

Change in Population in Georgia by County






 Georgia is experience rapid population growth in the Atlanta, Augusta, and Savannah regions of the state

Change in Population by Decade






- Laurens County has had steady growth in the past several decades

Comparison between Laurens County and Georgia






• Laurens County has a higher share of both Black and White populations compared to Georgia overall, and in turn has smaller Latino, API, and Other populations



- The share of the White population decreased by 4%






- Communities of color grew in Laurens County, however they all had slower rates of increase compared to Georgia overall, with the exception of the Other population


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
Laurens County Commission Net Gain in Population (2010 - 2020) by Census Block Group 2012 Map 2022 Map*





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


Laurens County Commission Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group






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




Laurens County School Board Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group







Median Household Income by Census Tract






