

### Change in Population in Georgia by County






 Georgia is experience rapid population growth in the Atlanta, Augusta, and Savannah regions of the state

### **Change in Population by Decade**






- Lanier County a surge in population growth from 1990-2010, but since 2010 has had a slight decline




### **Comparison between Lanier County and Georgia**






- Lanier County is <sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> white, while other demographic groups are disproportionately less represented in the county compared to Georgia overall
- However, the demographic breakdown, while smaller, is similar in the county as it is in Georgia





- Lanier County had slight decreases in the share of both the Black and White populations
- Meanwhile, the Latino population had a slight increase in its share of the population, and the Other population more than doubled its share






• Lanier County had higher rates of decline for both the Black and White populations, but saw modest increases in both the Latino and Other populations







### Lanier Co. Commission & School Board Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group






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






