



## **Population Gain Change in Population by Decade**






- Lee County had an explosion in population growth from 1970-1990, and still has seen significant growth since then

## **Demographics**Comparison between Lee County and Georgia






- Lee County is disproportionately White, and the only other demographic that at least matches the percentage of Georgia overall os the Other demographic

# **Demographics**2010 vs 2020 Demographics in Lee County






- Lee County has had significant increase in the share of people of color, especially the Other population








- Lee County had significant increases in all demographic groups, exceeding the growth rate that Georgia had in all groups, except for the API population






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
## Lee Co. Commission & School Board Net Gain in Population (2010 - 2020) by Census Block Group








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
## Lee Co. Commission & School Board Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group
