

# **Population Gain Change in Population by Decade**






- Crisp County had very moderate growth 1930-2010






- The Black community in Crisp County is a higher proportion of the county's population compared to Georgia overall







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#### Net Gain in Population (2010 - 2020) by Census Block Group











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Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group












