

Change in Population in Georgia by County






 Georgia is experience rapid population growth in the Atlanta, Augusta, and Savannah regions of the state

Change in Population by Decade






- Gwinnett County has been one of the fastest growing counties in Georgia, and has continued to see significant growth that surpasses Georgia's growth

Comparison between Gwinnett County and Georgia






- Gwinnett county is a very diverse county, with the one of the highest share of both Latino and API populations in the state
- Gwinnett has a significantly lower White population compared to Georgia overall, and slightly lower Black population


2010 vs 2020 Demographics in Gwinnett County

• Gwinnett County continues to have significant gains in population for communities of color, while having significant decline in the share of the White population in the county






- Gwinnett County has had similar growth rates in the API, Latino, and Other populations as Georgia overall

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




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


Gwinnett County Commission Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group






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

% Black by Census Block Group








Gwinnett County School Board Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group









Population Density by Race







Median Household Income by Census Tract








