

Change in Population in Georgia by County






 Georgia is experience rapid population growth in the Atlanta, Augusta, and Savannah regions of the state

Change in Population by Decade






- Miller County has varied between population growth and decline, but had its lowest decline in population in 90 years
- The decline in population in the past 2 decades, despite being small, is the first time there was 2 straight decades of decline for the county since 1960




Comparison between Miller County and Georgia






- Miller County is $\frac{2}{3}$ White and nearly $\frac{1}{3}$ Black, having a very small share of the remaining demographic groups
- While it is disproportionately White, the county does have a similar share of the Black population as Georgia does overall





- Miller County had a slight decline in its share of the White population
- Meanwhile, there was a slight increase in the share of the Black population, and a doubling of the share of the Other population to 2%






- Miller County had very little change in population overall, but did see significant decline in the White population
- While it is a small overall number, the rate of increase for the Latino population was higher than in Georgia overall










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Miller Co. Commission & School Board Net Gain in Population (2010 - 2020) by Census Block Group






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


Miller Co. Commission & School Board Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group






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










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


% Black by Census Block Group






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% Latino by Census Block Group






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Median Household Income by Census Tract






