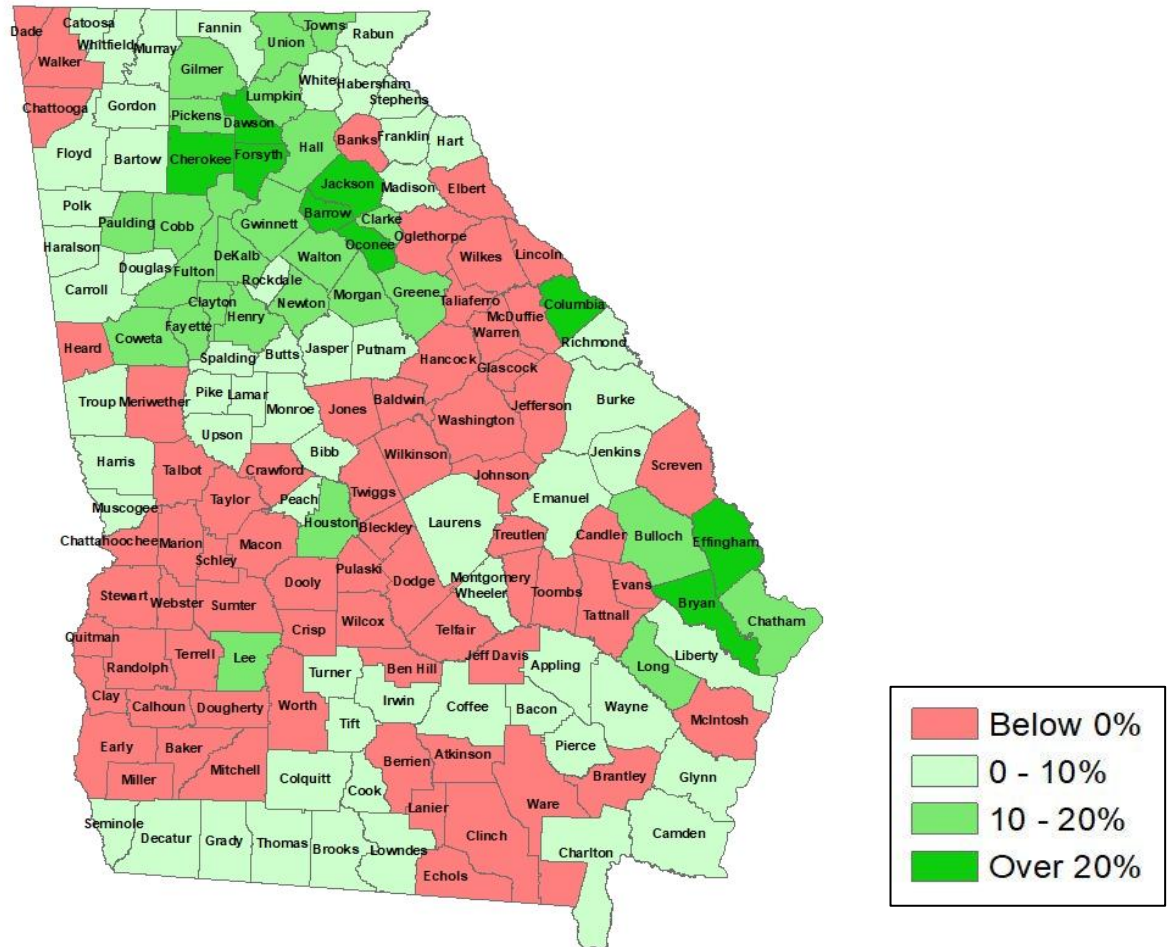

Change in Population in Georgia by County



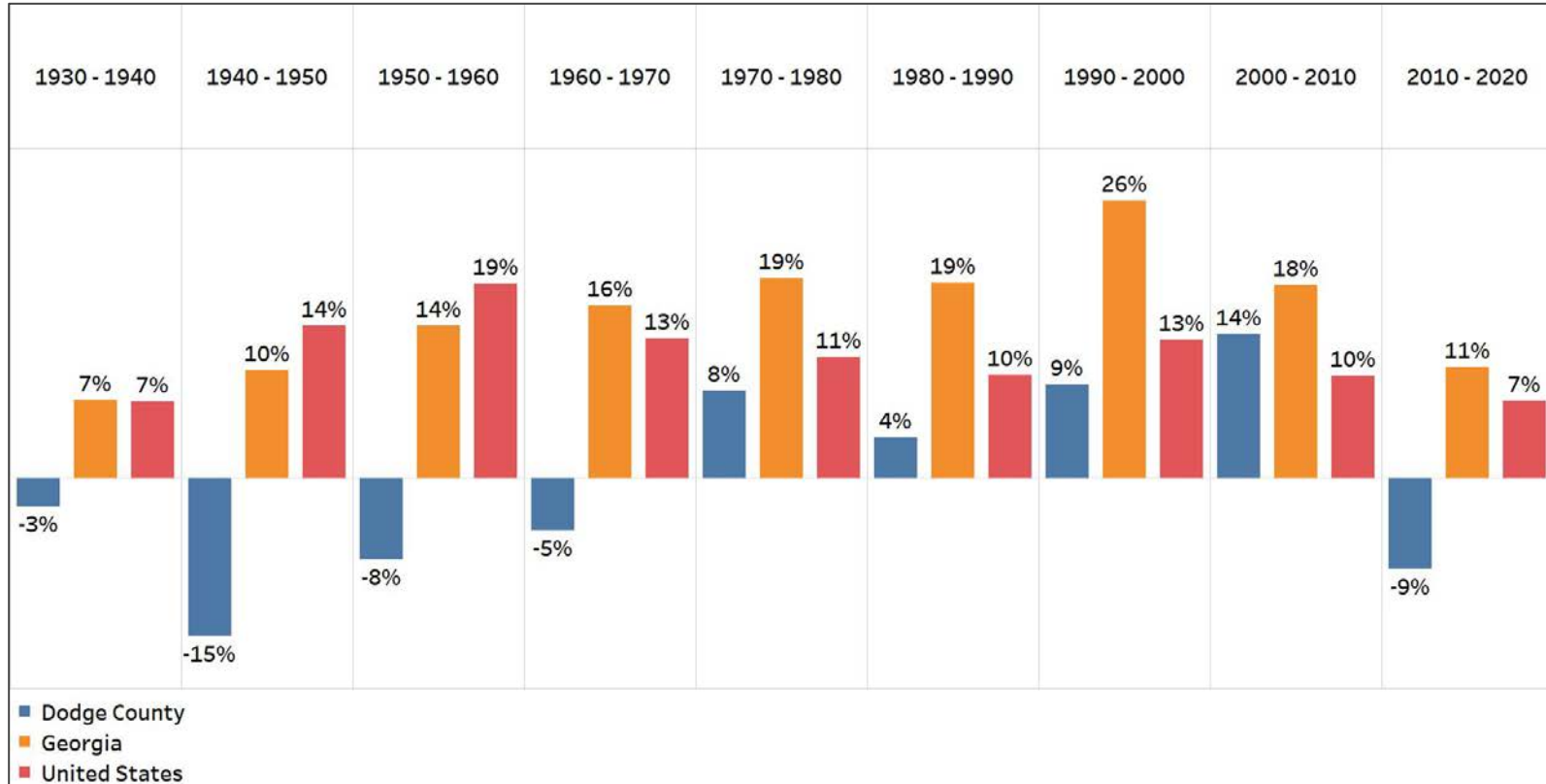
- Georgia is experiencing rapid population growth in the Atlanta, Augusta, and Savannah regions of the state

Change in Population by Decade



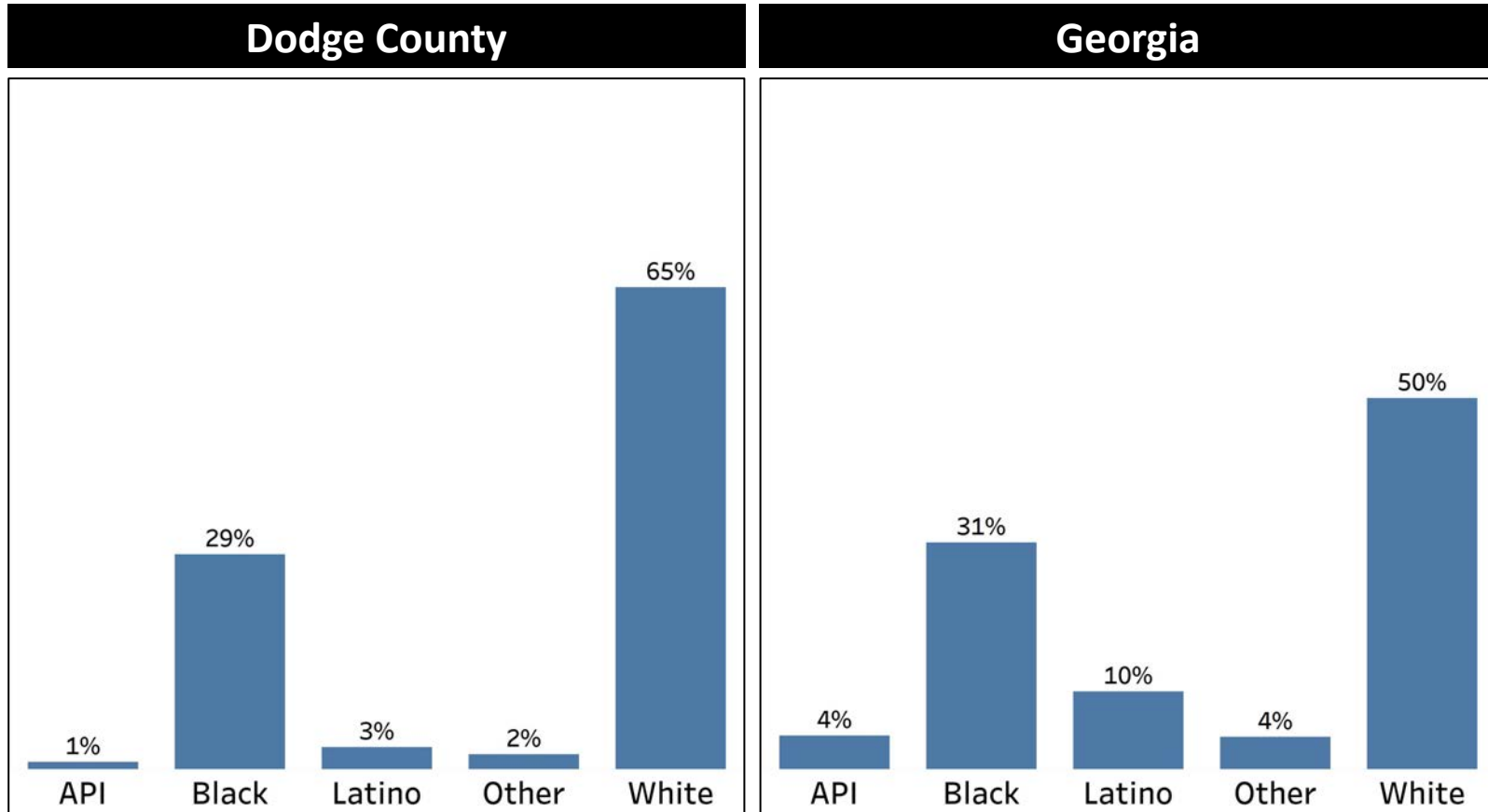
- Dodge County had a period of growth from 1970-2010

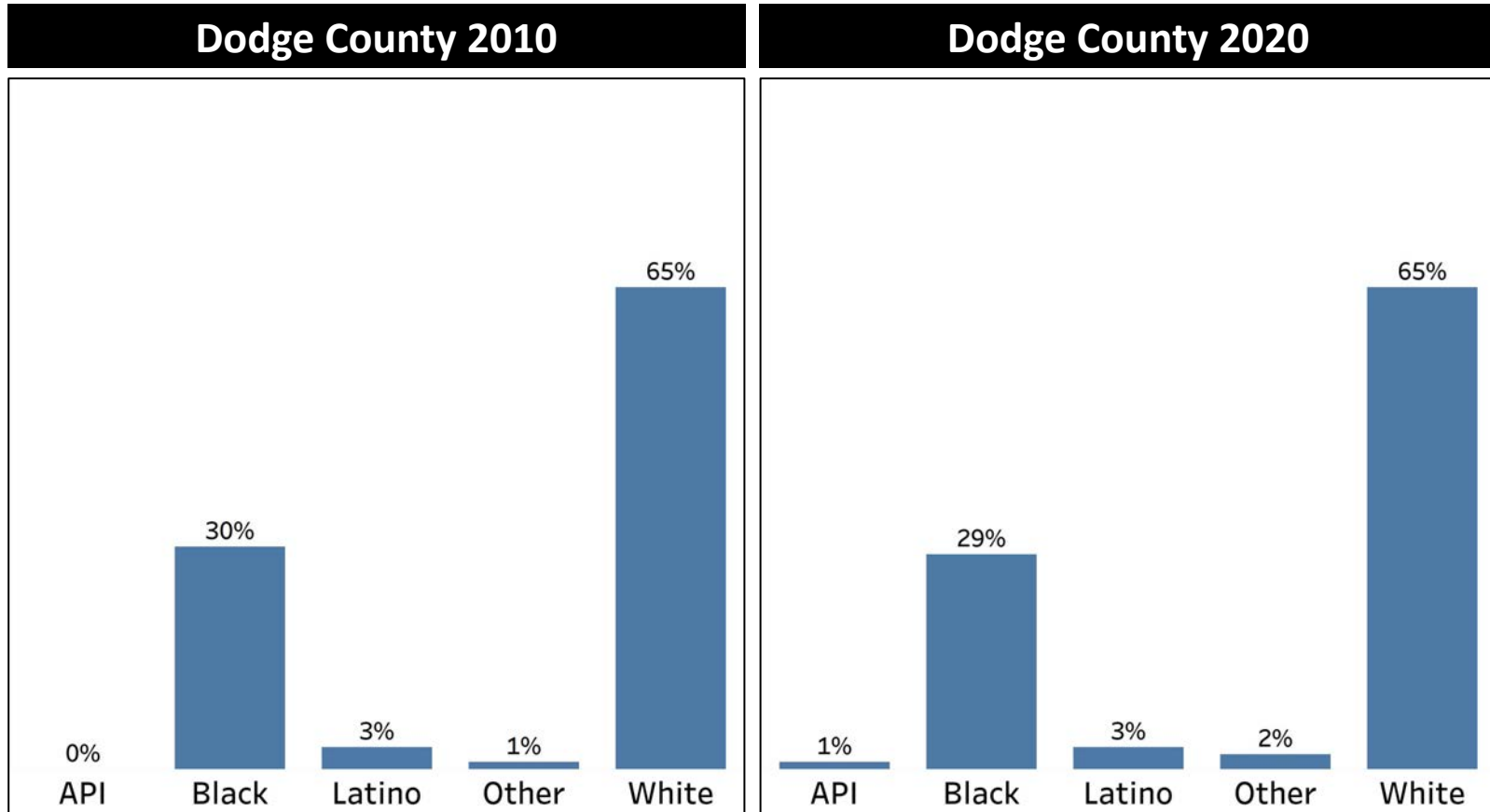
Comparison between Dodge County and Georgia

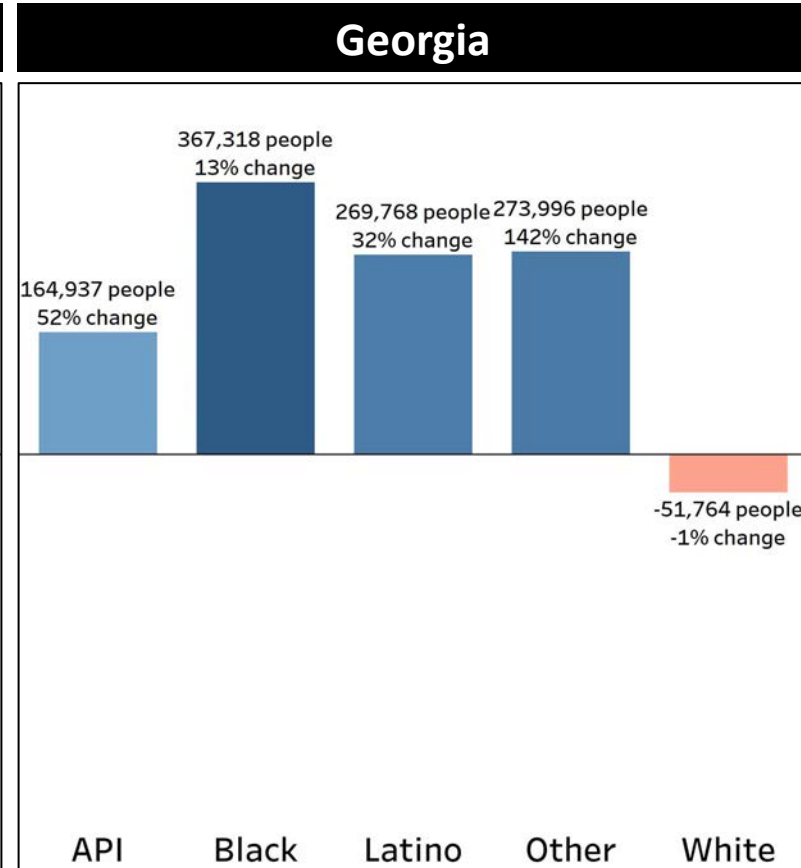
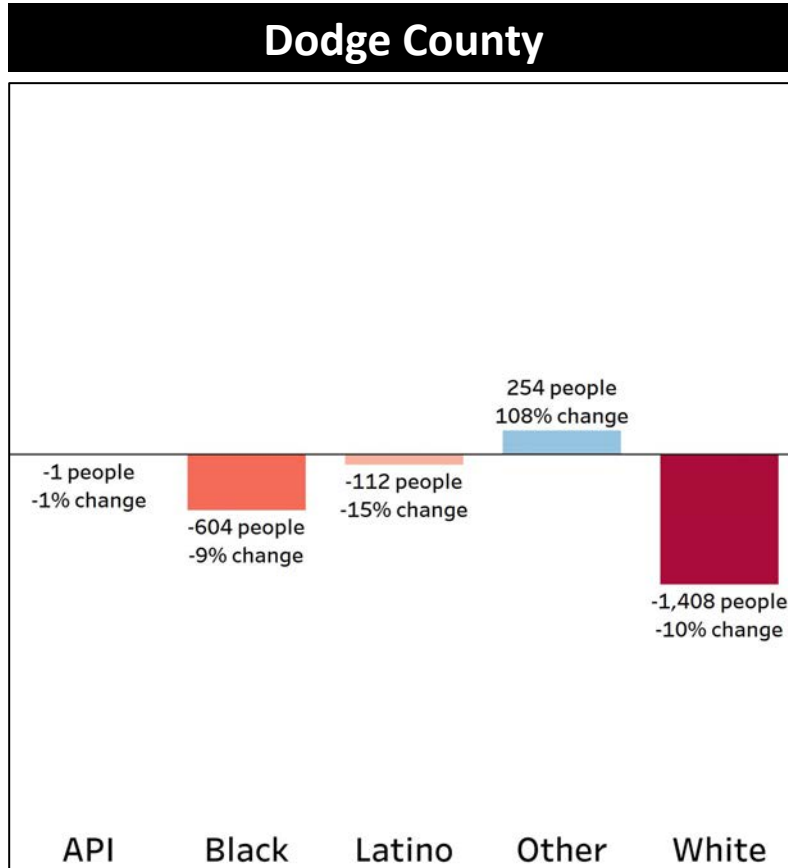


- The shares of the API and Other populations increased in the last decade

- The White population declined at a faster rate in the county than in Georgia overall

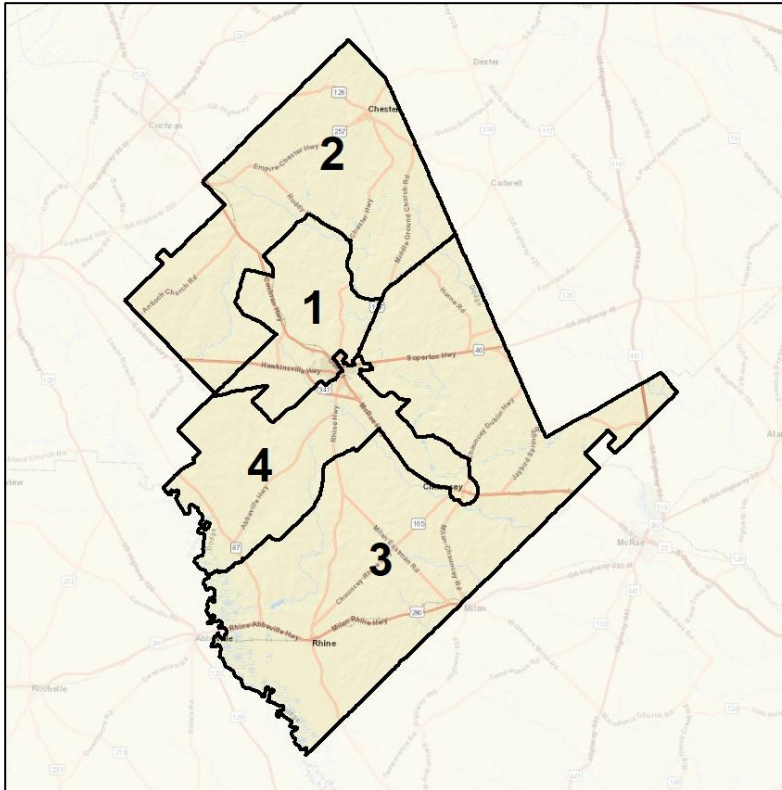

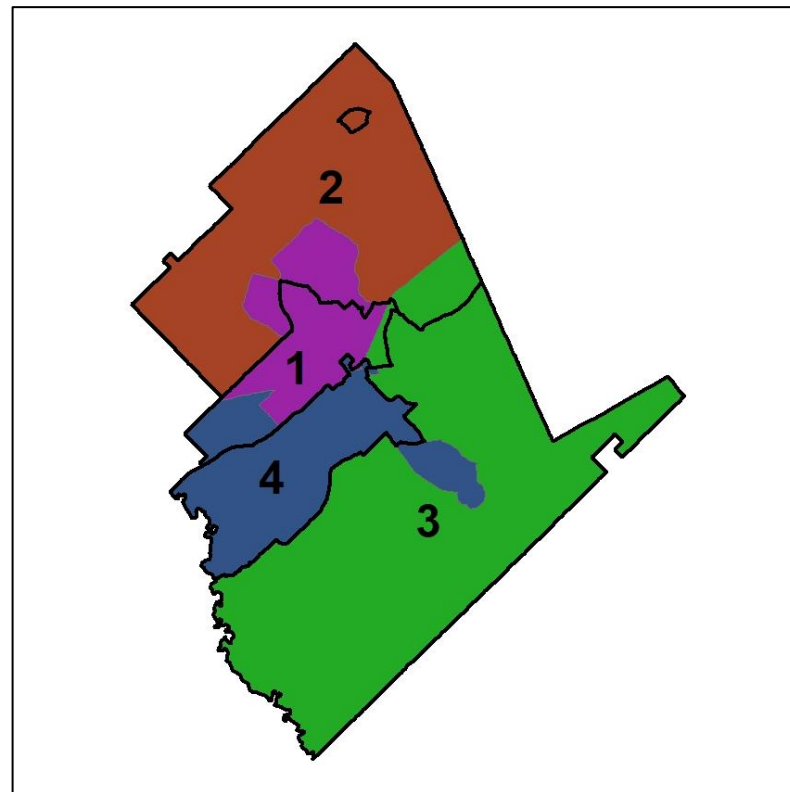
Changes in Redistricting

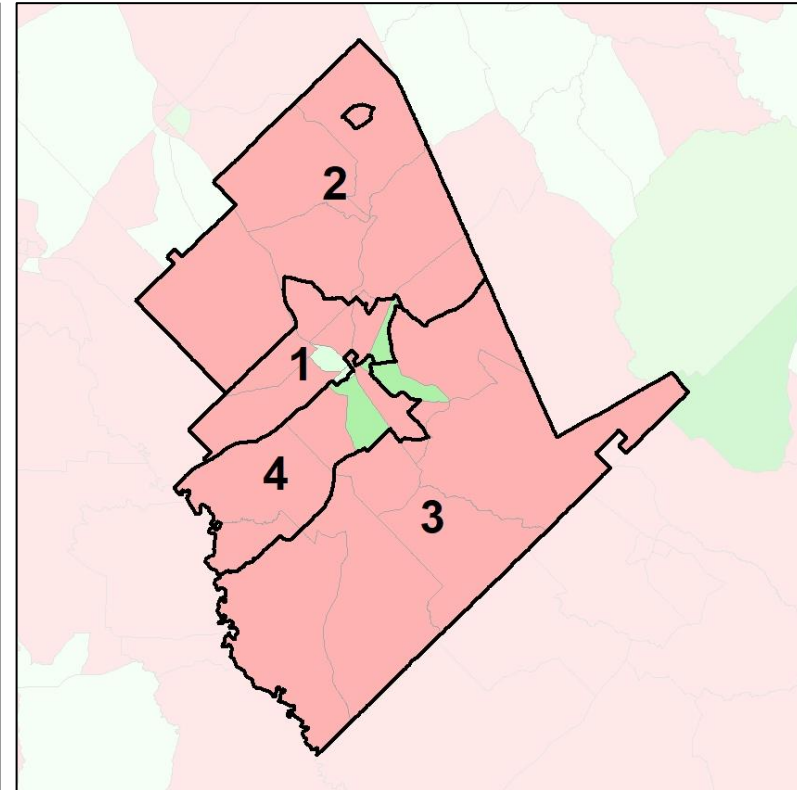
Net Gain in Population (2010 - 2020)

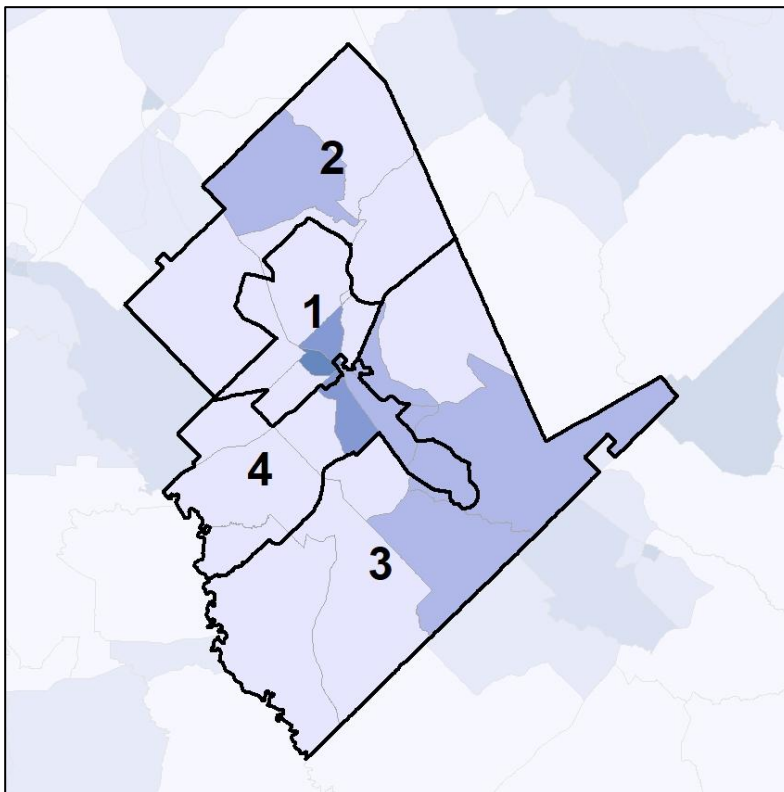

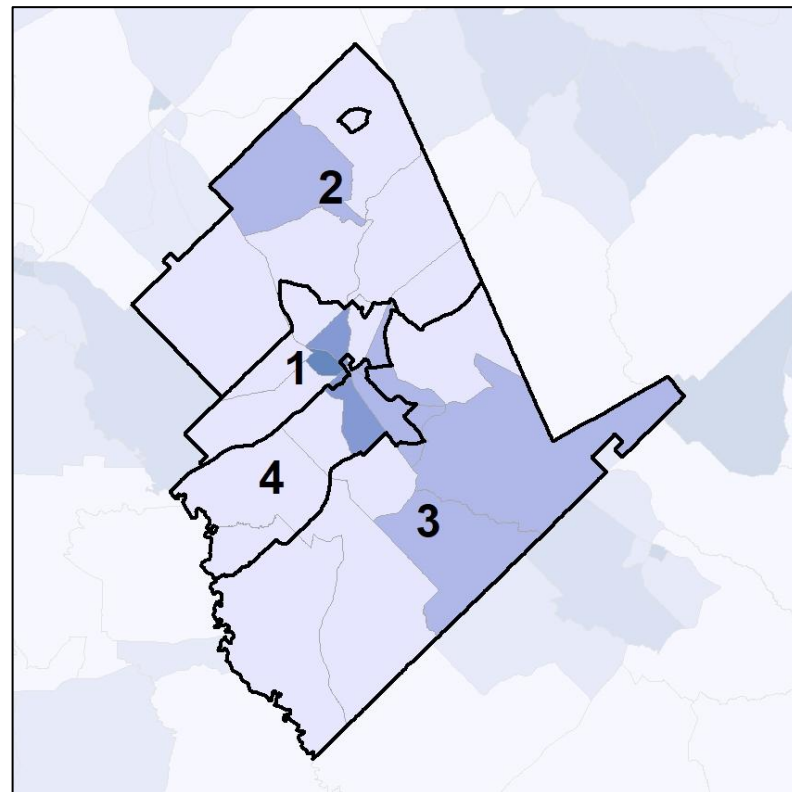
Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group

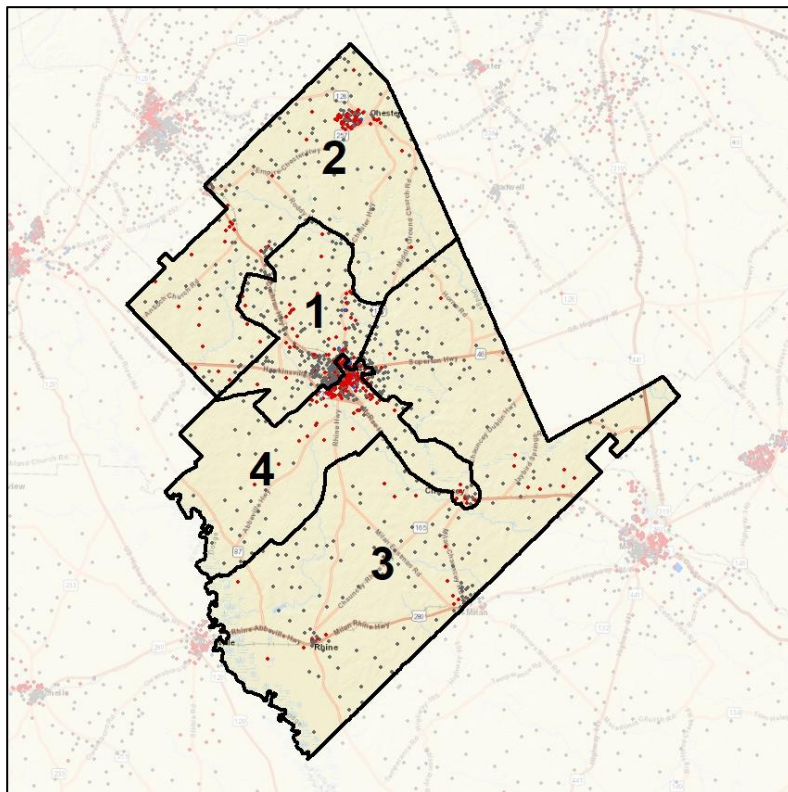

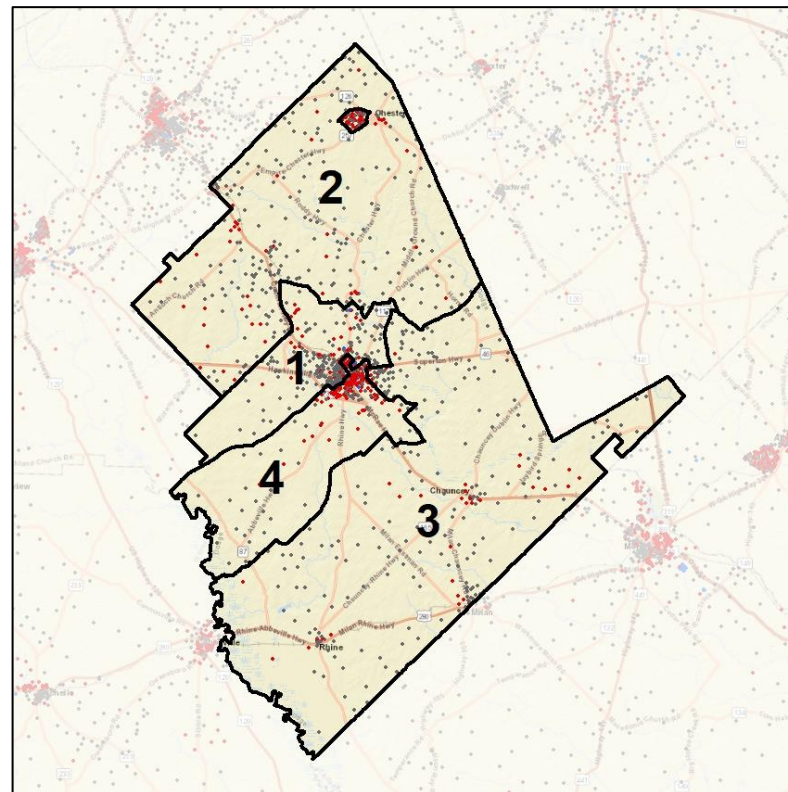
Population Density by Race



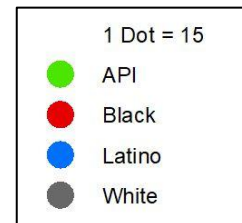

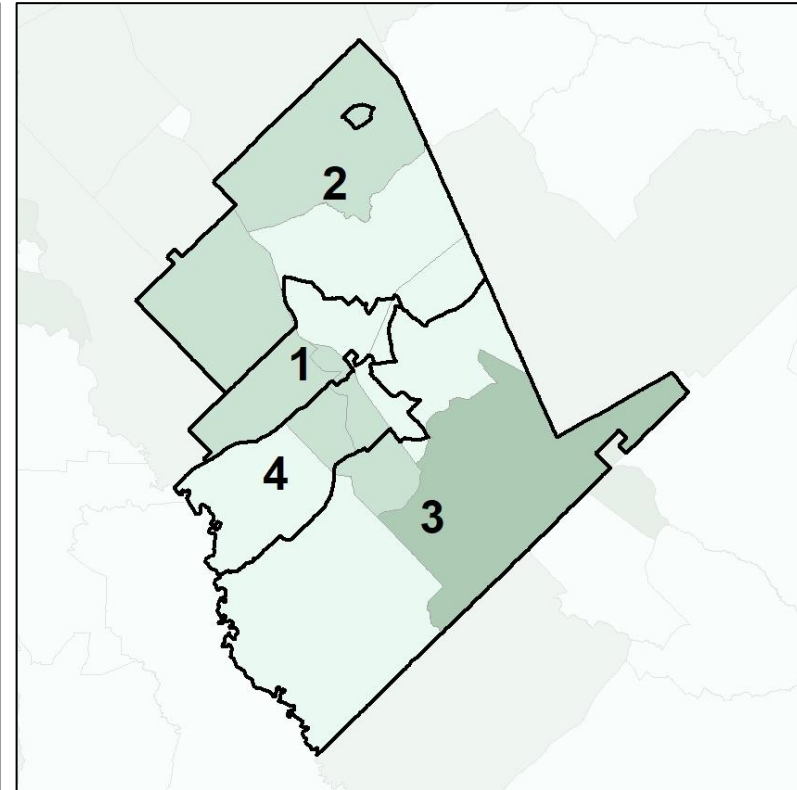
Median Household Income by Census Tract



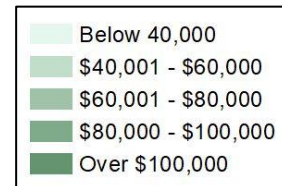

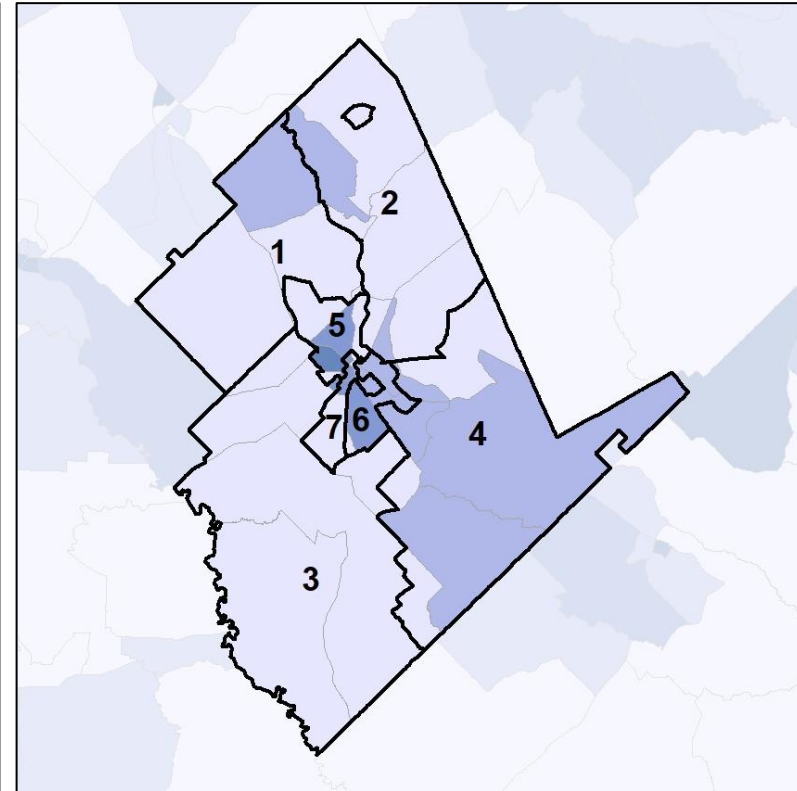
Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group

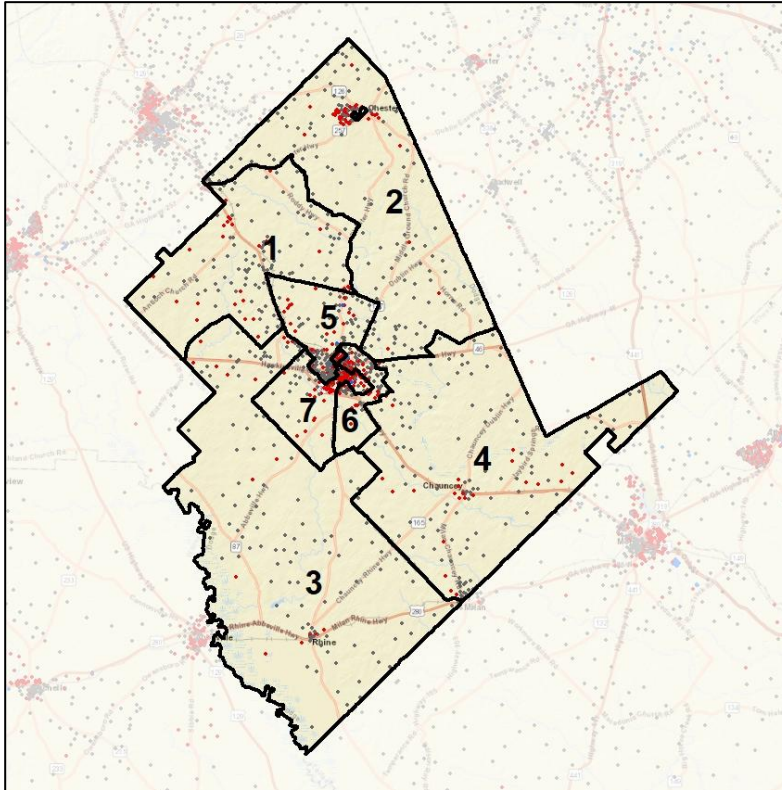

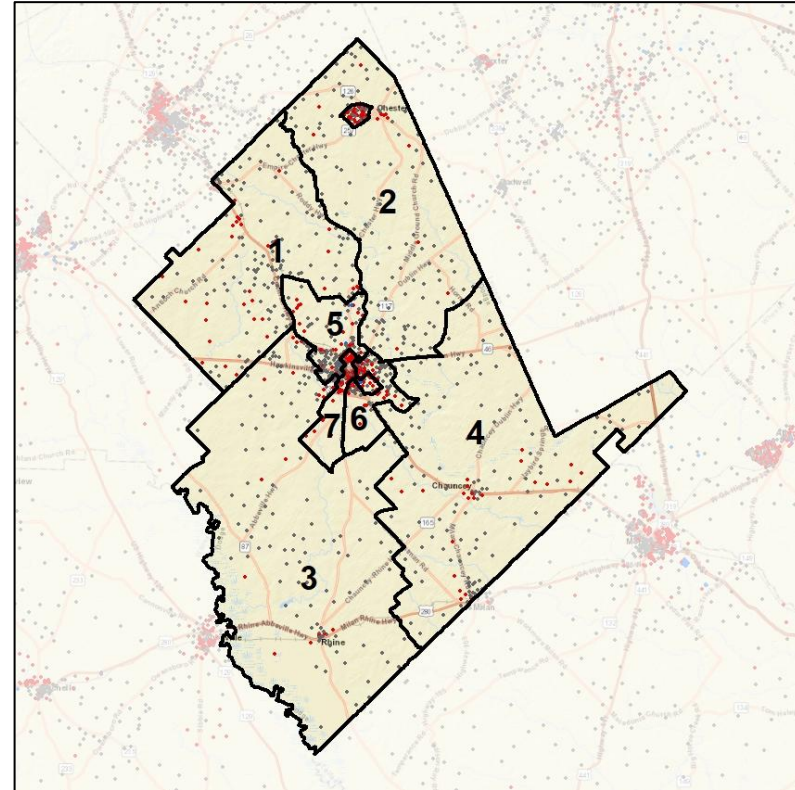
Population Density by Race



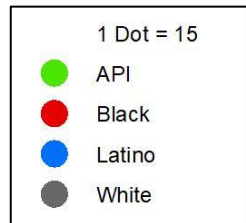

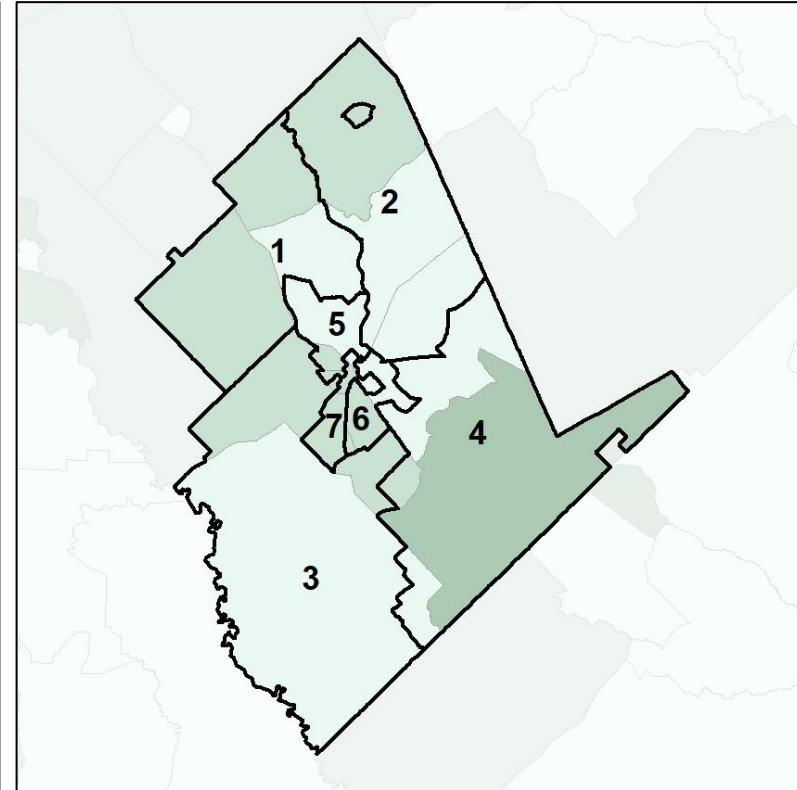
Median Household Income by Census Tract



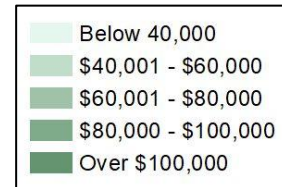

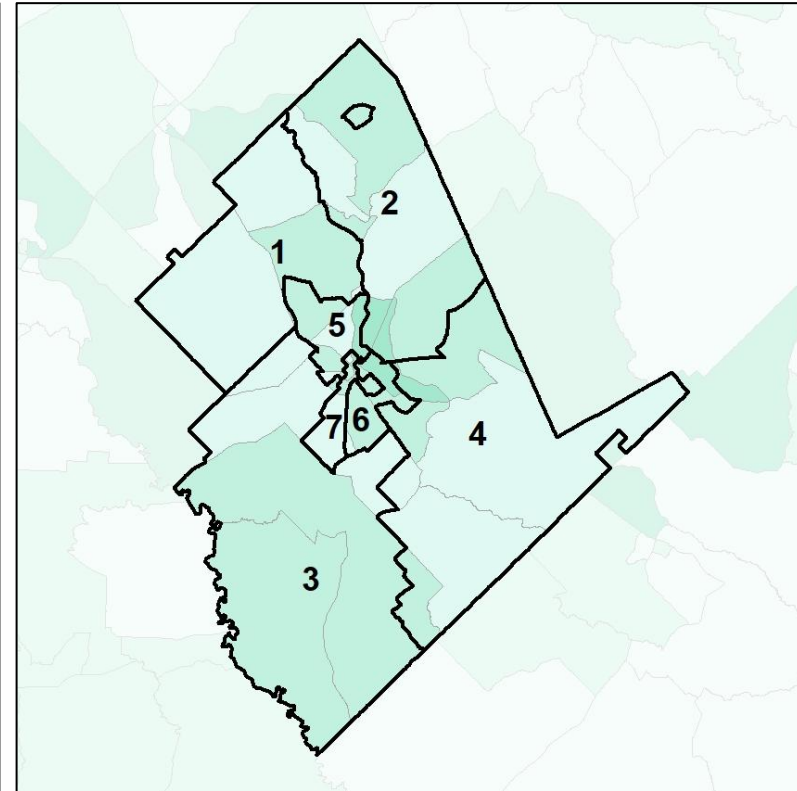
% Youth (18-34) by Census Block Group
