## Change in Population in Georgia by County



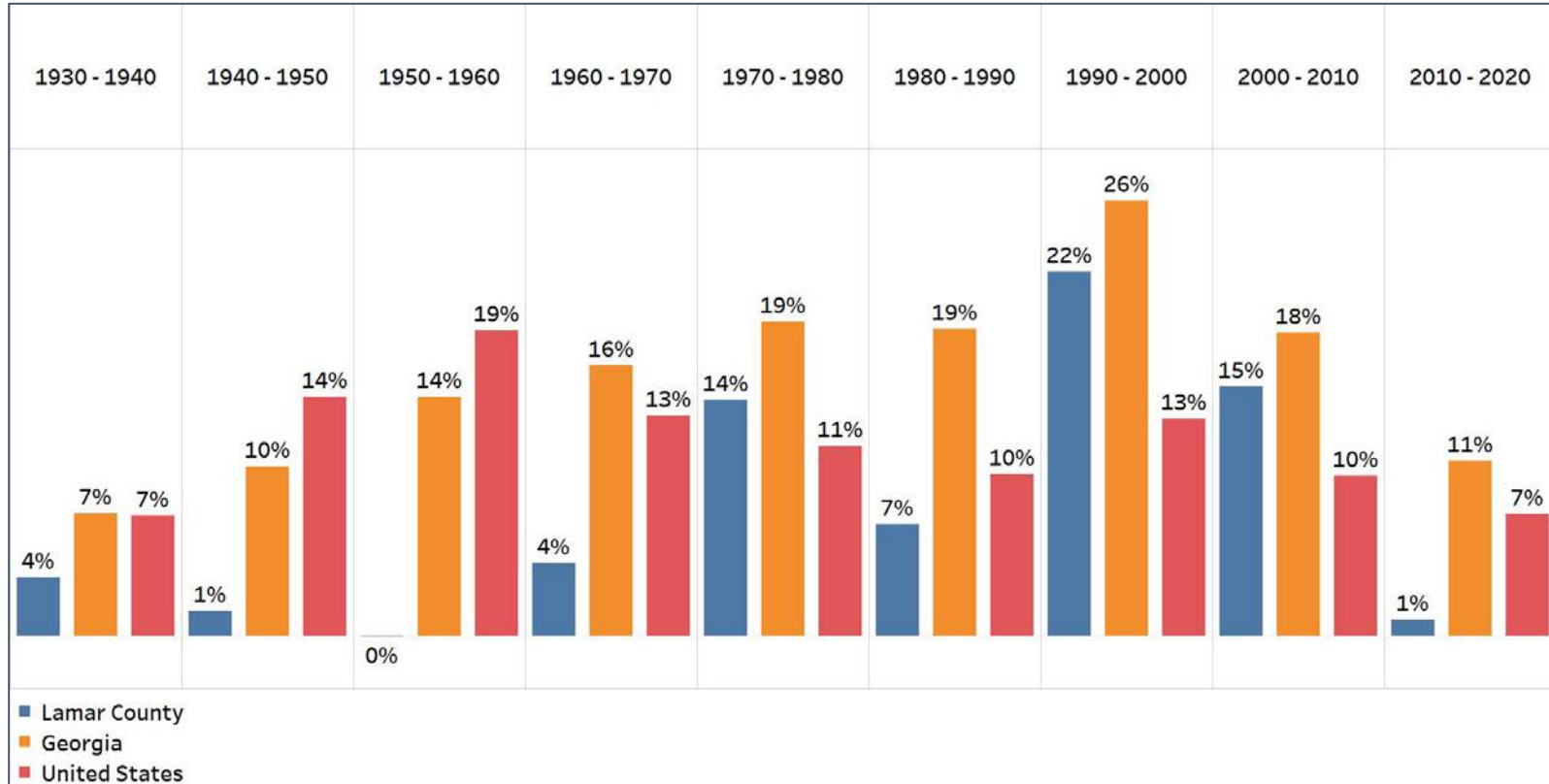
- Georgia is experiencing rapid population growth in the Atlanta, Augusta, and Savannah regions of the state

## Change in Population by Decade



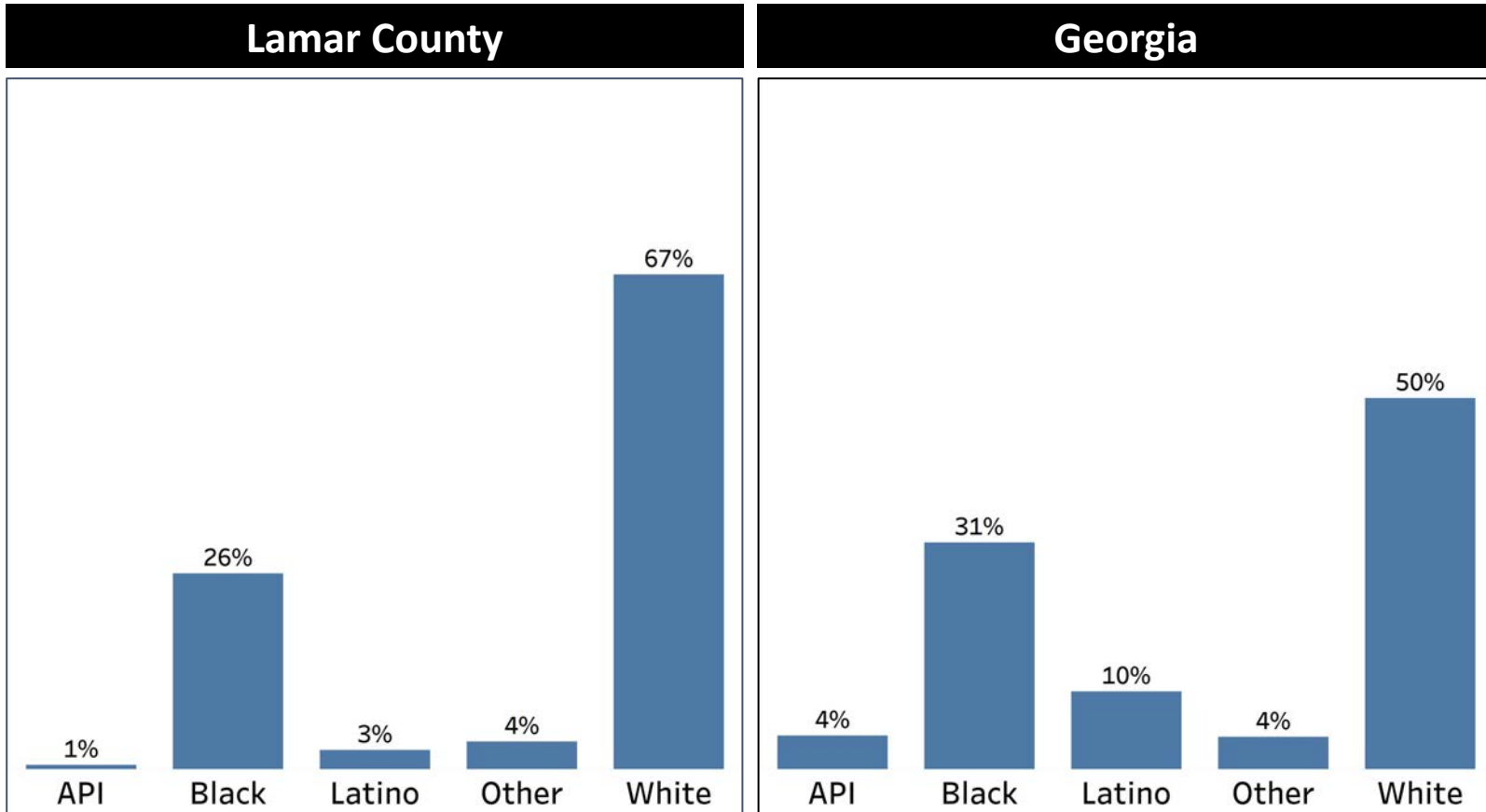
- Lamar County has not had any population decline since 1930

- The Other demographic also has a similar share in the county as it does statewide

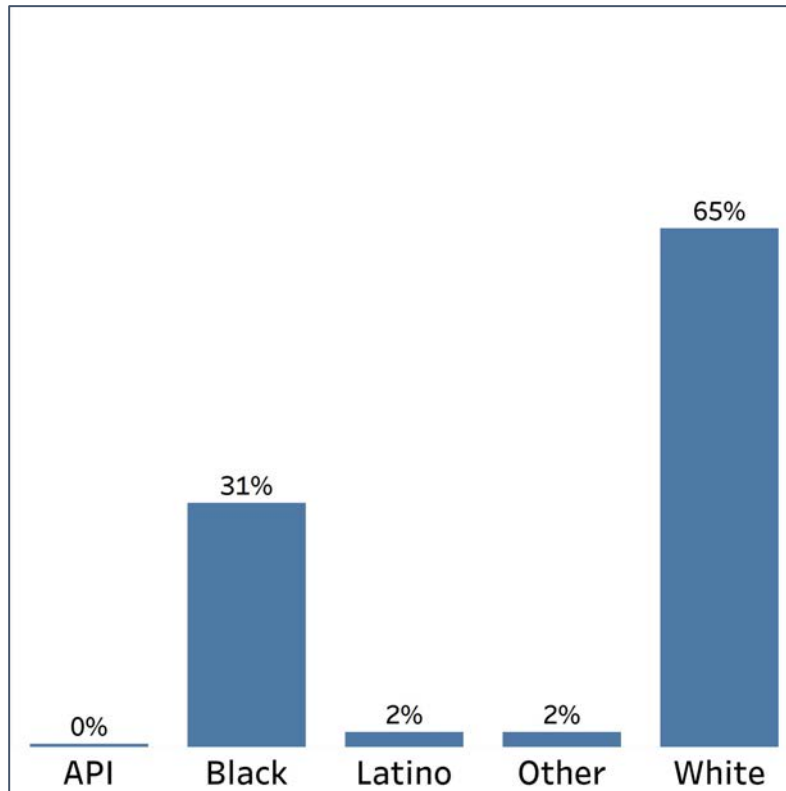

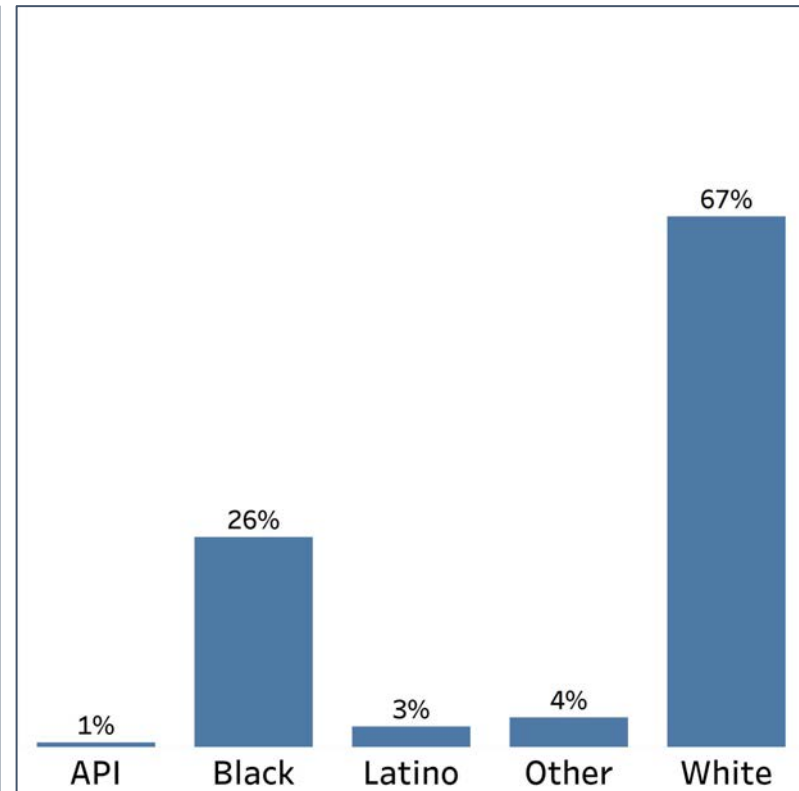
## 2010 vs 2020 Demographics in Lamar County

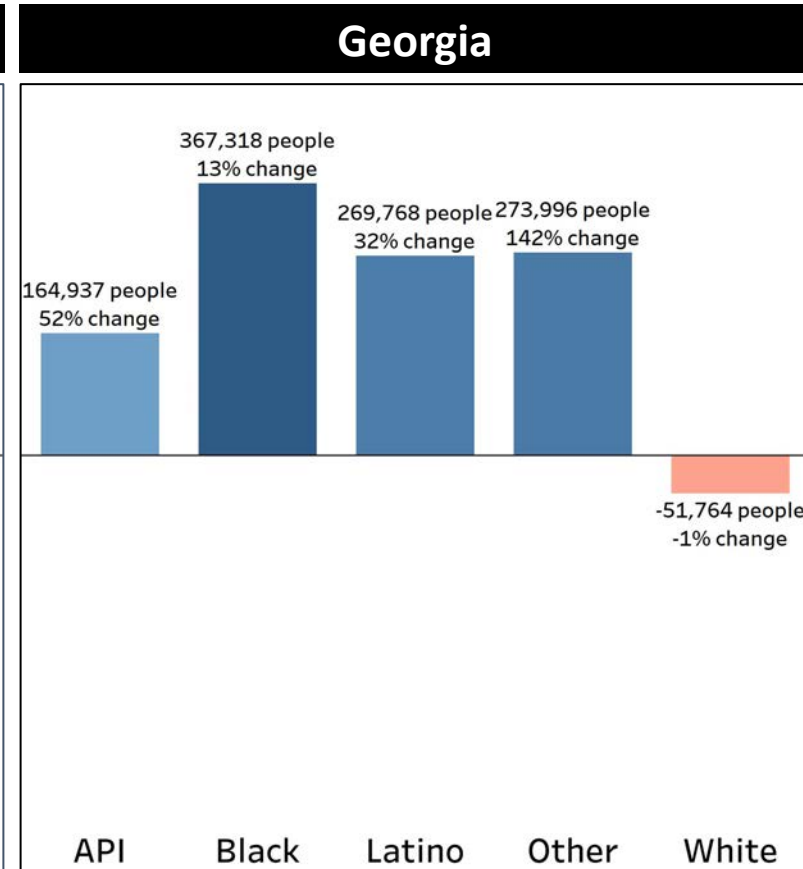
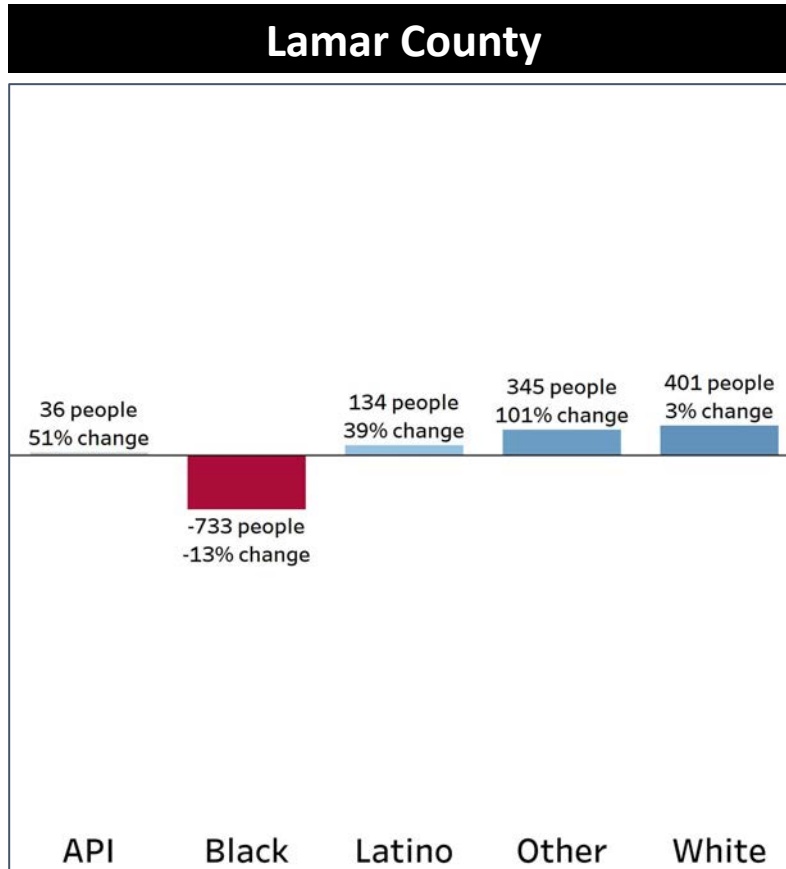
### Lamar County 2020



- Lamar County had a slight increase in the share of the White population while seeing significant decrease in the share of the Black population
- Both the Latino and Other populations also saw increases in the past decade

## Population Change by Race (2020 - 2010)



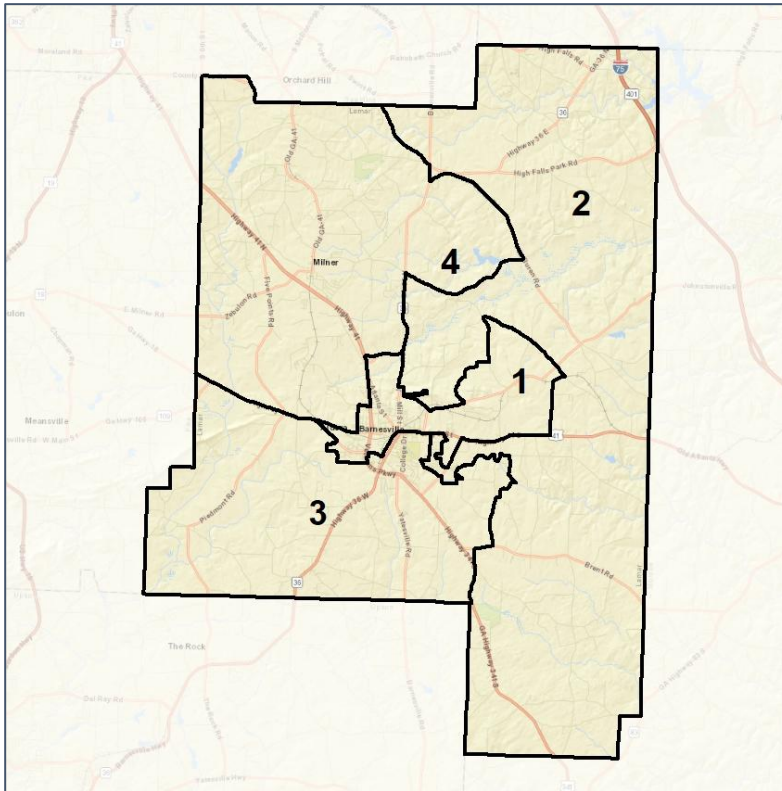
- Lamar County had significant decline in the Black population in the last decade, which is the opposite of the overall trend of growth in Georgia

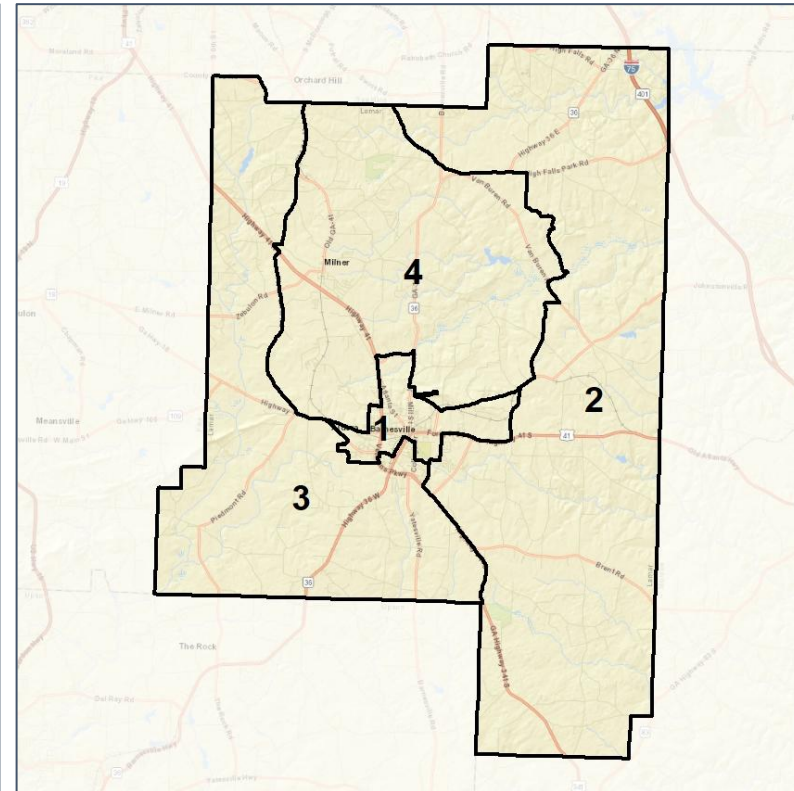

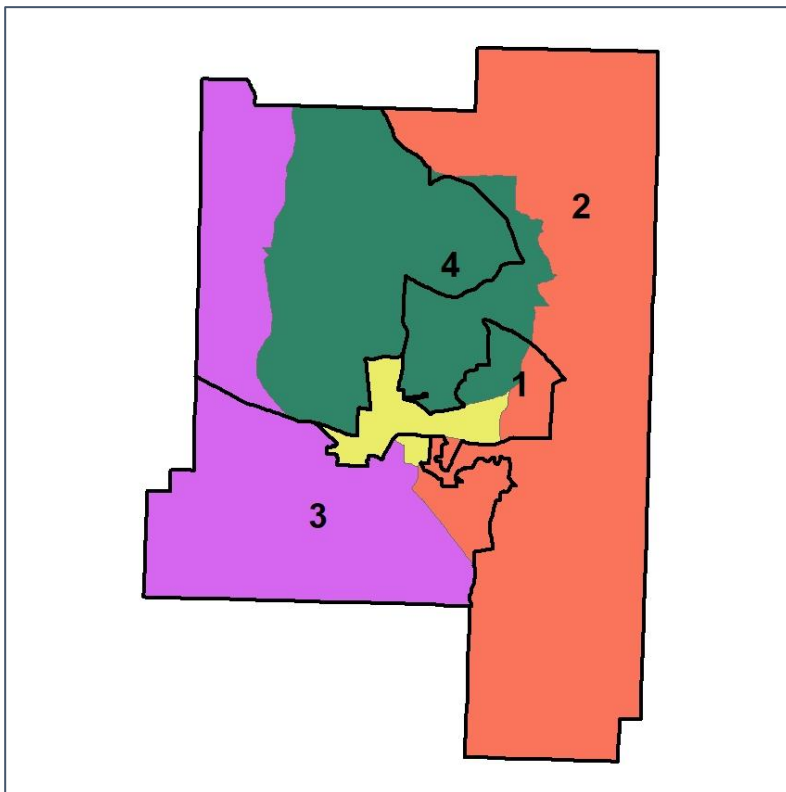

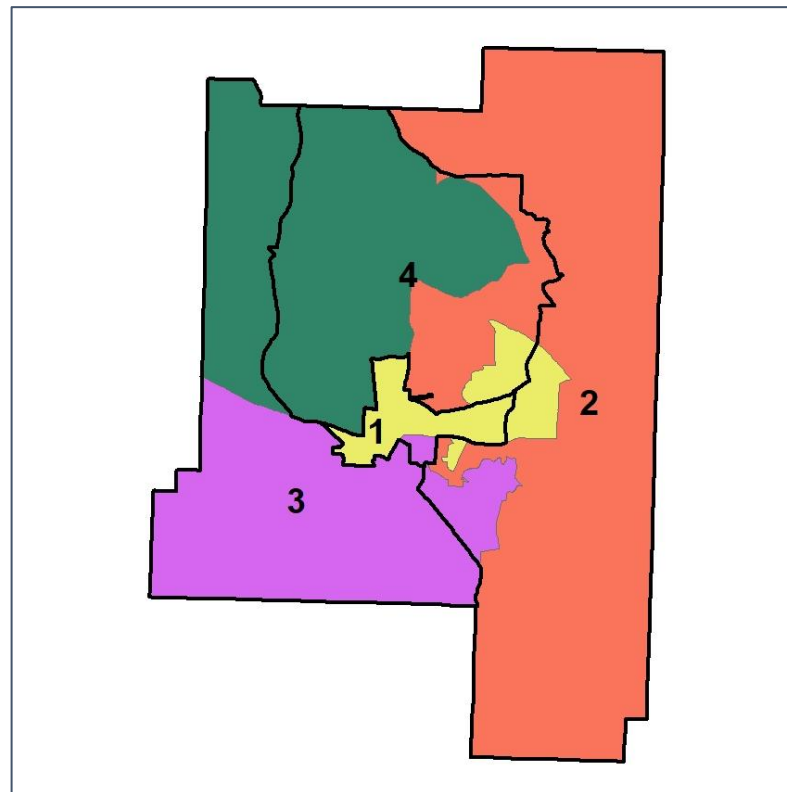
## Changes in Redistricting

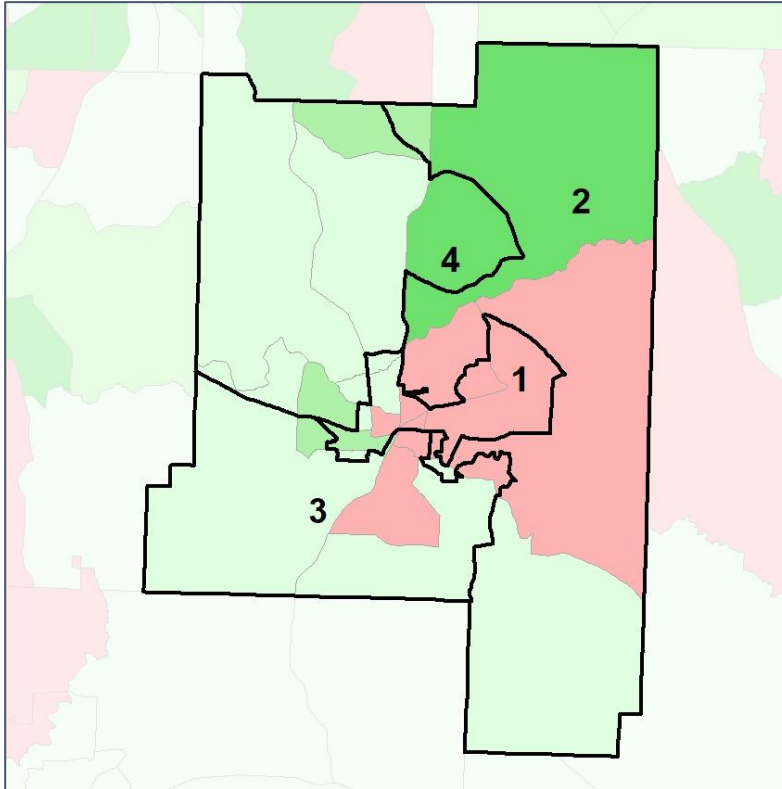

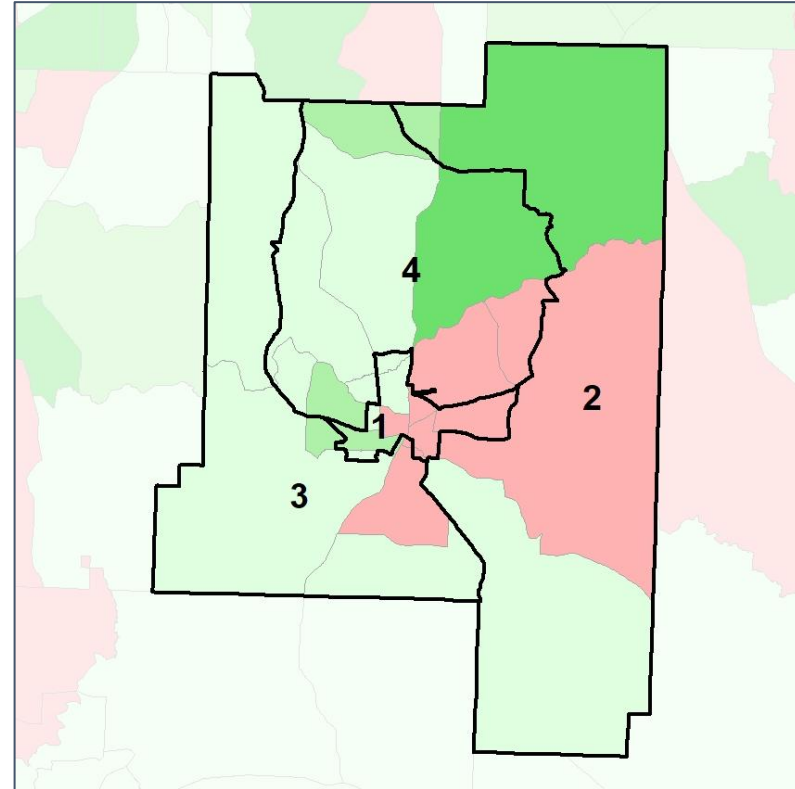
## Net Gain in Population (2010 - 2020) by Census Block Group

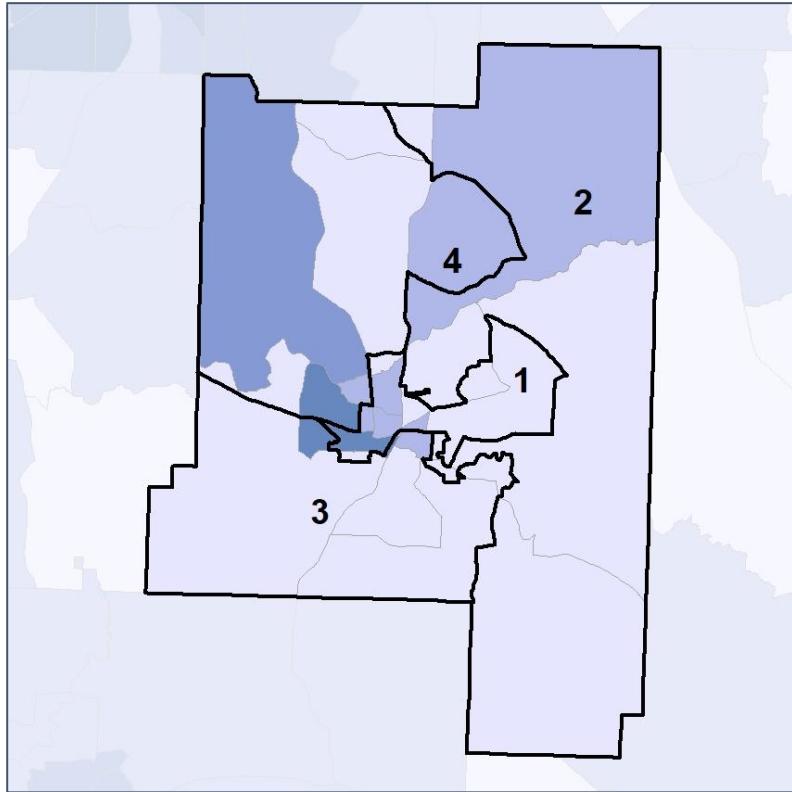

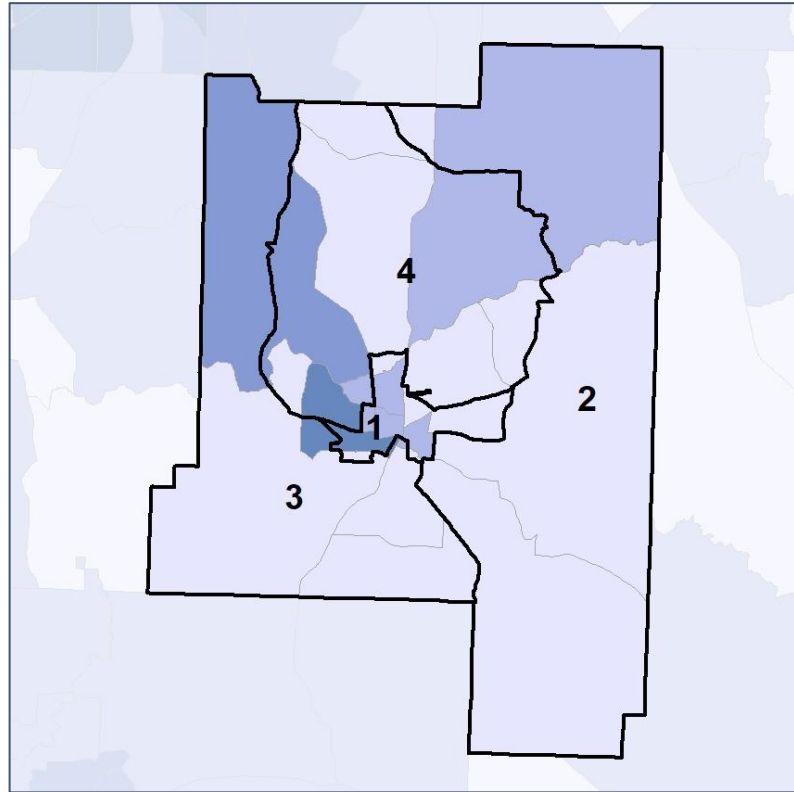
## Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group

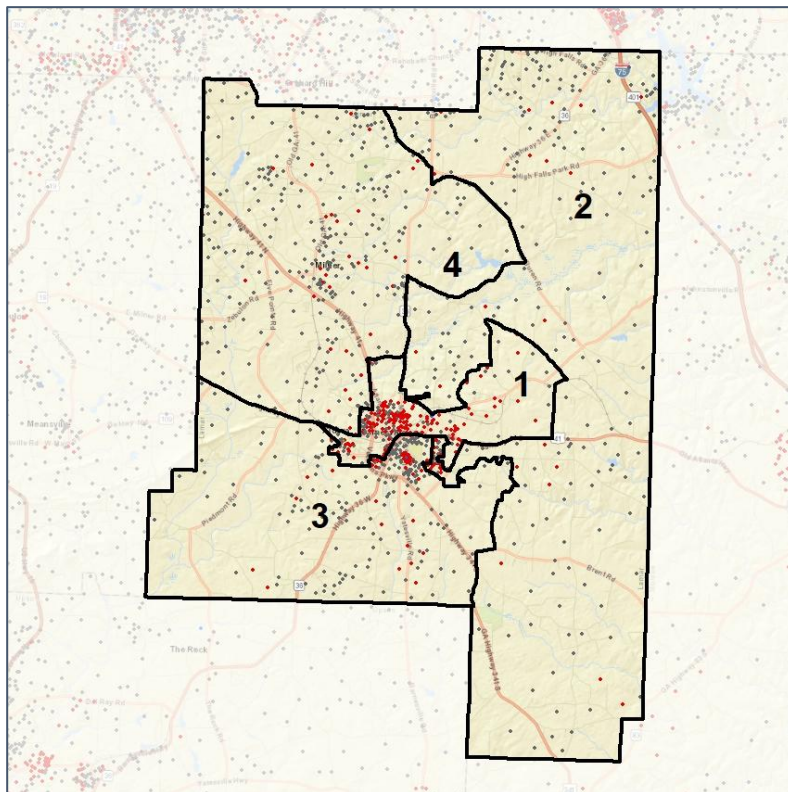

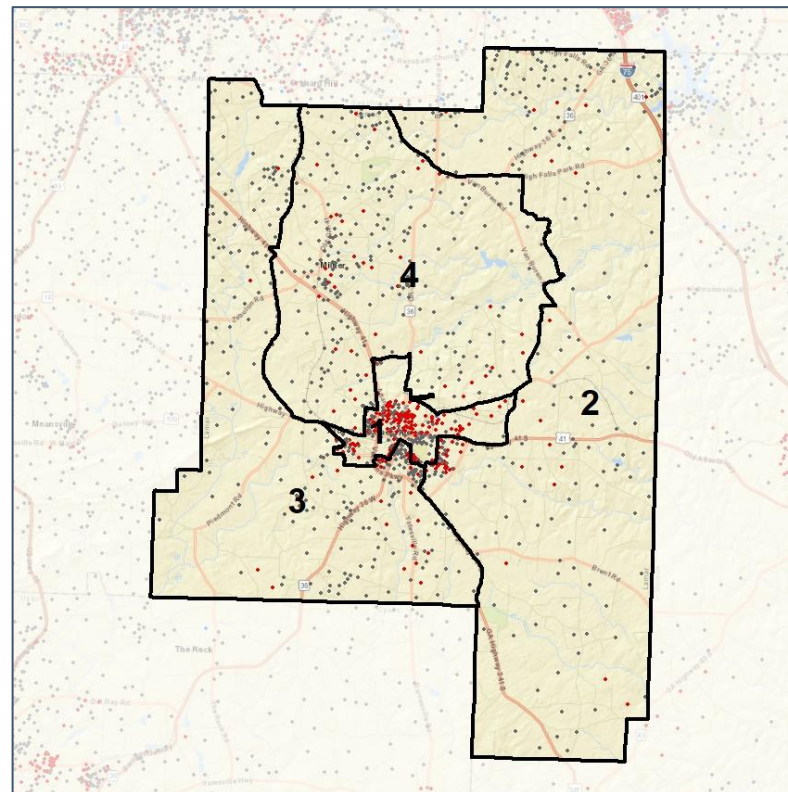
## Population Density by Race



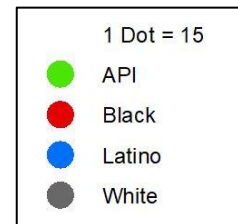

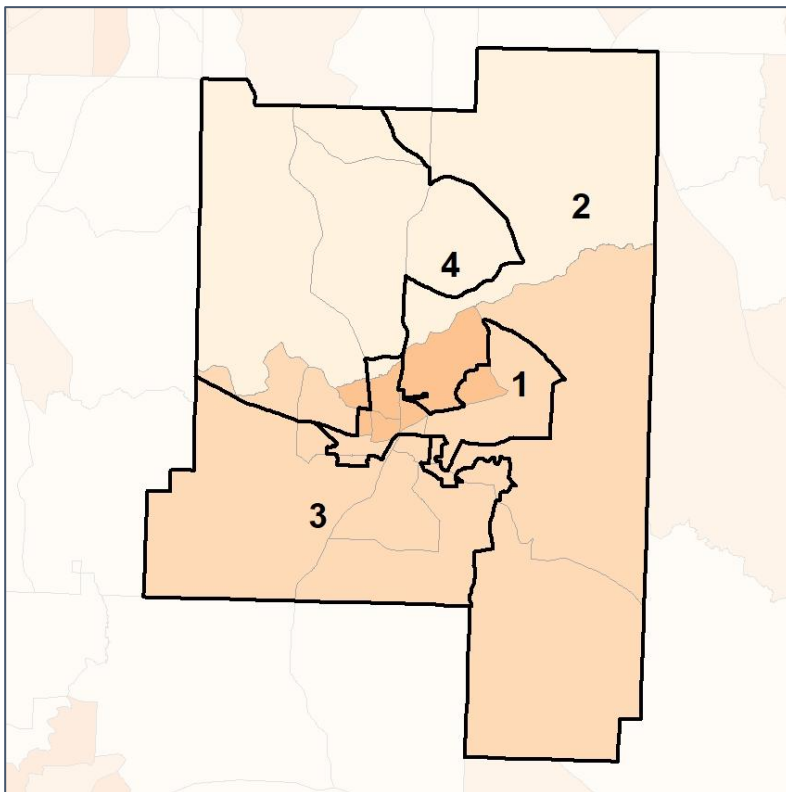

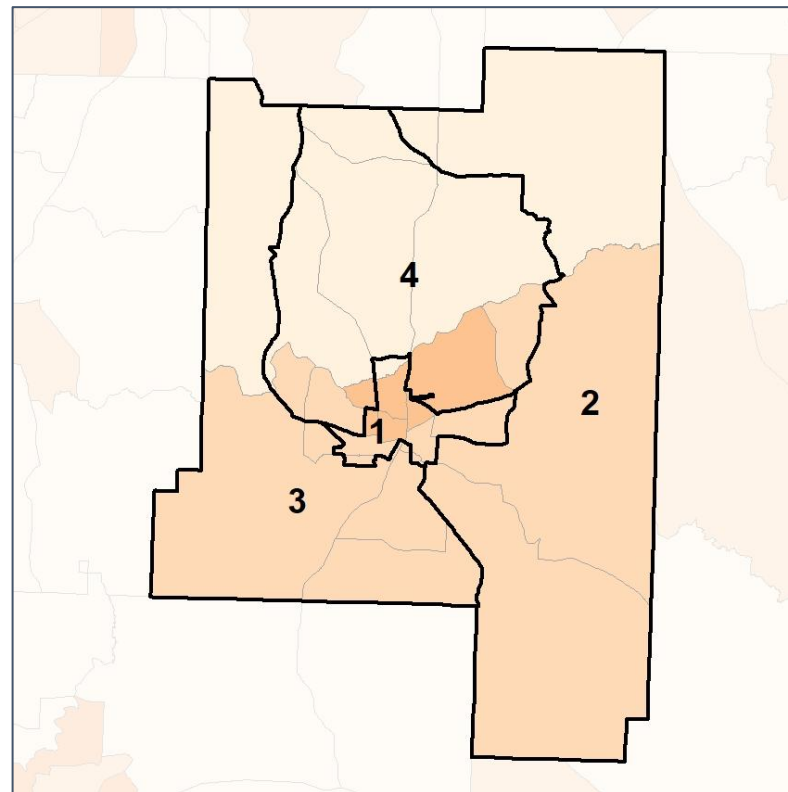
## % People of Color by Census Block Group



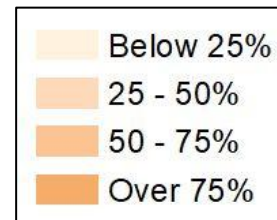

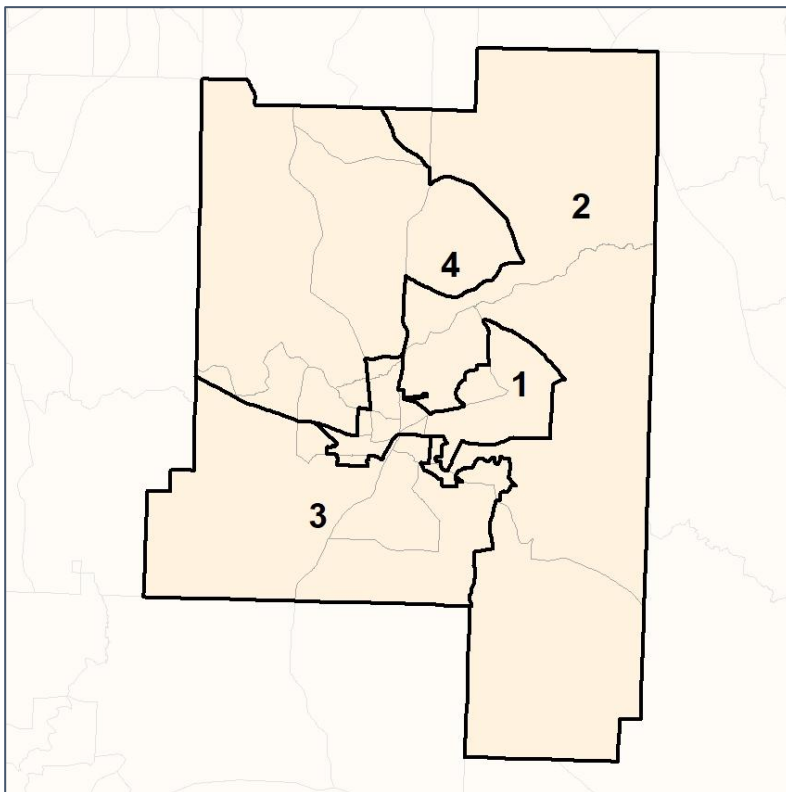

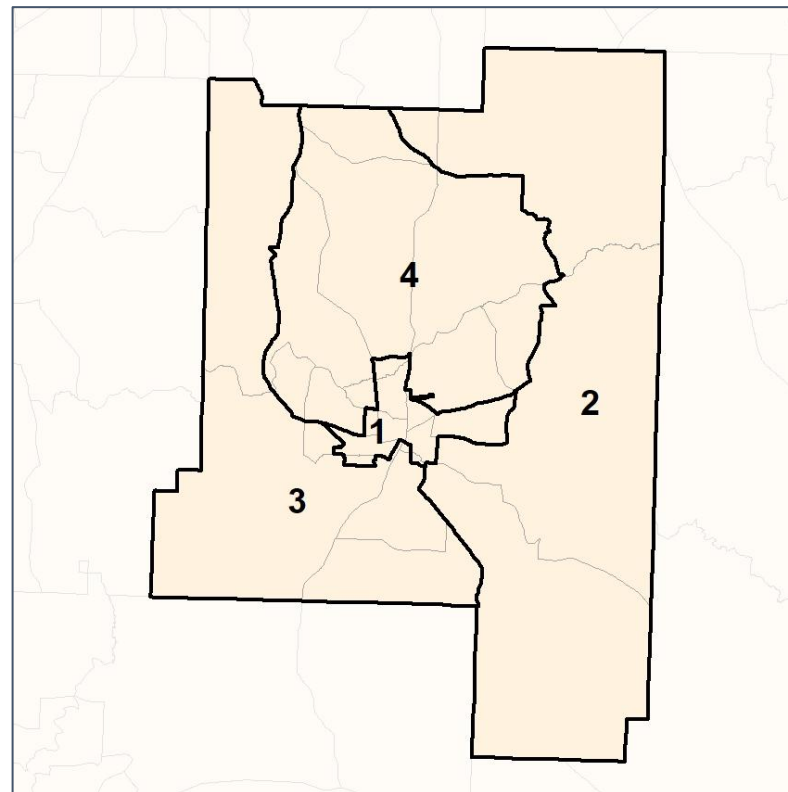
## % API by Census Block Group



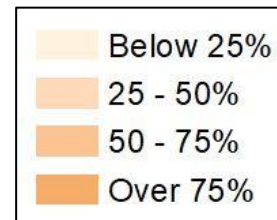

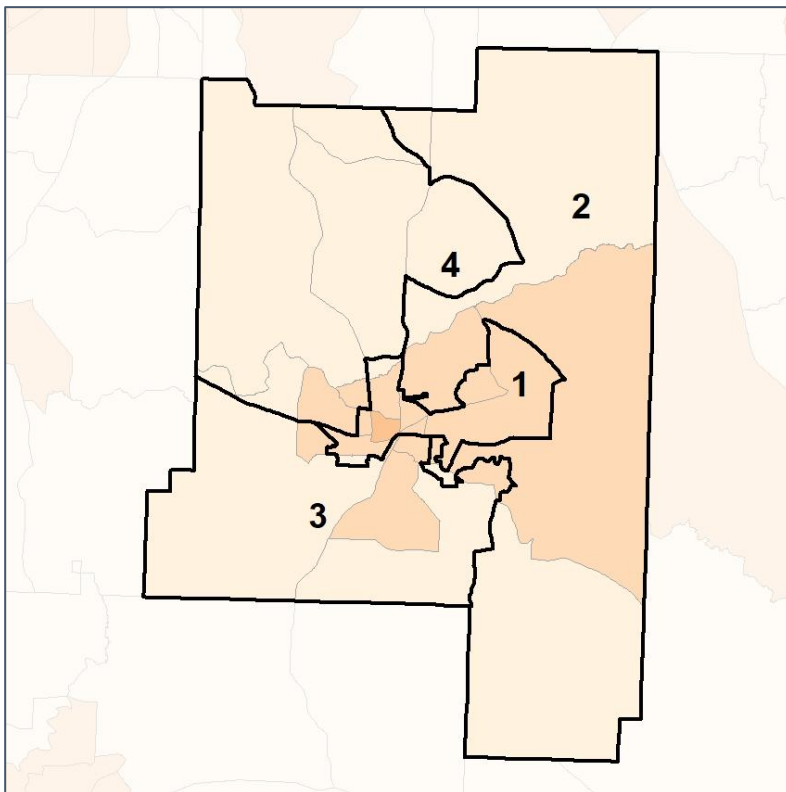

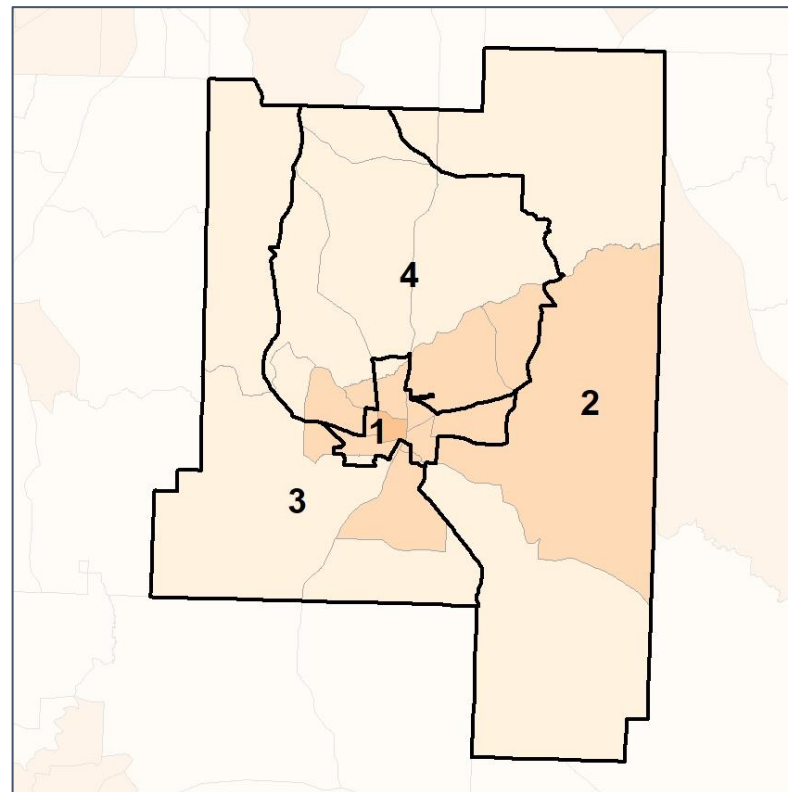
## % Black by Census Block Group



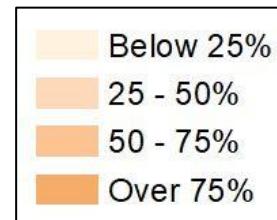

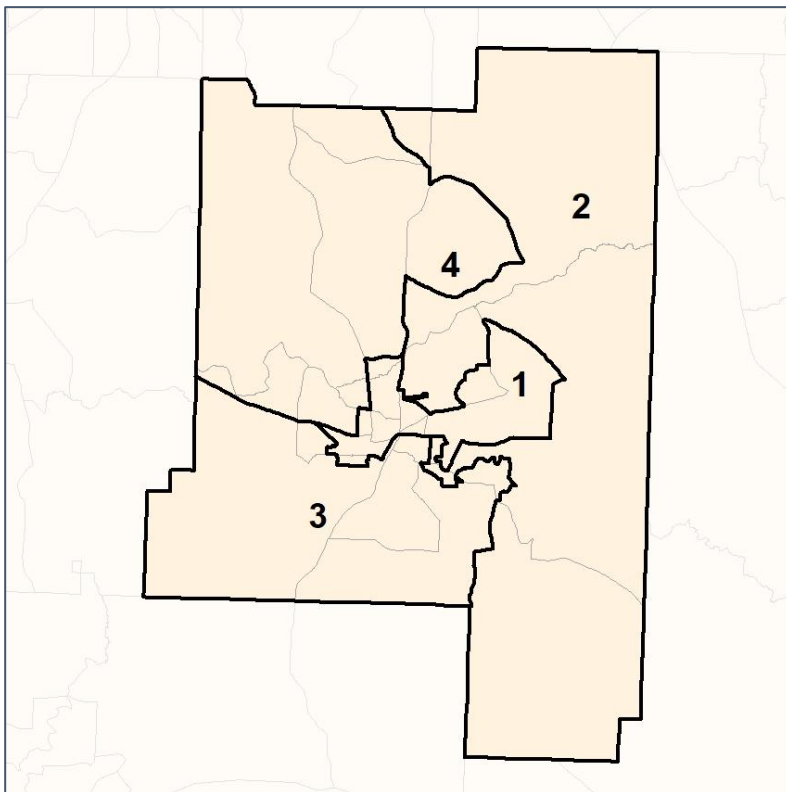

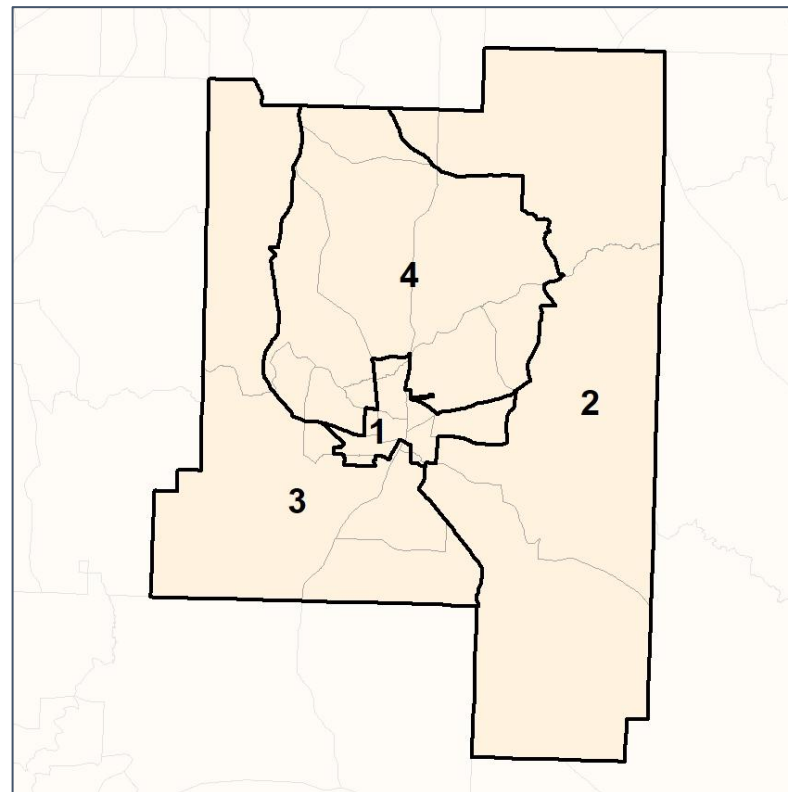
## % Latino by Census Block Group



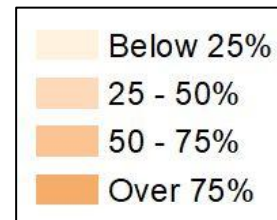

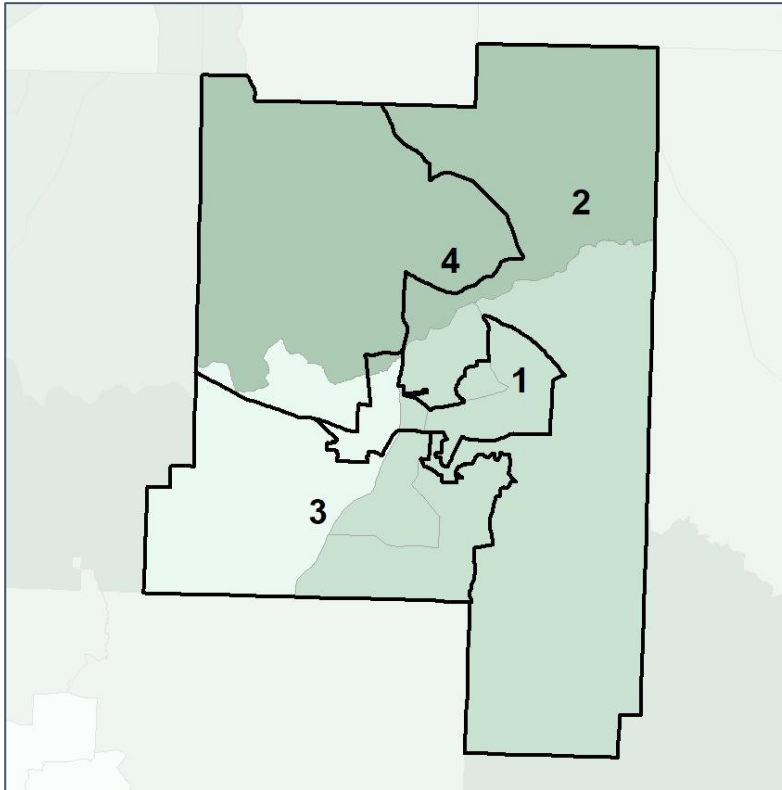

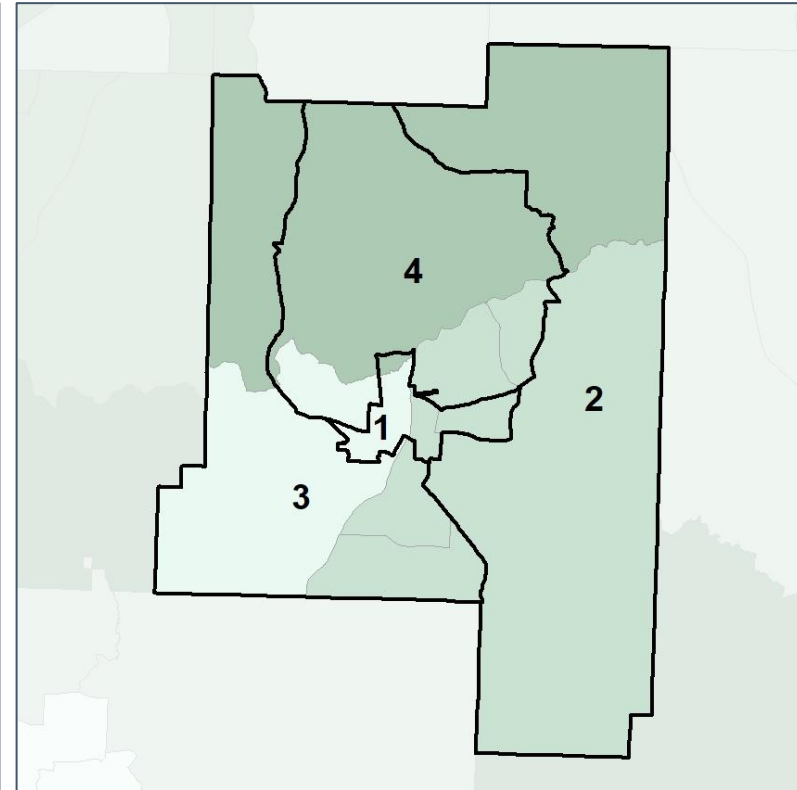
## Median Household Income by Census Tract



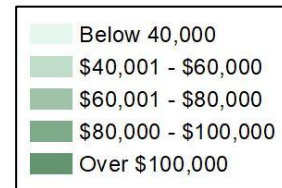

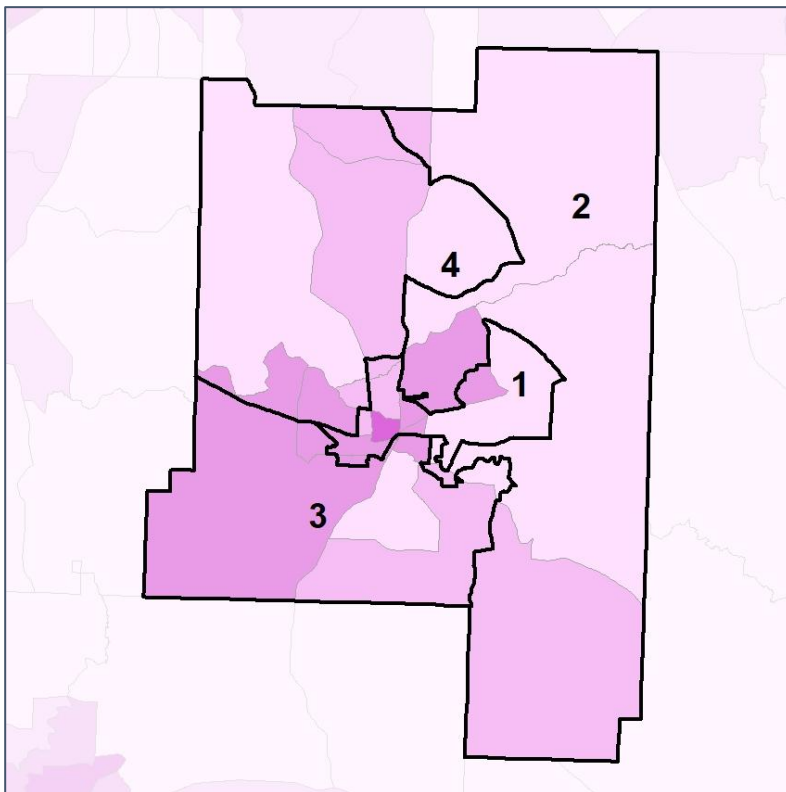

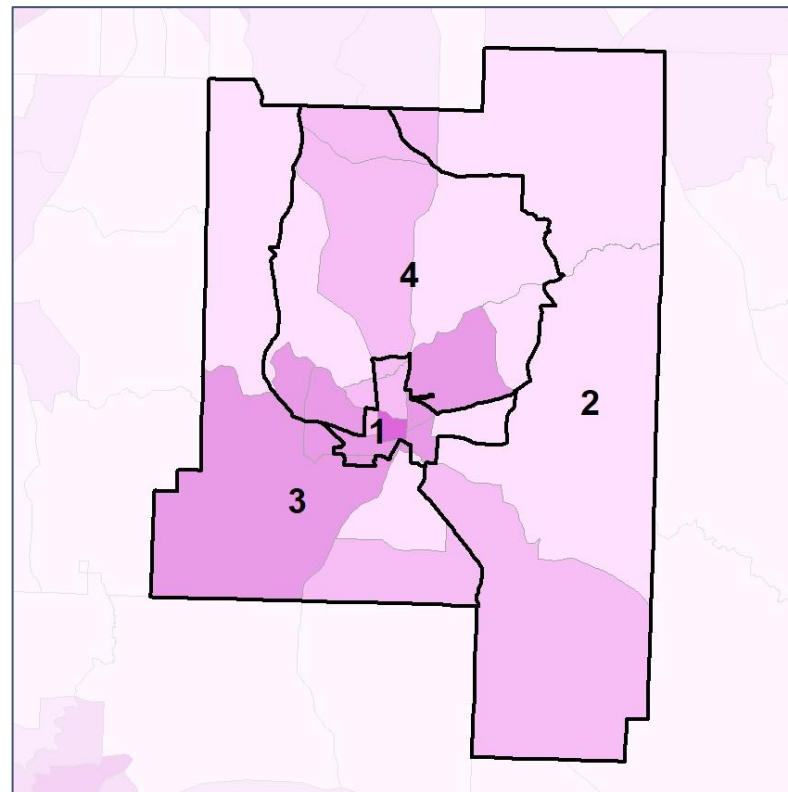
## % Renter by Census Block Group

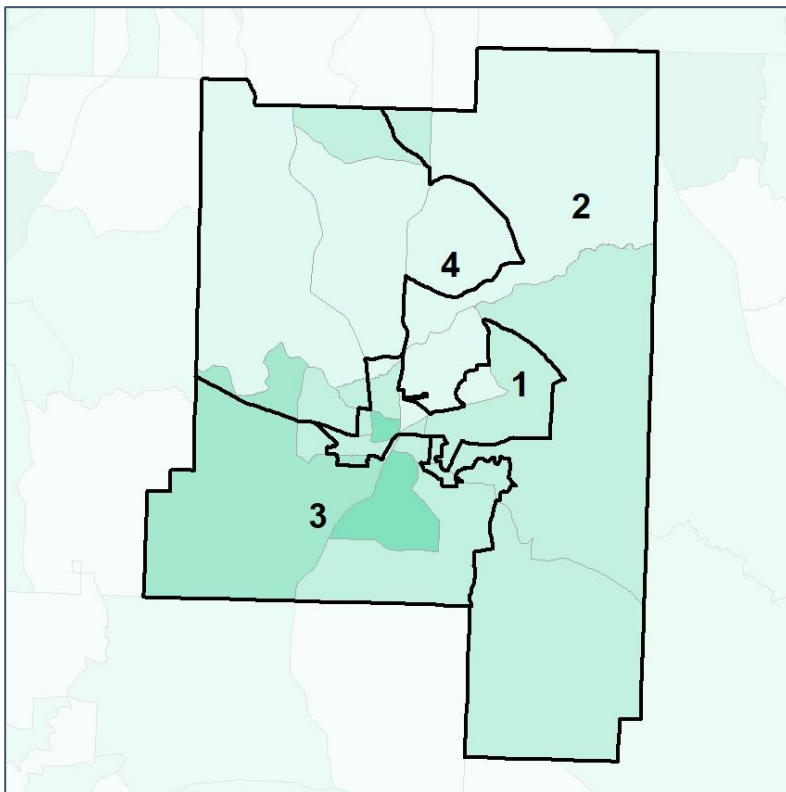

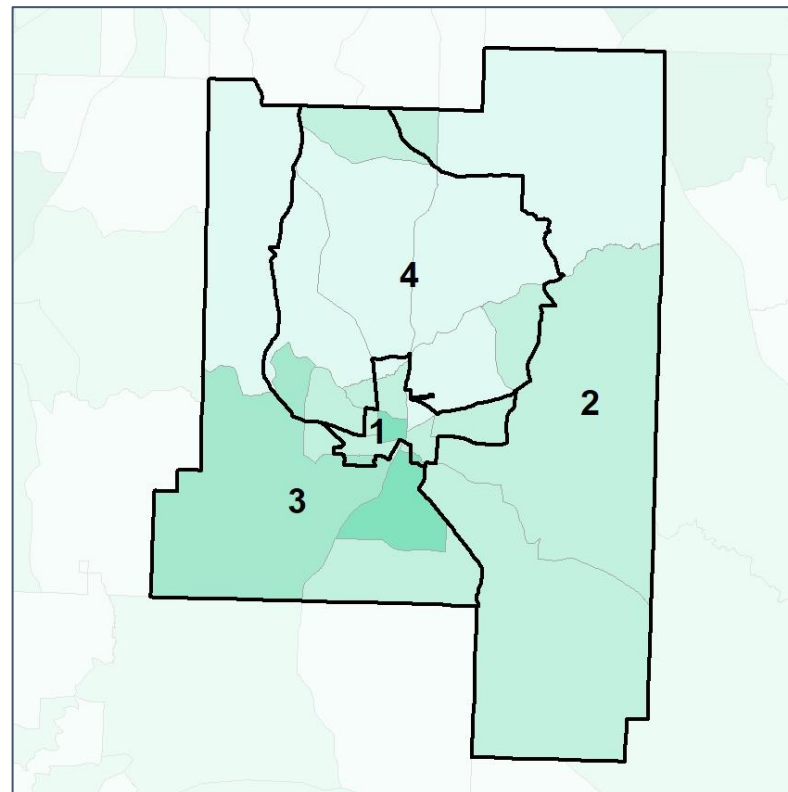
## % Youth (18-34) by Census Block Group
