










 Haralson County has had a slight decline in the share of both White and Black percentage of population, with both the Latino and Other populations doubling their share



# **Demographics**Population Change by Race (2020 - 2010)







 Only the Black community declined in Haralson County, while both the Latino and Other populations had higher growth rates than Georgia overall




# Haralson County Commission Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group















### Haralson County School Board Median Household Income by Census Tract











