



Population Gain Change in Population by Decade






- Heard County had a strong surge in population from 1970-2000, following significant decline in the previous few decades

DemographicsComparison between Heard County and Georgia






Heard County is overwhelmingly White, with only the Other population being the only other demographic that is above Georgia's average



Demographics2010 vs 2020 Demographics in Heard County






 Heard County's White and Black populations both declined, while the Other population more than doubled



DemographicsPopulation Change by Race (2020 - 2010)







- All demographic groups declined except for Latino which was only a slight increase - and the Other demographic



Heard Co. Commission & School Board Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group












