

Change in Population in Georgia by County






 Georgia is experience rapid population growth in the Atlanta, Augusta, and Savannah regions of the state

Change in Population by Decade






- Madison County had significant growth from 1960-2000
- While it has continued to grow, it has slowed to make the last two decades the slowest growth for the county since it started growing in 1960




Comparison between Madison County and Georgia






- Madison County is over ¾ White, with the only other demographic group at least matching its percentage statewide being the Other demographic
- The Black community in Madison County is less than a ¹/₃ of the share in Madison County compared to its share in Georgia's overall population





- Madison County's share of the White population decreased significantly in the past decade
- The Black and Latino populations both increased, while the share of the API population doubled, and the share of the Other population quadrupled






- Madison County had similar trends in growth and decline rates as Georgia overall, with all demographic groups except the White population growing
- However, the changes in Madison County were more pronounced, with all communities of color increasing at higher rates in the county than in Georgia overall, while the White population decreased at a higher rate than in Georgia overall







Median Household Income by Census Tract


