Change in Population in Georgia by County



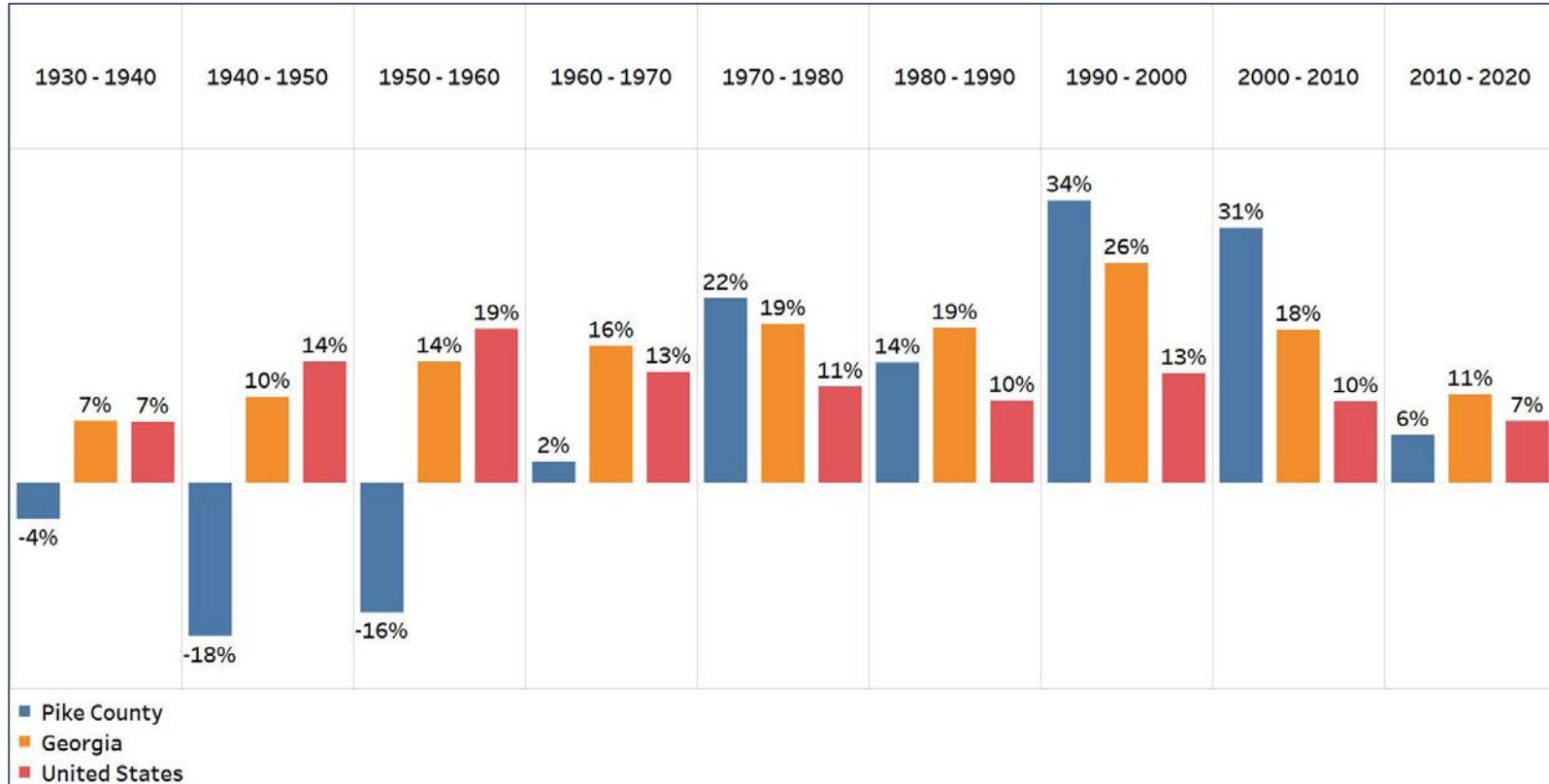
- Georgia is experiencing rapid population growth in the Atlanta, Augusta, and Savannah regions of the state

Change in Population by Decade

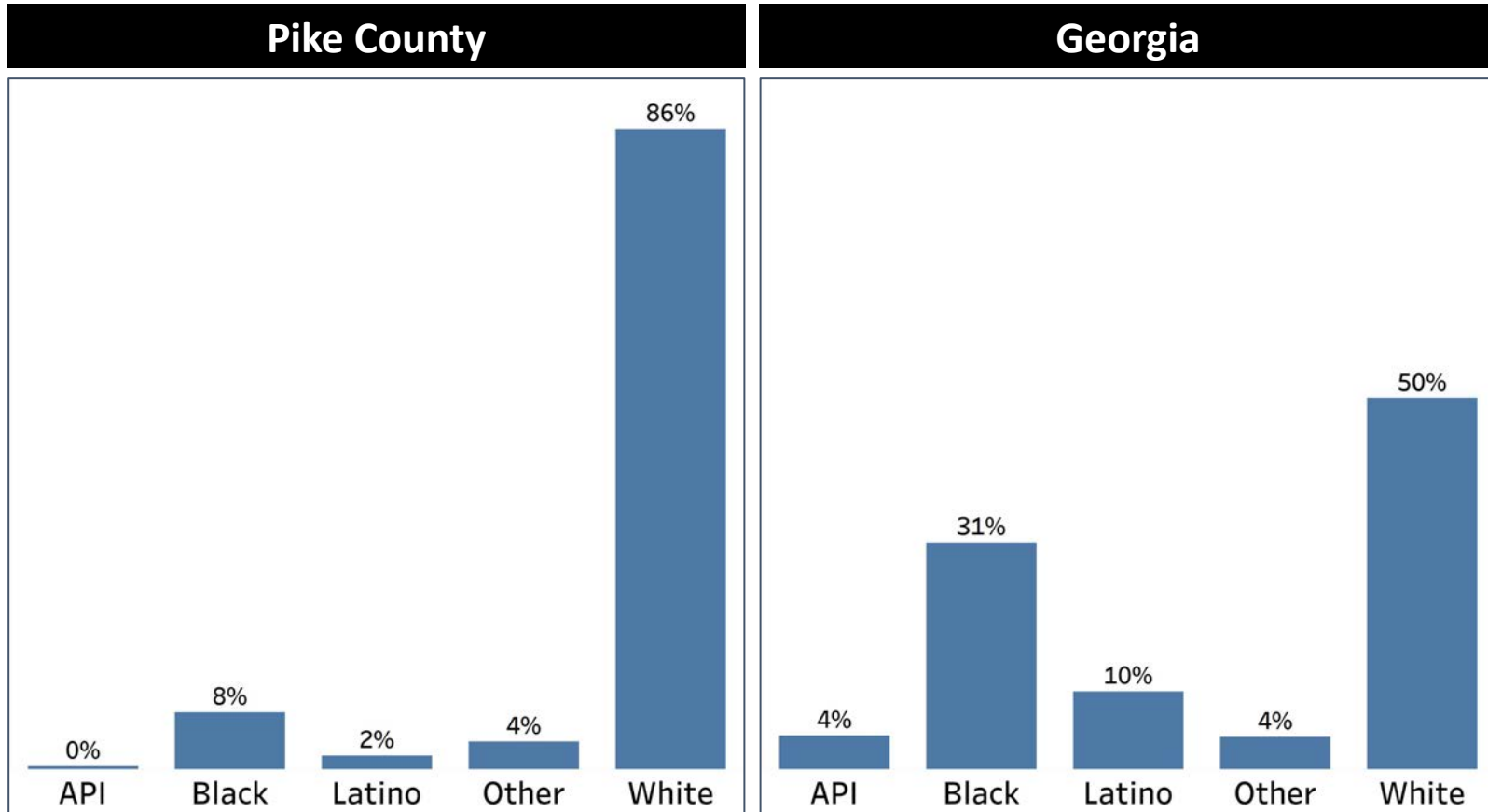


- Pike County had a significant period of growth from 1970-2010

Comparison between Pike County and Georgia

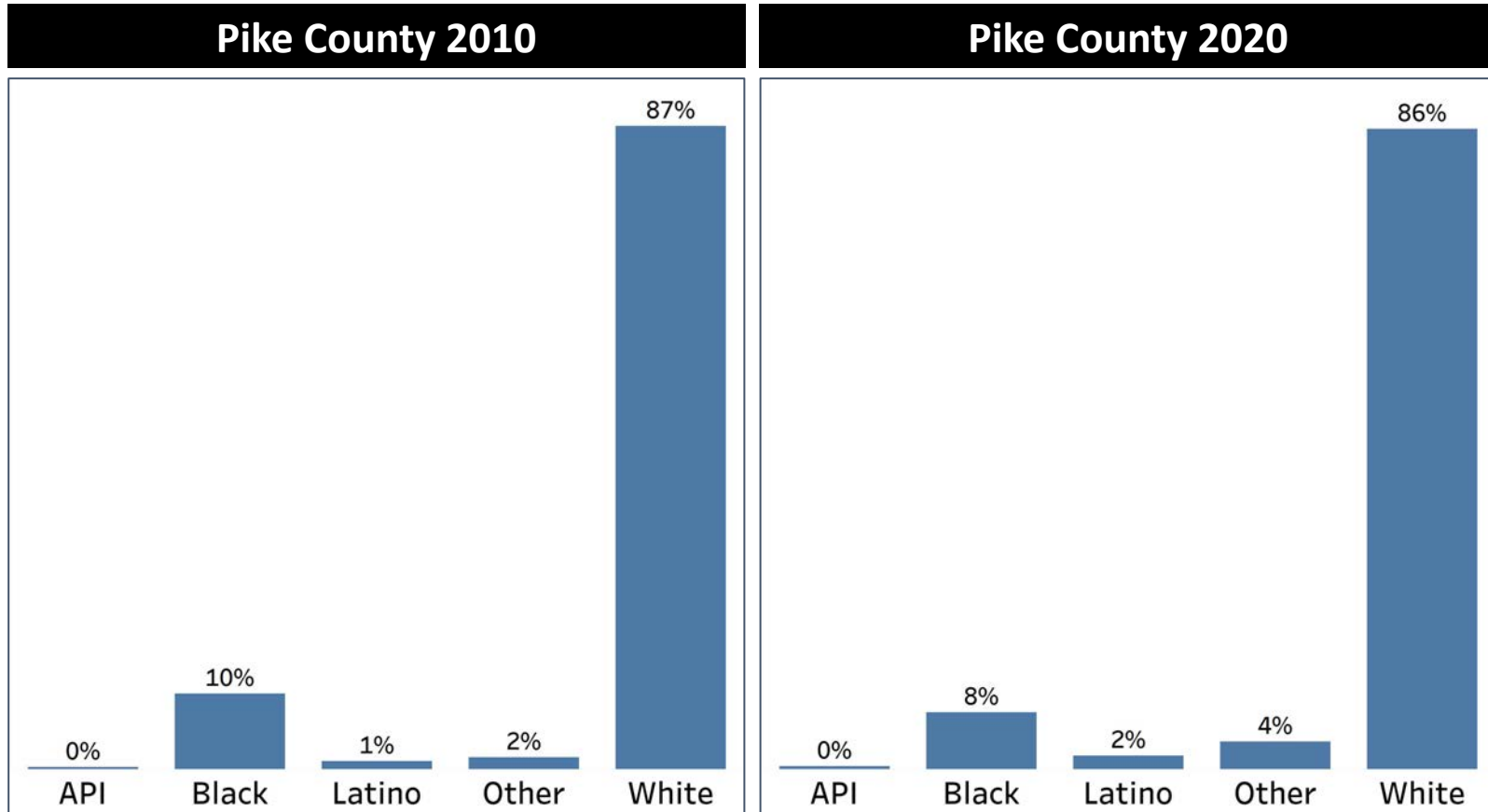


- Pike County is overwhelmingly White, with only 16% of the population identifying as people of color

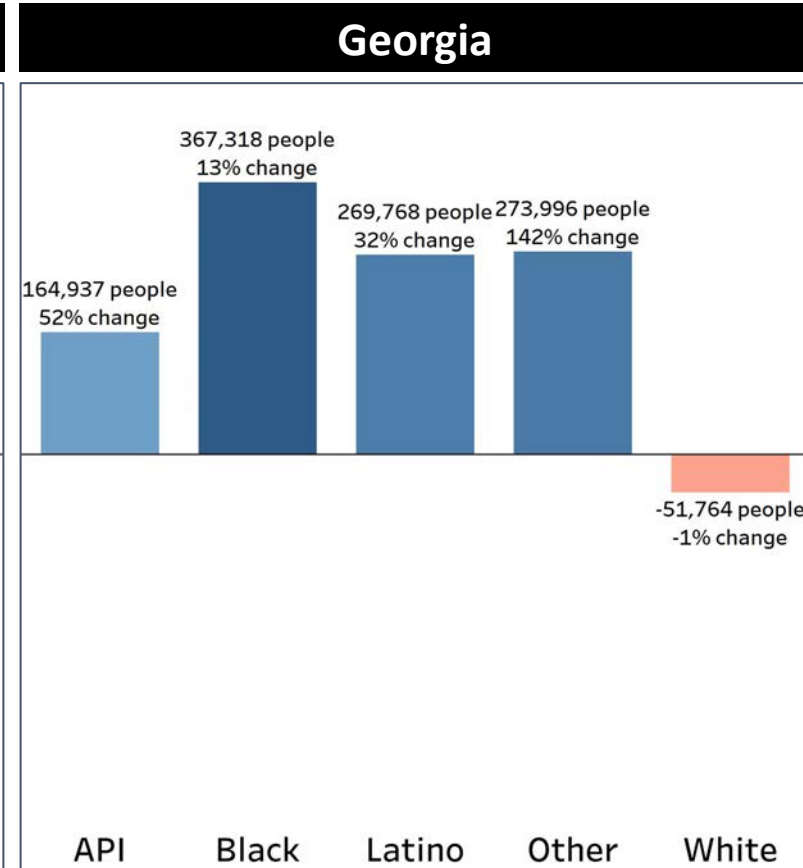
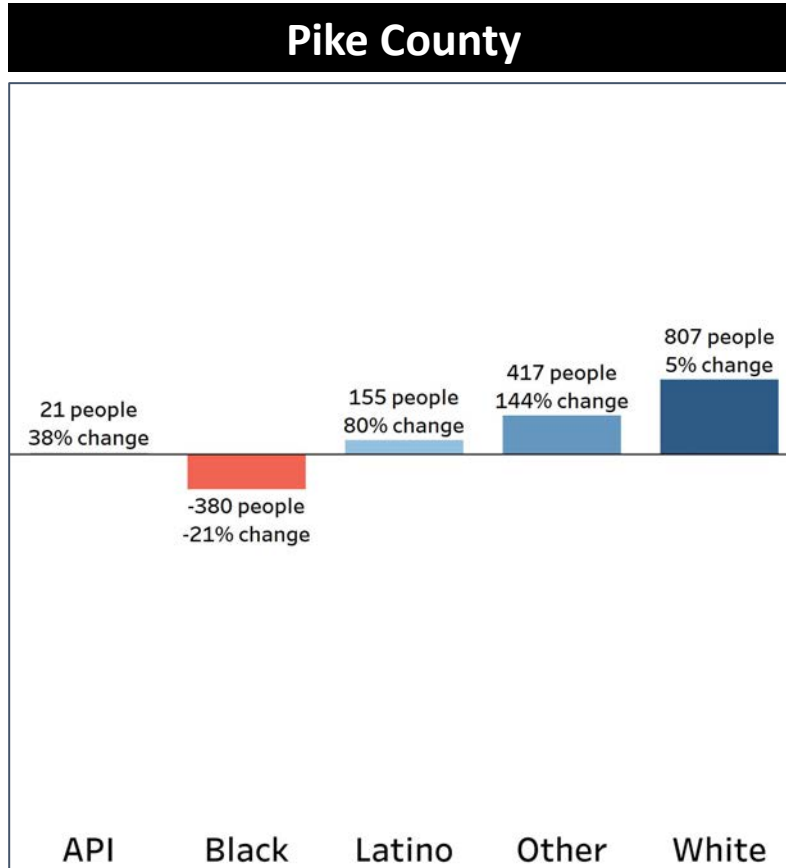


- Pike County had a slight decline in its share of the White population and a relatively significant decline in its share of the black population

- The White population increased as well, as opposed to it decreasing overall in Georgia, while the Black population had the opposite occur, declining relatively significantly in the past decade

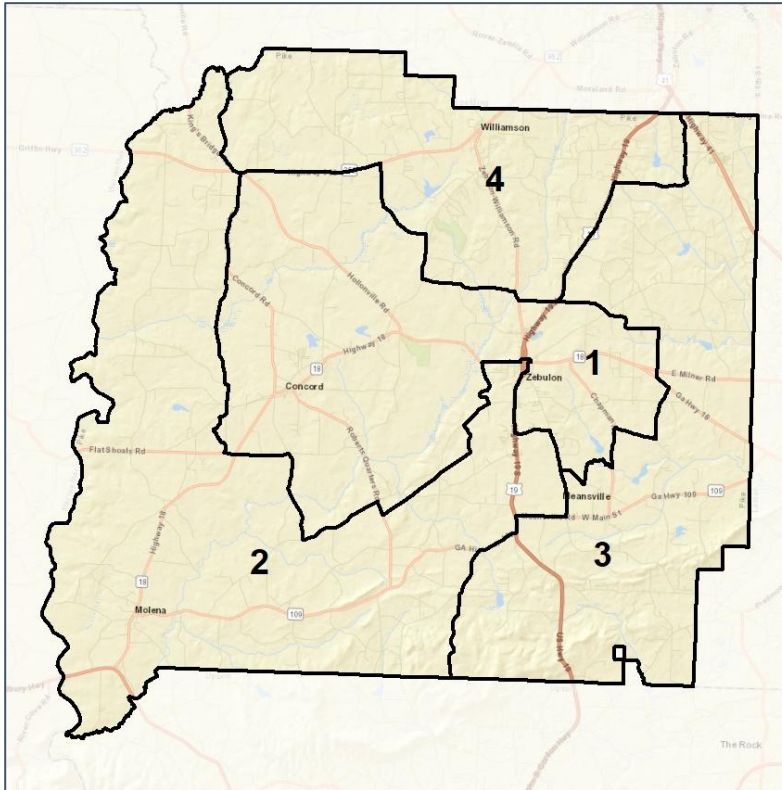

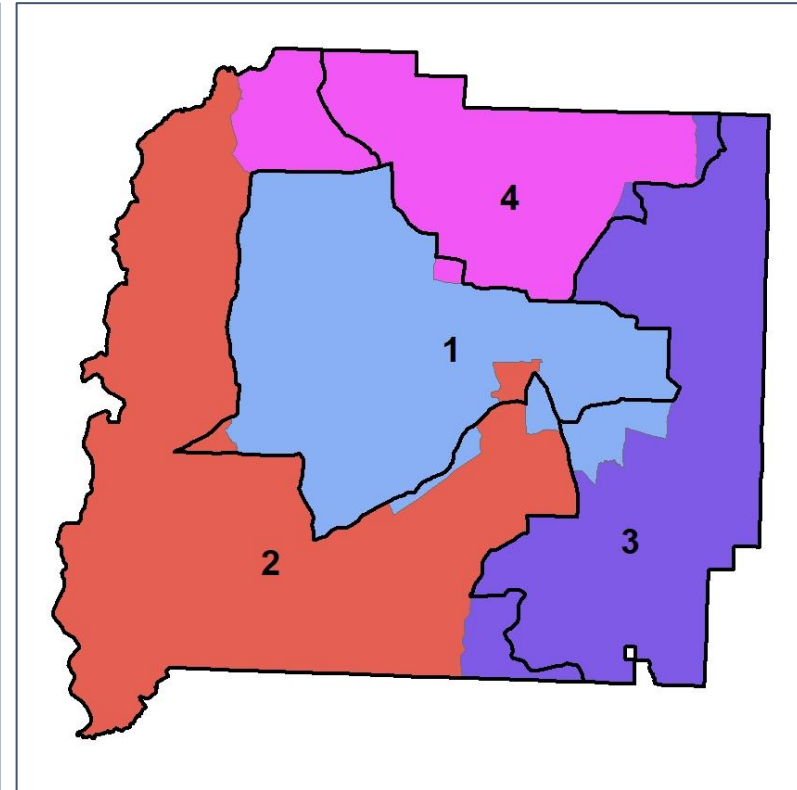
Changes in Redistricting

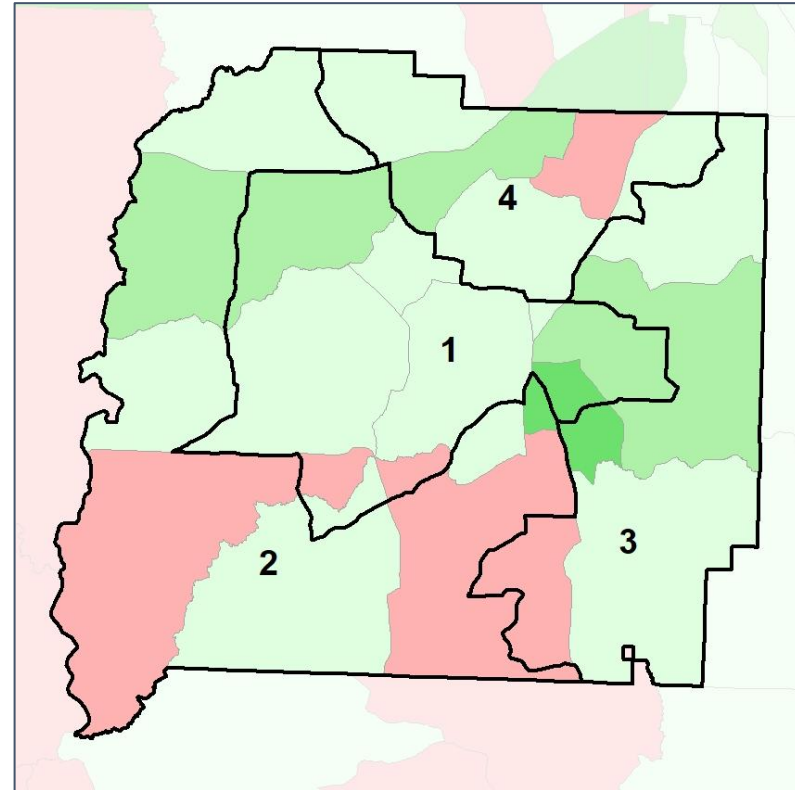
Net Gain in Population (2010 - 2020) by Census Block Group

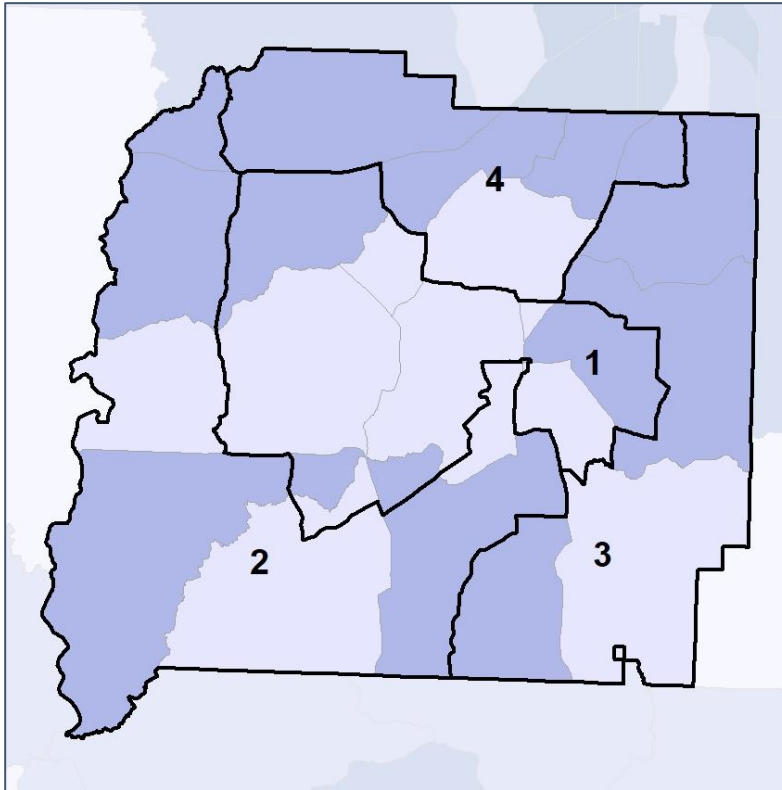

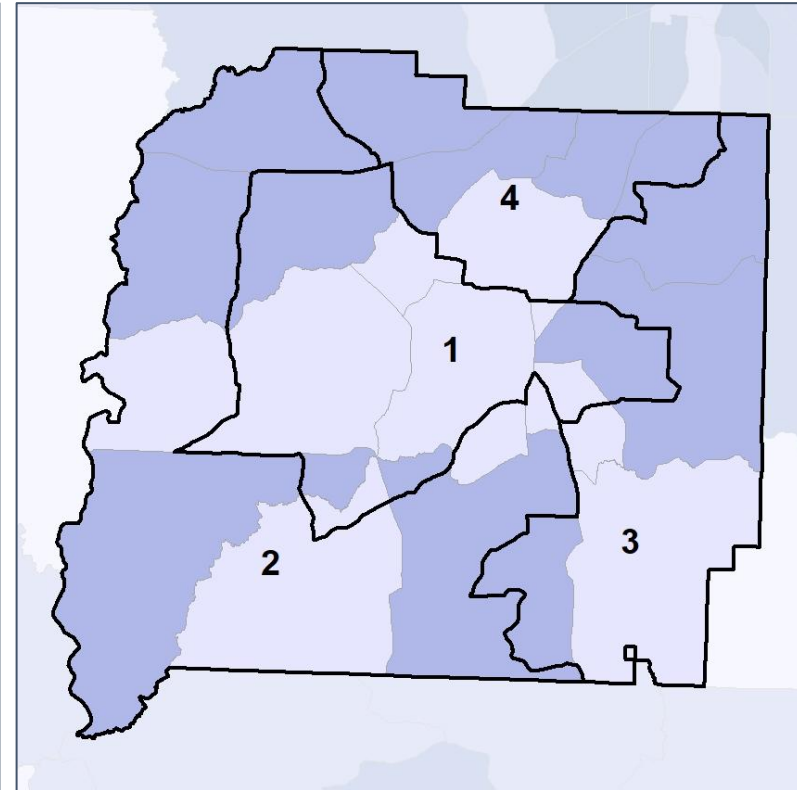
Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group



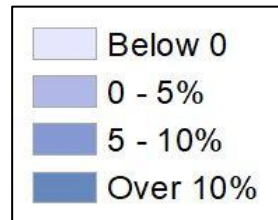

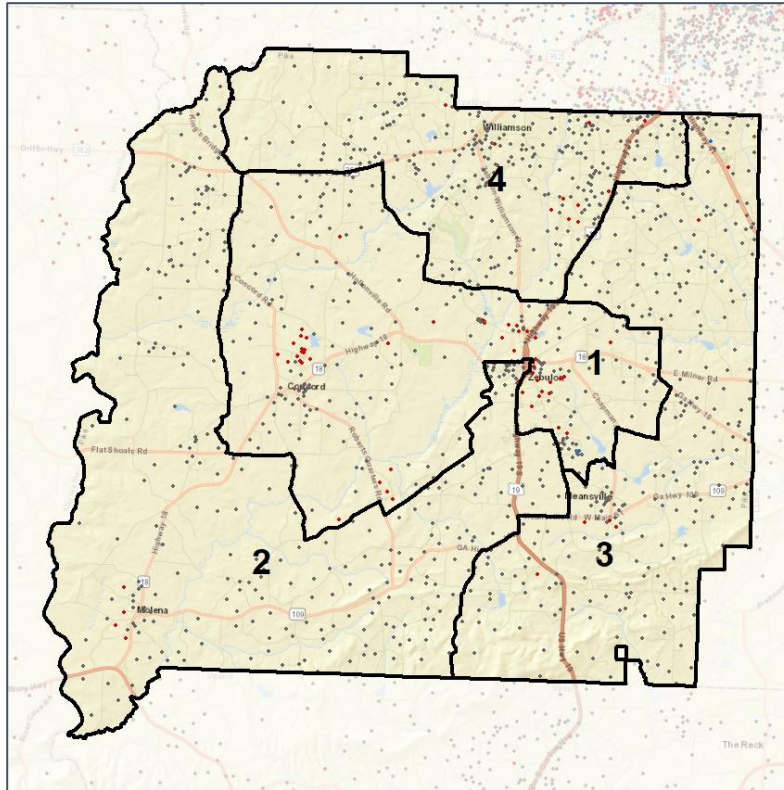

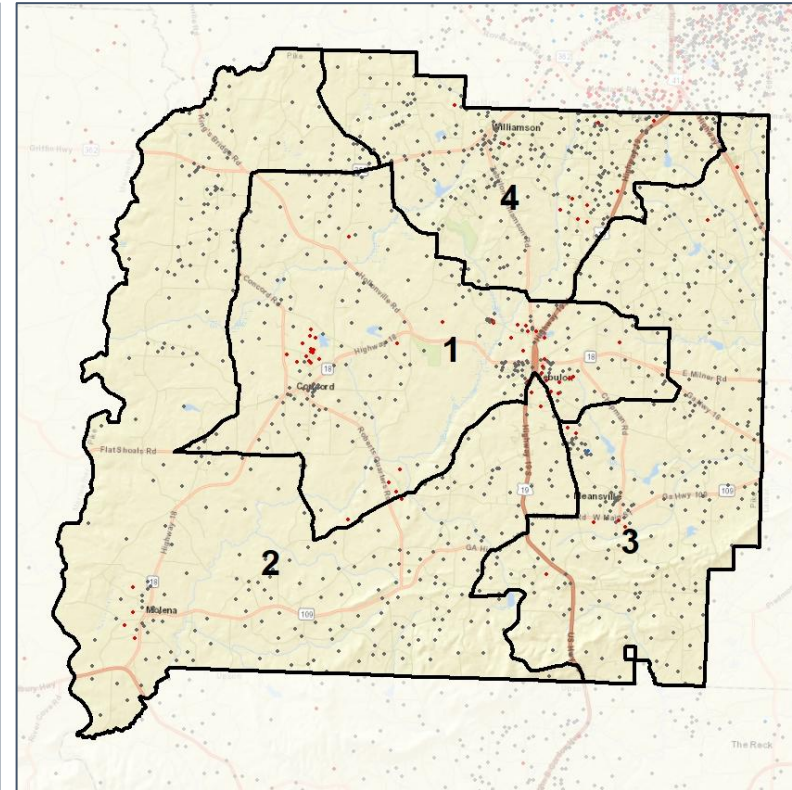
Population Density by Race



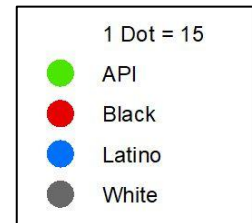

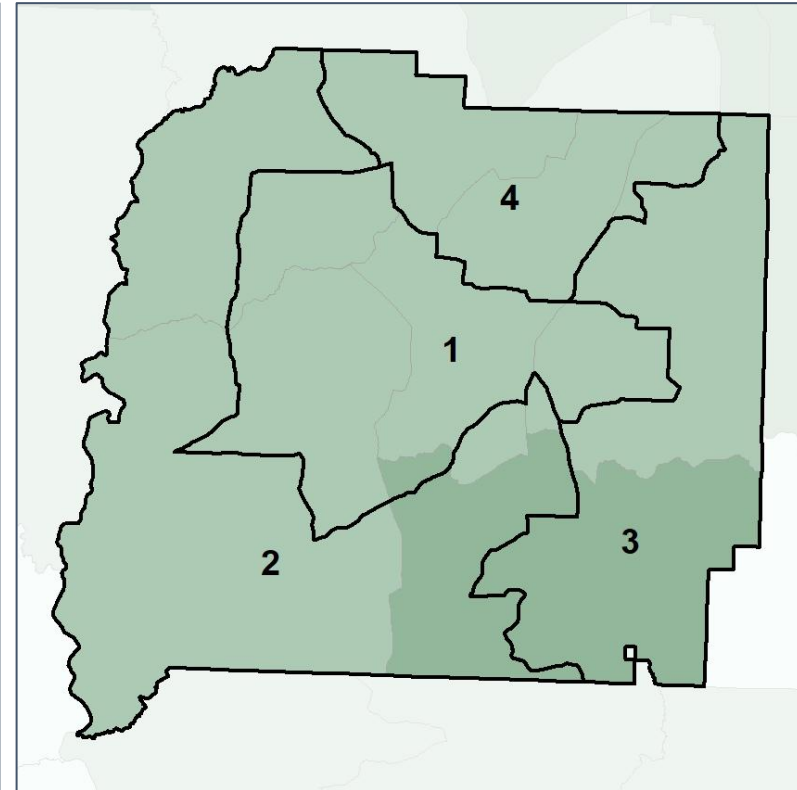
Median Household Income by Census Tract



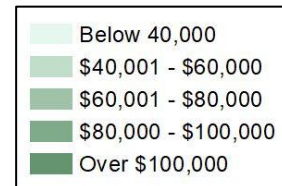

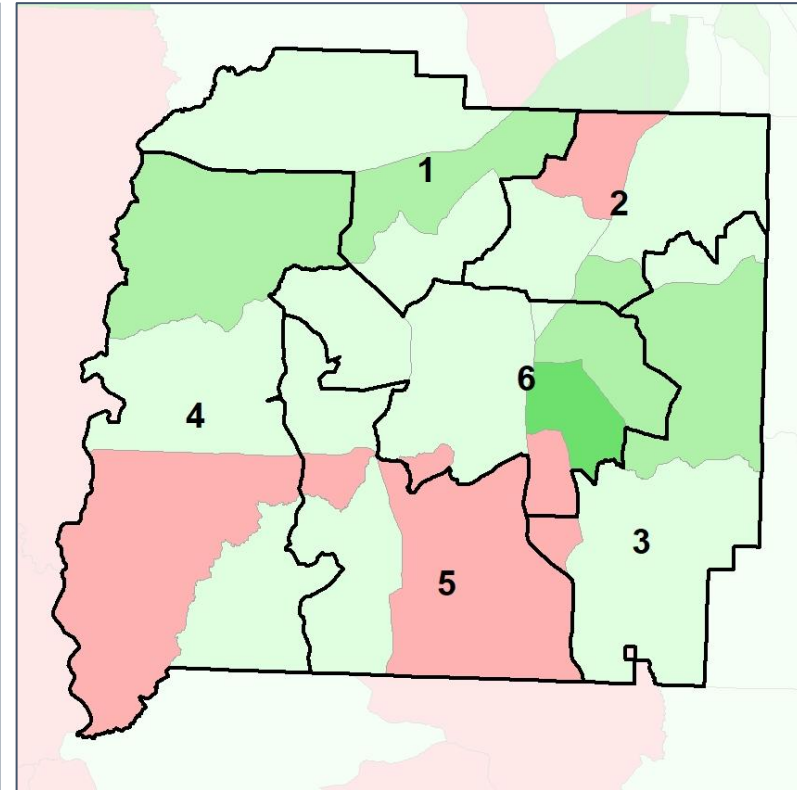
Net Gain in Population (2010 - 2020) by Census Block Group

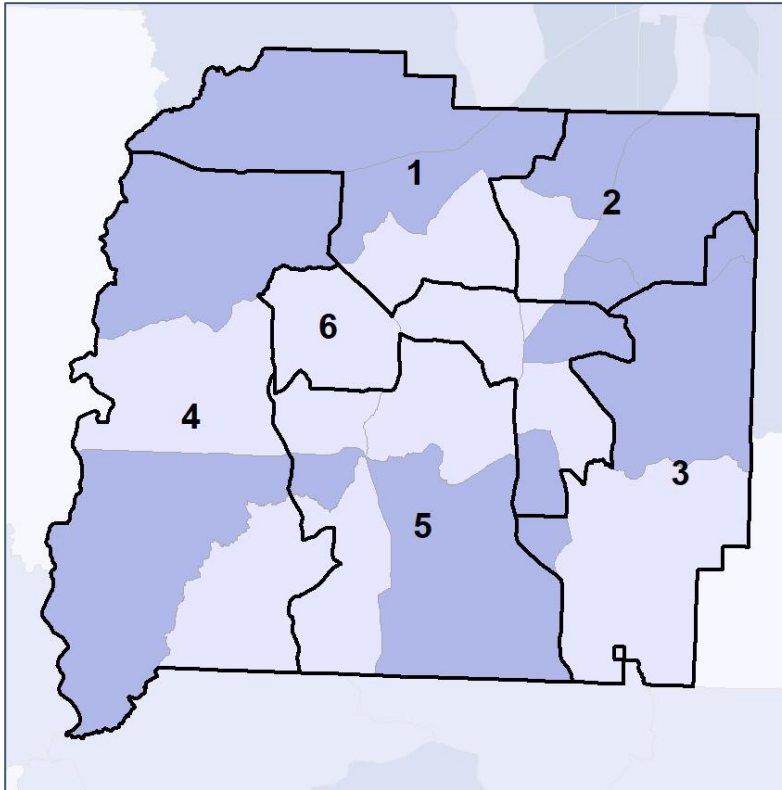

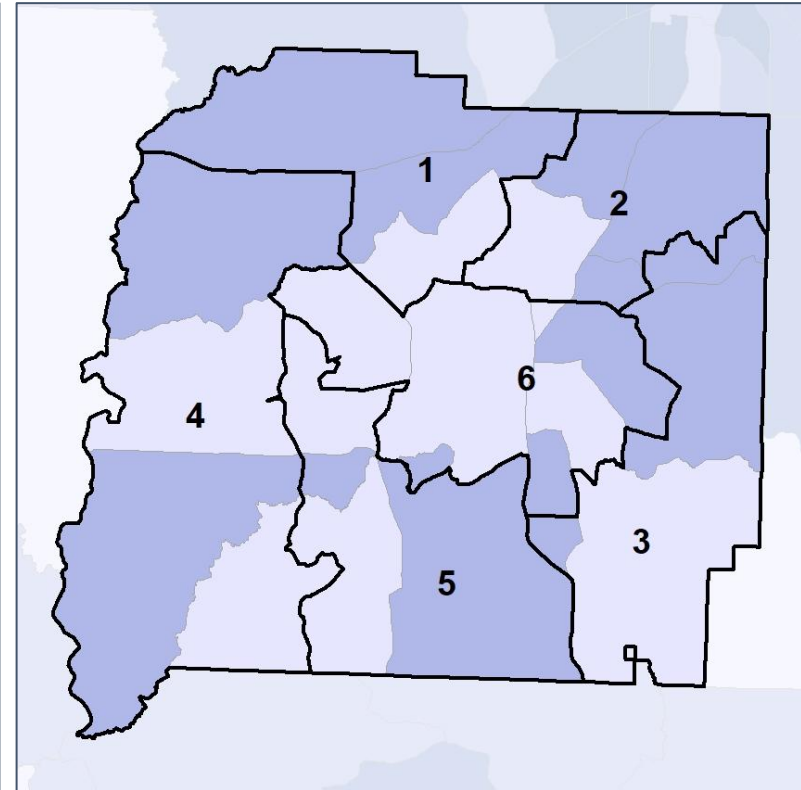
Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group

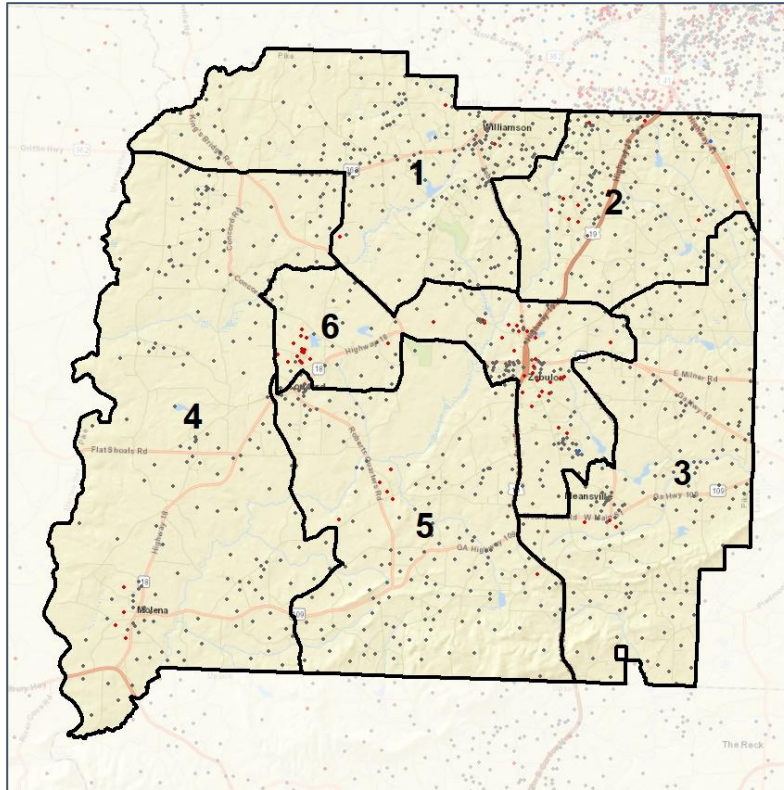

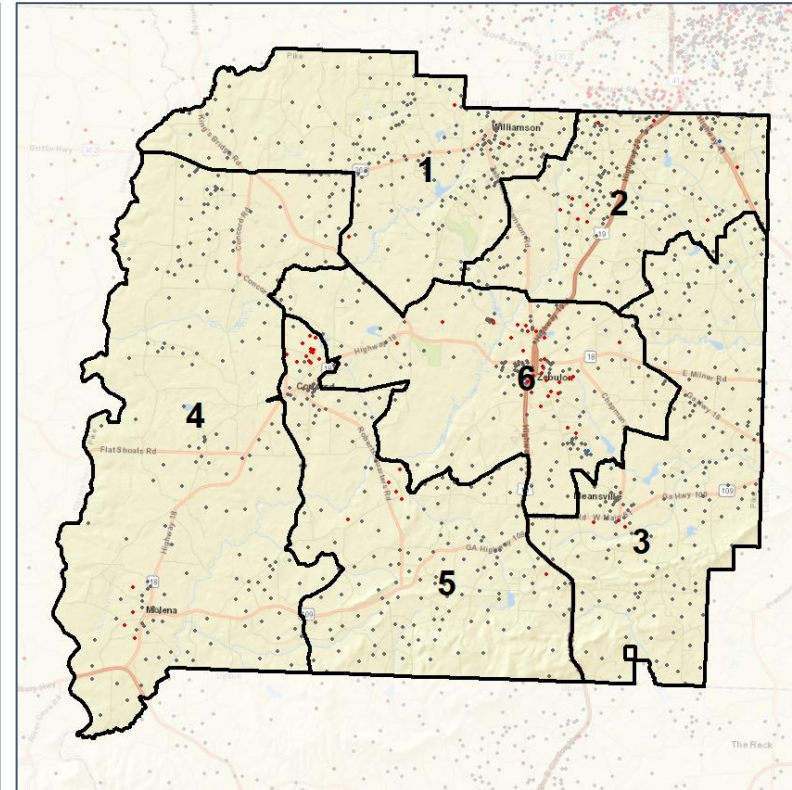
Population Density by Race



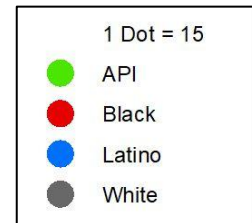

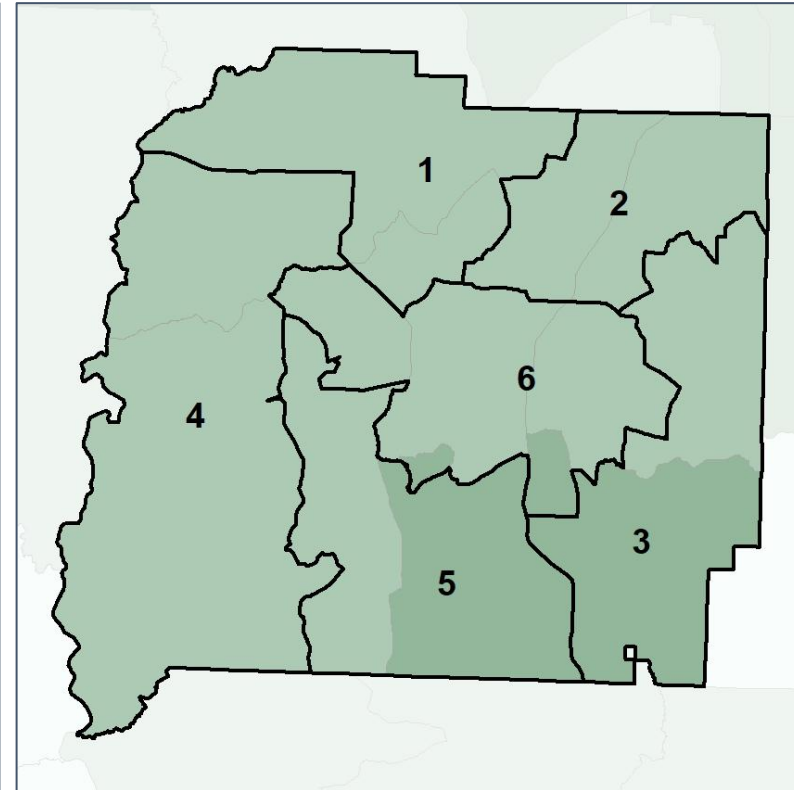
Median Household Income by Census Tract



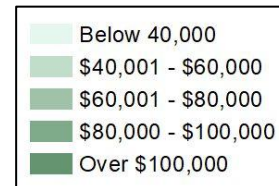
