



Population Gain Change in Population by Decade






- Since 1970, Long County has had an above population growth above the statewide and national average

DemographicsComparison between Long County and Georgia






- Long County has a slight higher White population when compared to the statewide average

Demographics2010 vs 2020 Demographics in Long County






- Long County's Black and API population increased by 1% while "other" population increased by 4%

DemographicsPopulation Change by Race (2020 - 2010)






- Long County API, Black, and "other" population growth resembles that of the statewide average while the Latino population is growing at a slower rate









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Long Co. Commission & School Board Net Gain in Population (2010 - 2020)











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



Long Co. Commission & School Board Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group












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Long Co. Commission & School Board Population Density by Race












