## Change in Population in Georgia by County



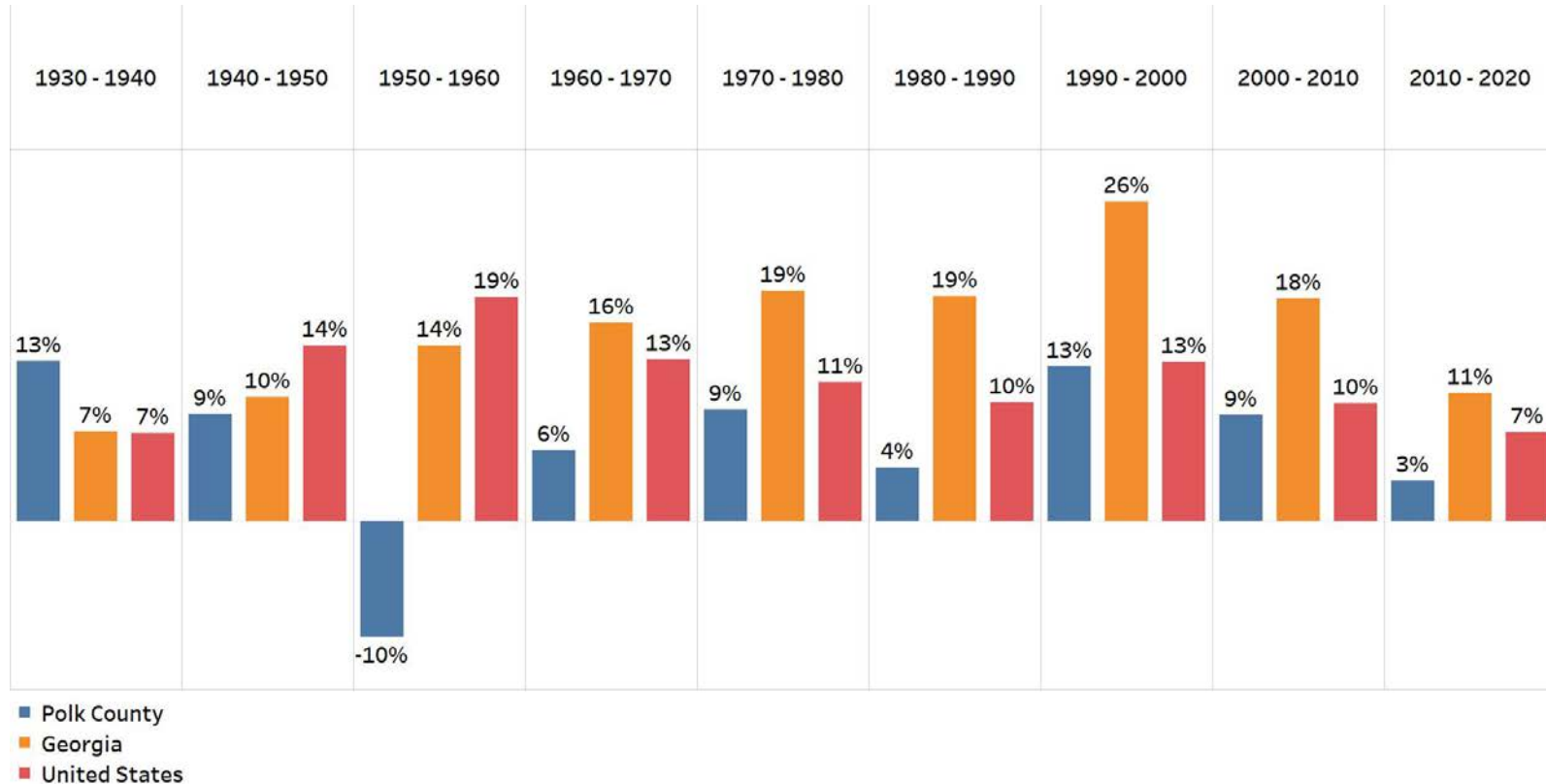
- Georgia is experiencing rapid population growth in the Atlanta, Augusta, and Savannah regions of the state

## Change in Population by Decade

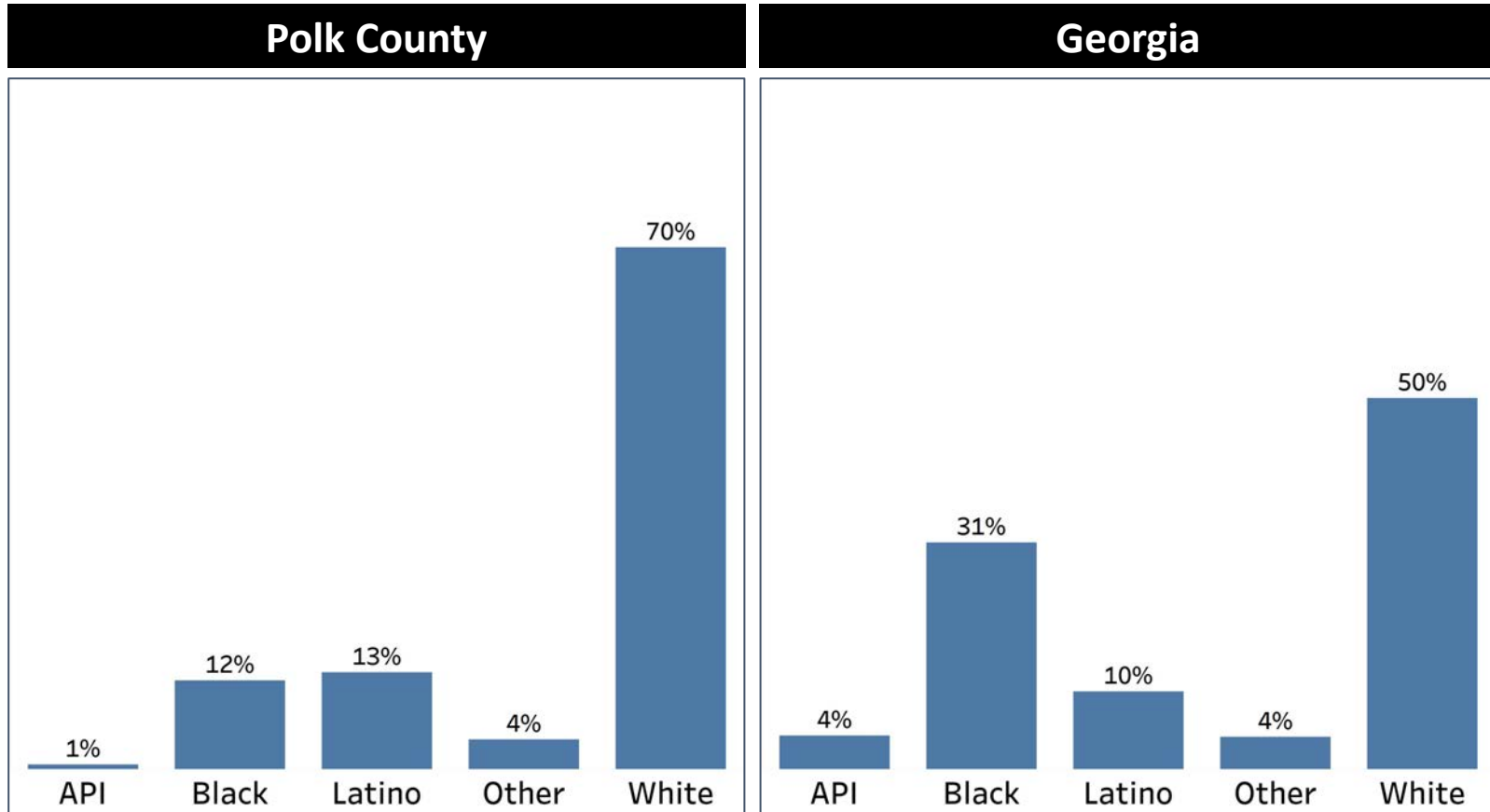


- Polk County has a period of growth since 1960, but this growth has always been lower than the growth in Georgia overall

- The Other population also has the same share of the county as Georgia overall

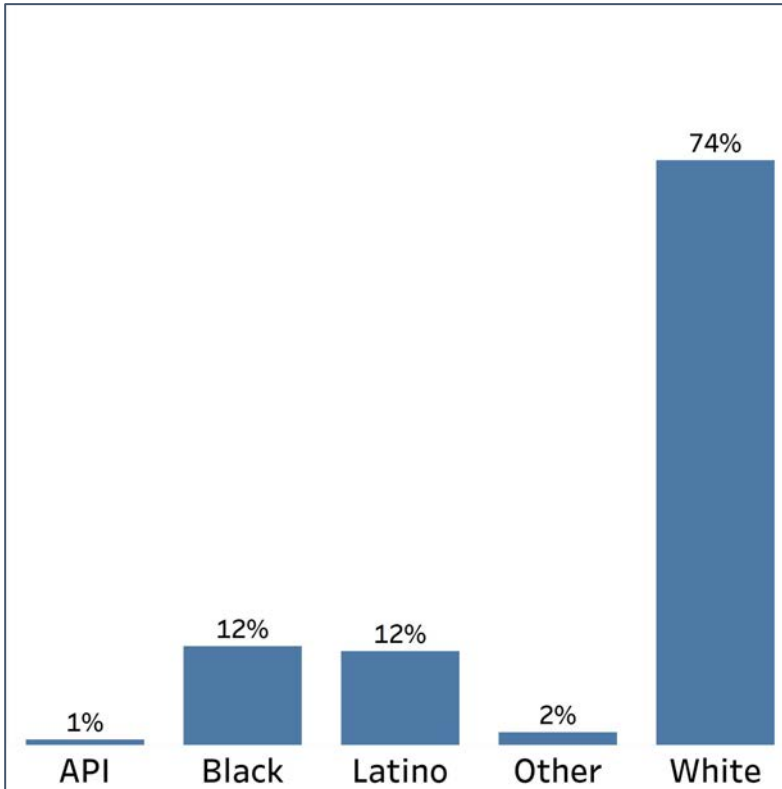

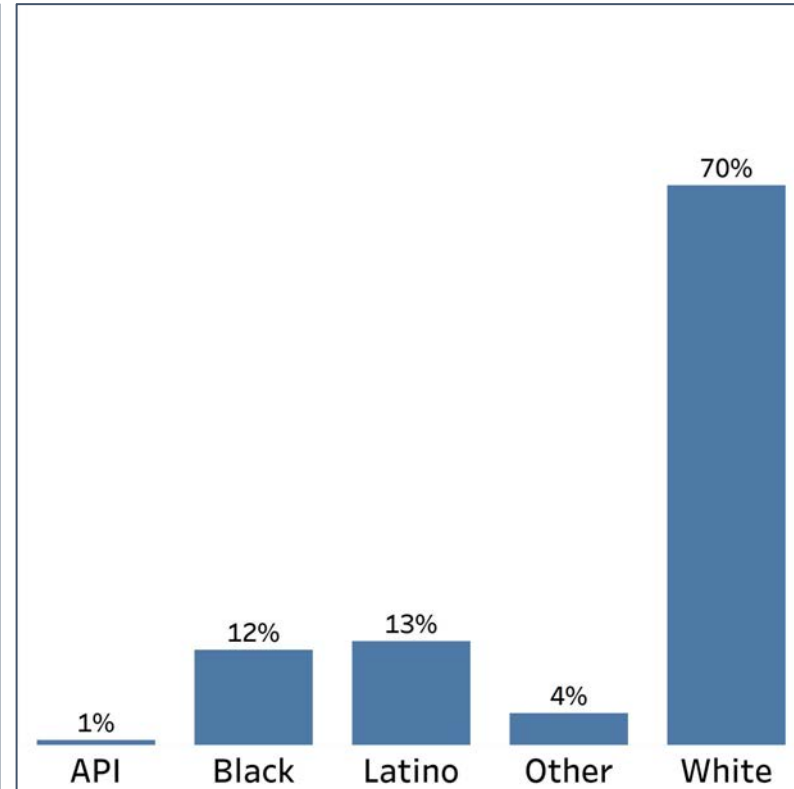
## 2010 vs 2020 Demographics in Polk County

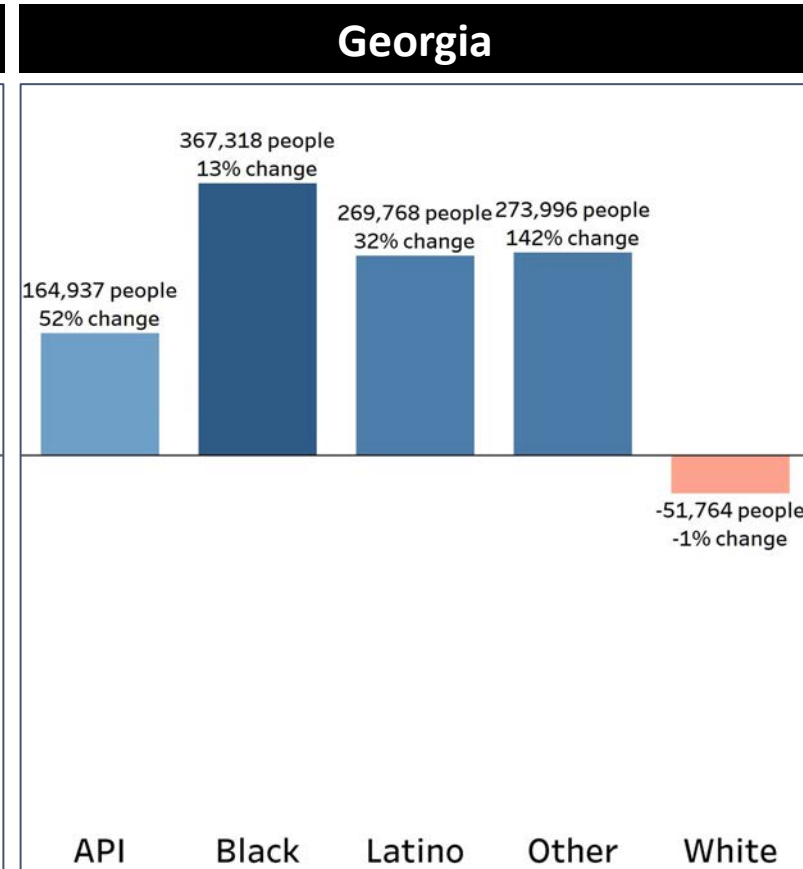
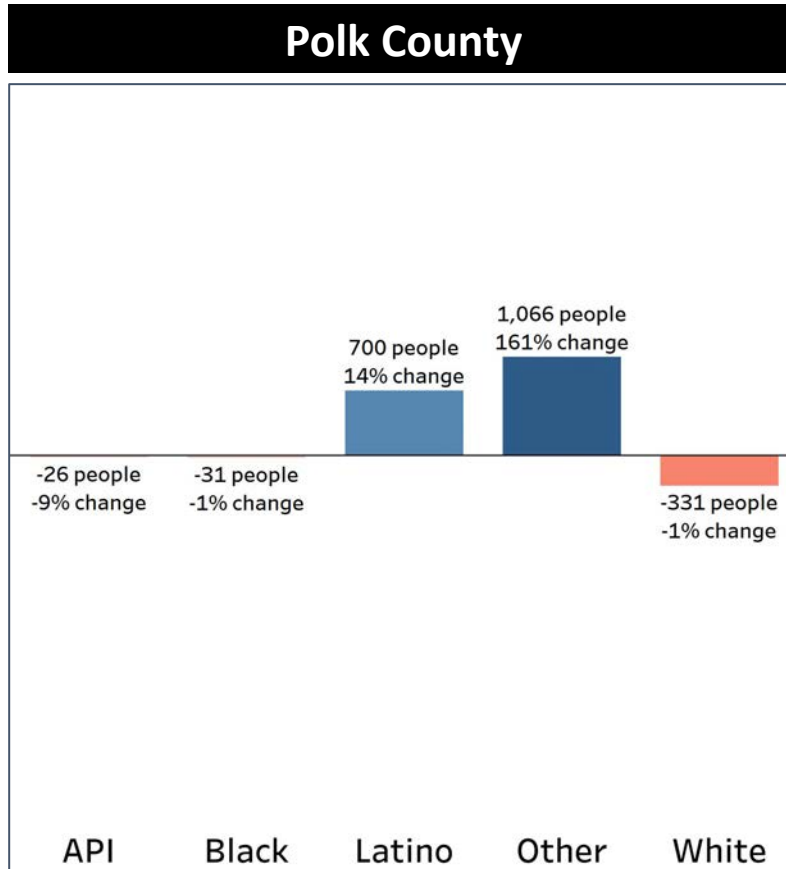


- The share of the White population in Polk County declined in the past decade, while the Latino population increased slightly and the Other population doubled

## Population Change by Race (2020 - 2010)



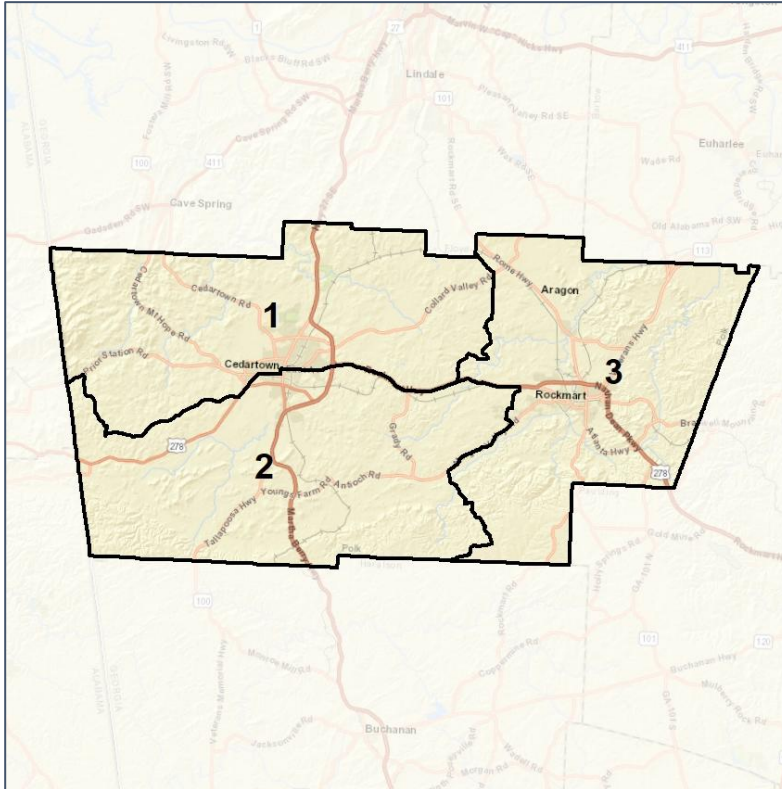
- Polk County had the most significant changes in the Latino and Other populations, although only the Other population had a higher rate of increase compared to Georgia overall

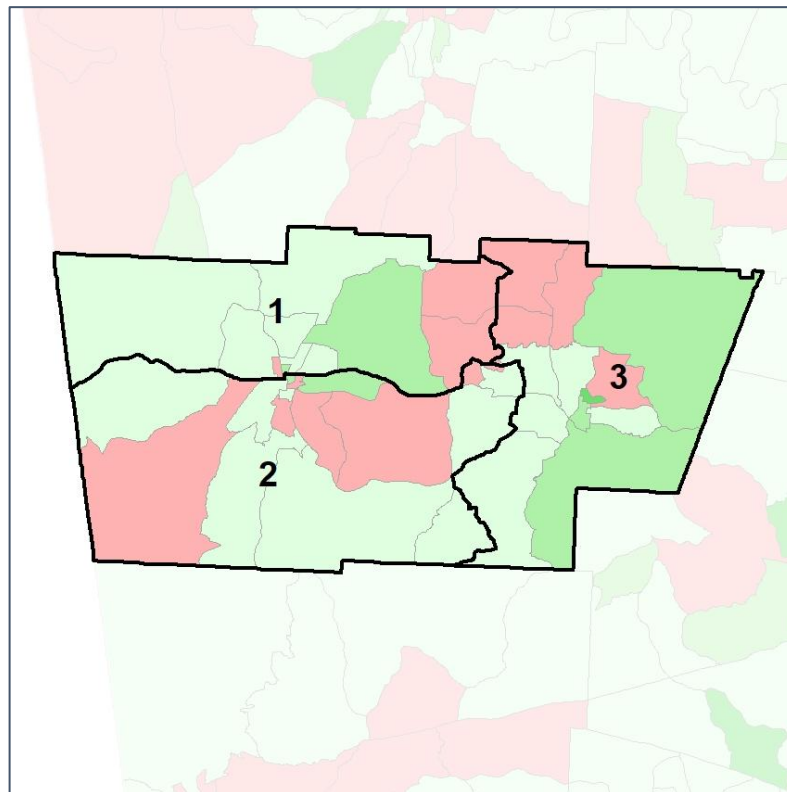
## Net Gain in Population (2010 - 2020) by Census Block Group

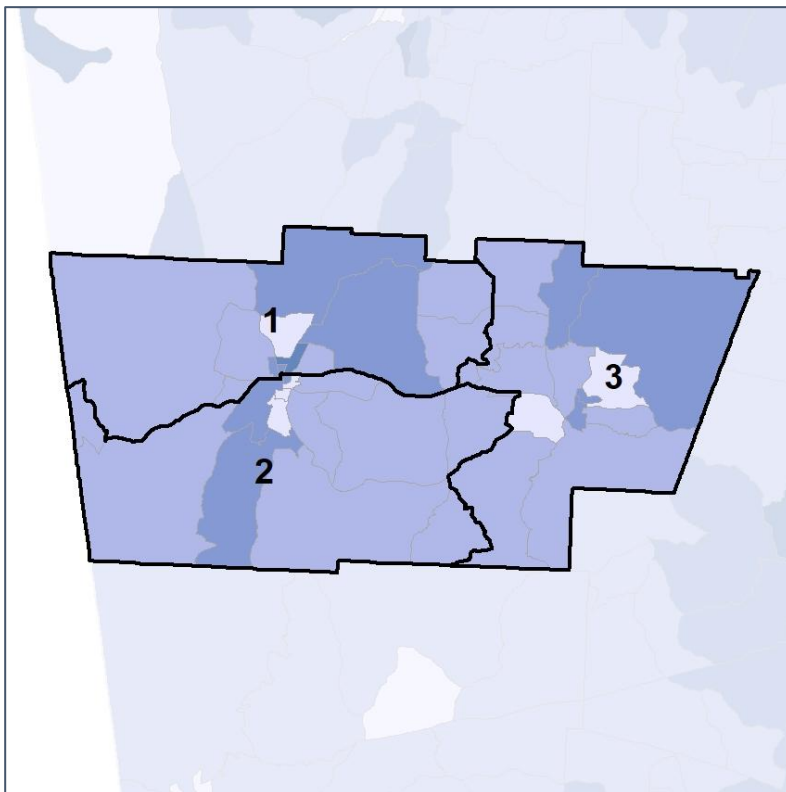

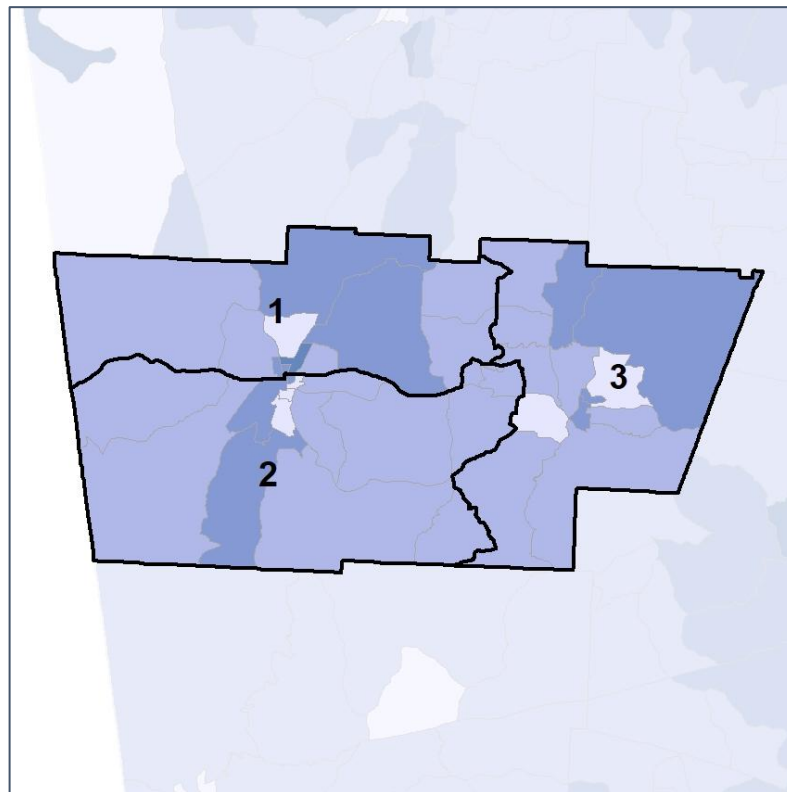
## Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group

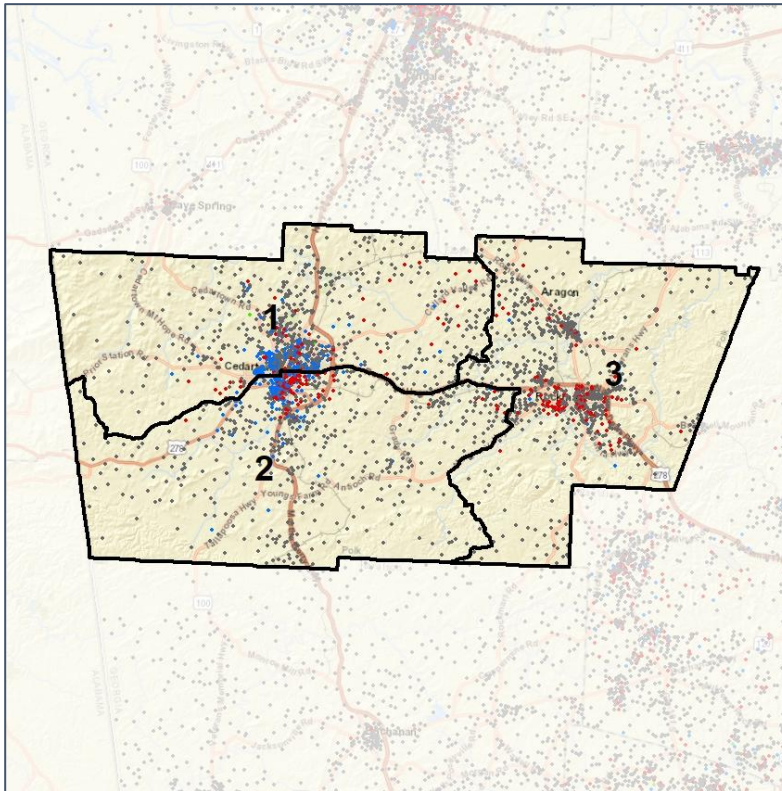

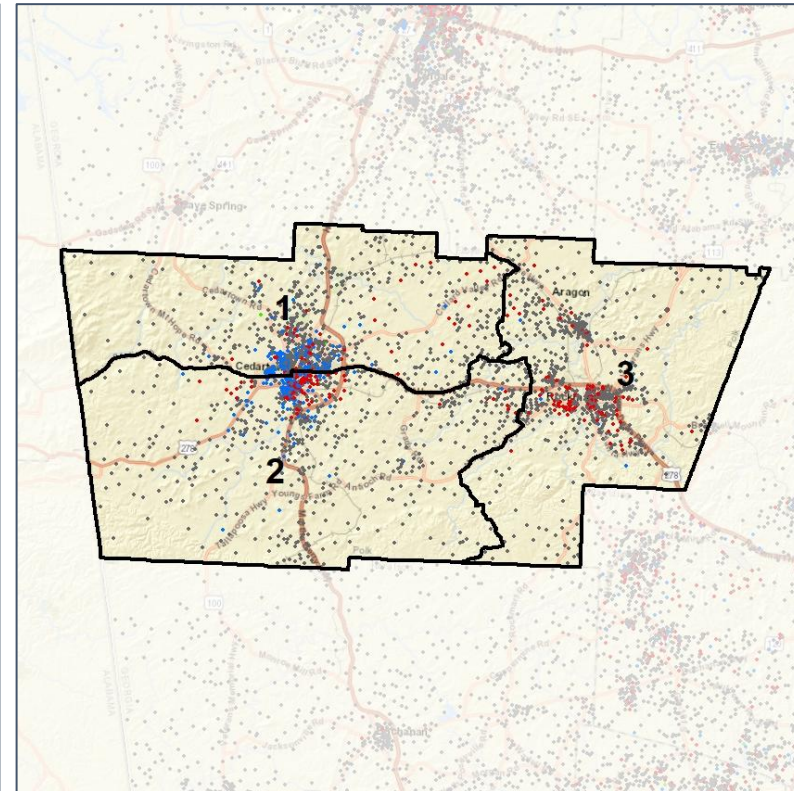
## Population Density by Race



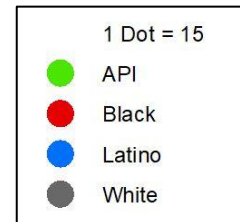

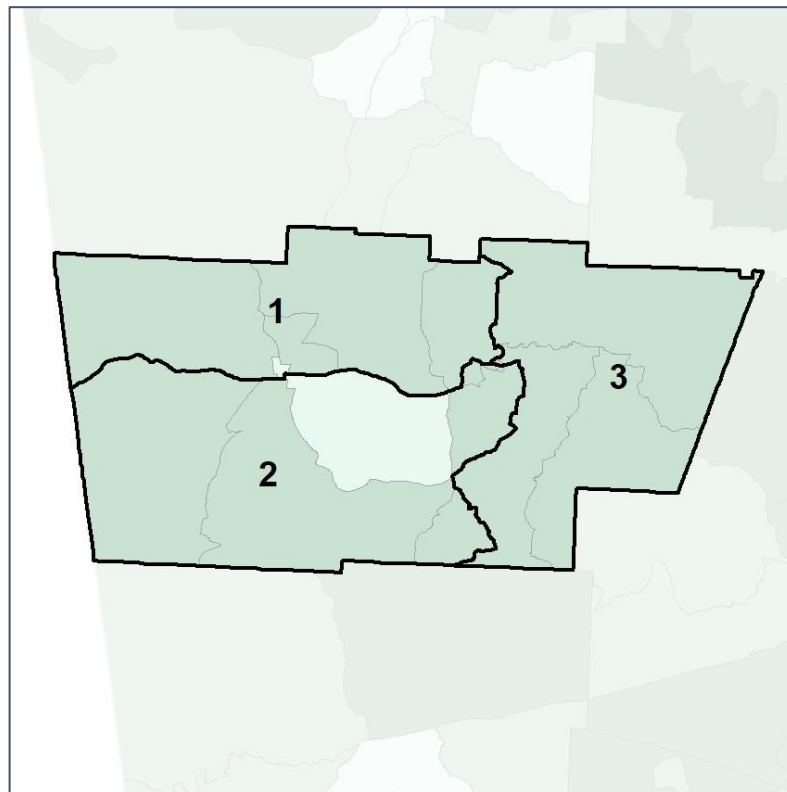
## Median Household Income by Census Tract



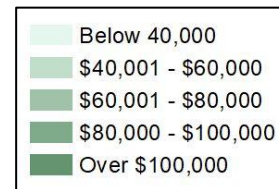

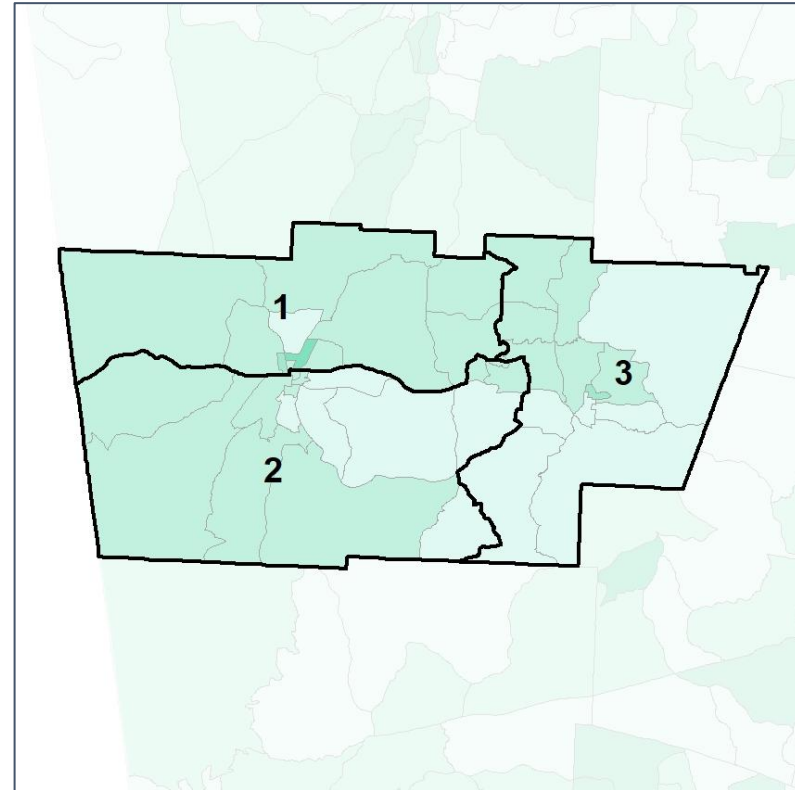
## % Youth (18-34) by Census Block Group

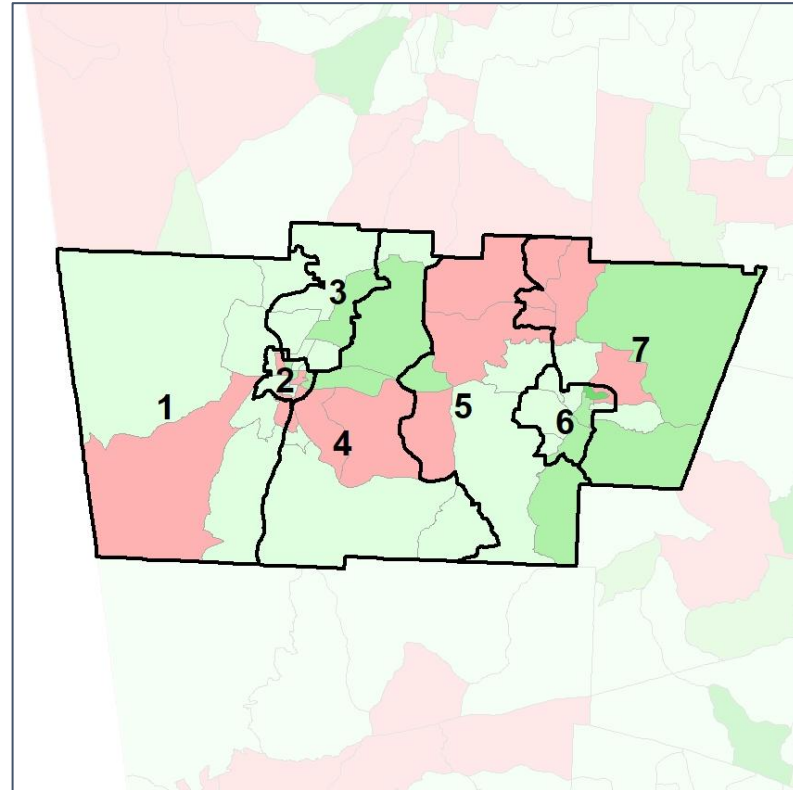
## Net Gain in Population (2010 - 2020) by Census Block Group



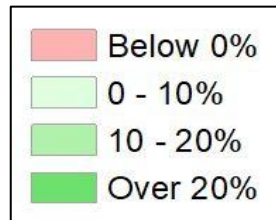

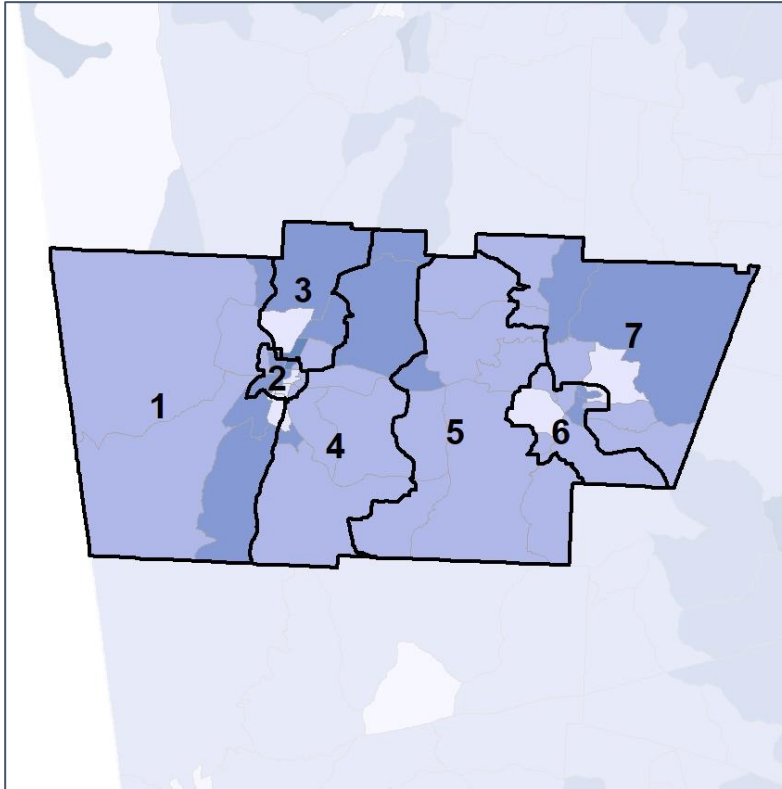

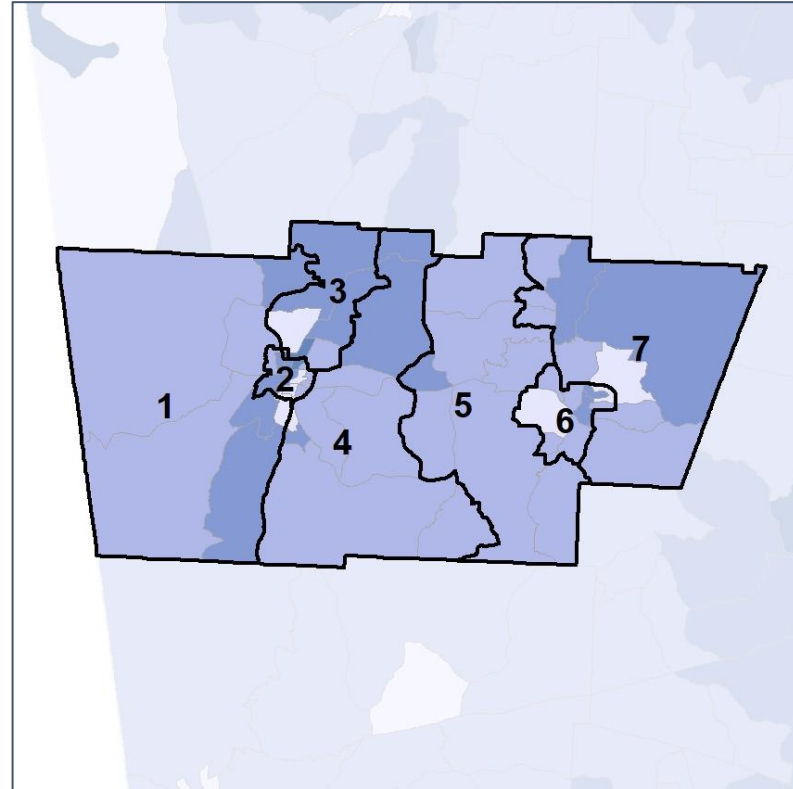
## Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group

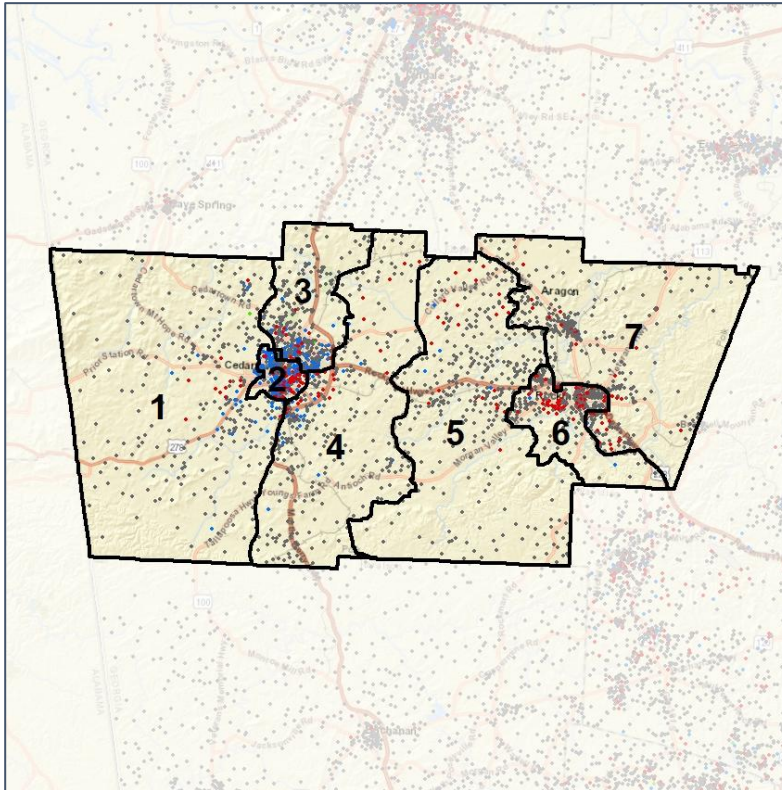

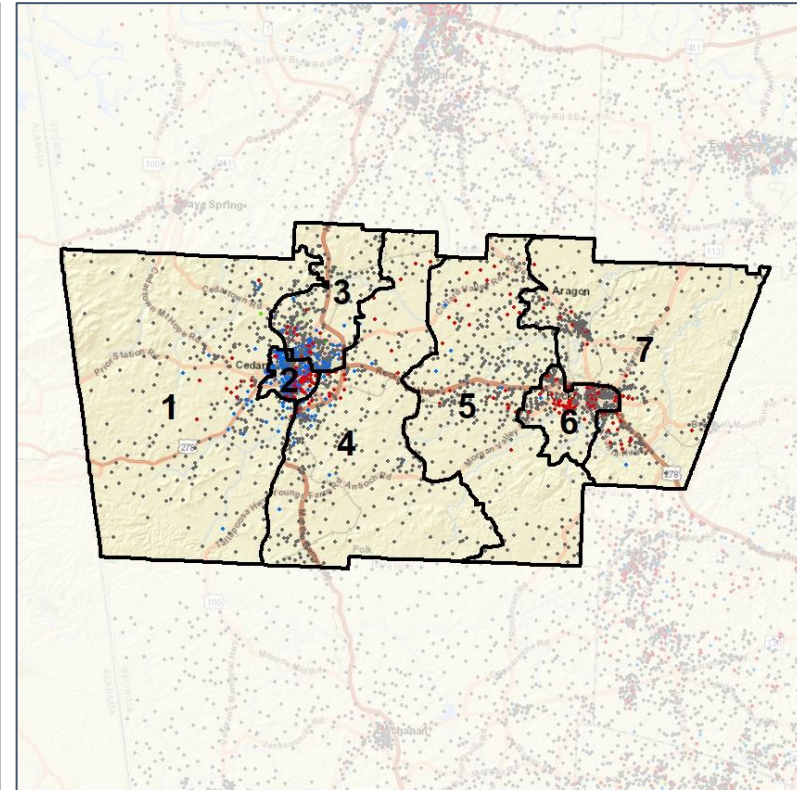
## Population Density by Race



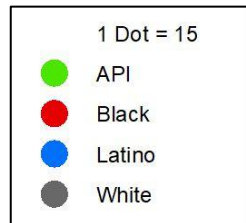

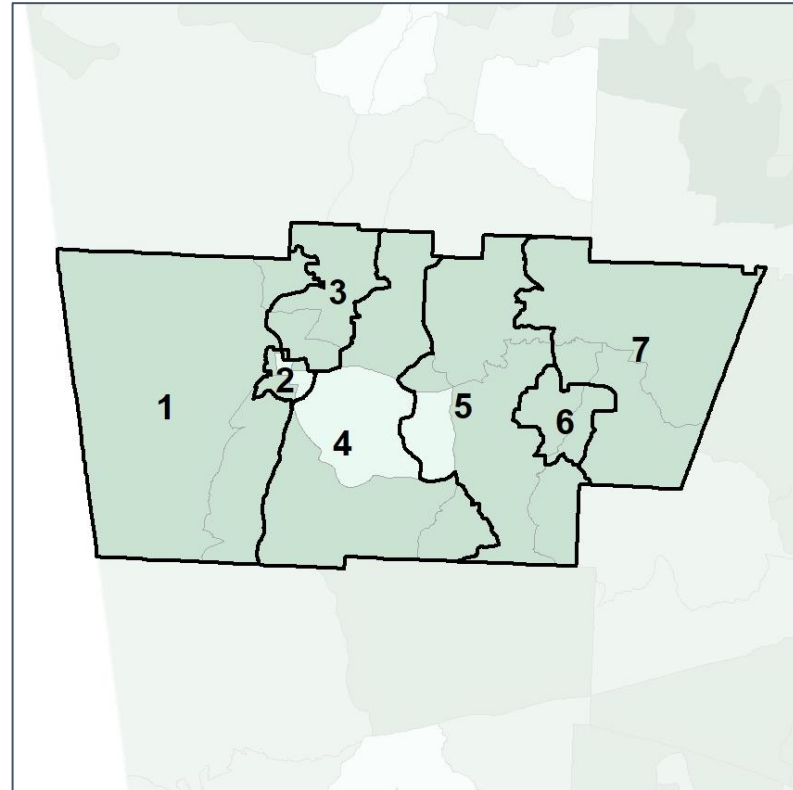
## Median Household Income by Census Tract



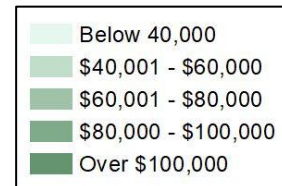

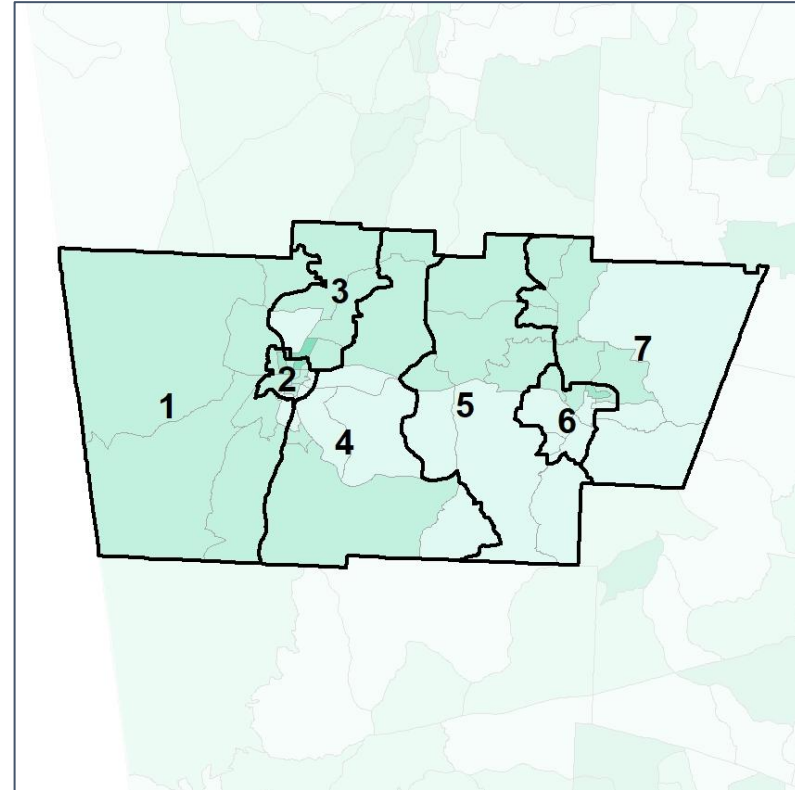
## % Youth (18-34) by Census Block Group
