- Dooly County has seen long periods of decline with the exception of the 1970s and 1990-2010, with the latter period being a significant increase in the population
- However, in the last decade, Dooly County has had the biggest drop in population in 90 years

- Dooly County is plurality Black, only slightly under a majority at $49 \%$, followed by the White population at 41\%
- The Latino population also makes up a decent share of the county, somewhat close to the share in Georgia overall

- Meanwhile, the API and White communities decreased their shares
