



Population Gain Change in Population by Decade






- Glynn County has experienced a steady population growth since 1930 which has fluctuated in percentage rate every decade






 Glynn County White population is above the statewide average while the Black population is below Georgia's overall average



Demographics2010 vs 2020 Demographics in Glynn County






- Glynn County is experiencing a decline in population both in its White and Black population which have both decreased by 2% since 2010

DemographicsPopulation Change by Race (2020 - 2010)








- Glynn County is experiencing an increase in population across demographics expect the Black population









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Glynn Co. Commission & School Board Net Gain in Population (2010 - 2020)










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



Glynn Co. Commission & School Board Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group












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Glynn Co. Commission & School Board Population Density by Race

















Glynn Co. Commission & School Board % Youth (18-34) by Census Block Group
