

#### Change in Population in Georgia by County






 Georgia is experience rapid population growth in the Atlanta, Augusta, and Savannah regions of the state

**Change in Population by Decade** 






- Clay County has seen consistent decline in its population since 1940, with the exception being in the 1990's, where there was no significant change




#### **Comparison between Clay County and Georgia**






- Clay County has a much higher Black population compared to Georgia overall

• Clay County has seen a small decline in the Black population, and consequently a small increase in the White and Other populations






• There has been very little change amongst all demographic groups, but the Black community saw the greatest decline





## Clay Co. Commission & School Board Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group








