



Population Gain Change in Population by Decade






 Bleckley County was seeing some growth from 1990-2010, but now has had slight decline in population

Comparison between Bleckley County and Georgia






- Bleckley county is disproportionately white compared to the rest of Georgia
- It has less representation of communities of color than Georgia overall, but the Black population is the 2nd largest group by far



Demographics2010 vs 2020 Demographics in Bleckley County






- Bleckley County has seen a decline in its Black population, but has doubled its Latino and Other populations

DemographicsPopulation Change by Race (2020 - 2010)







- Bleckley county has seen significant decline in its Black population, and saw similar declines in the White population as Georgia
- However, both the Latino and Other populations had higher growth rates than Georgia overall









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Net Gain in Population (2010 - 2020) by Census Block Group












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Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group










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



Bleckley School Board Population Density by Race


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Bleckley School Board Median Household Income by Census Tract




