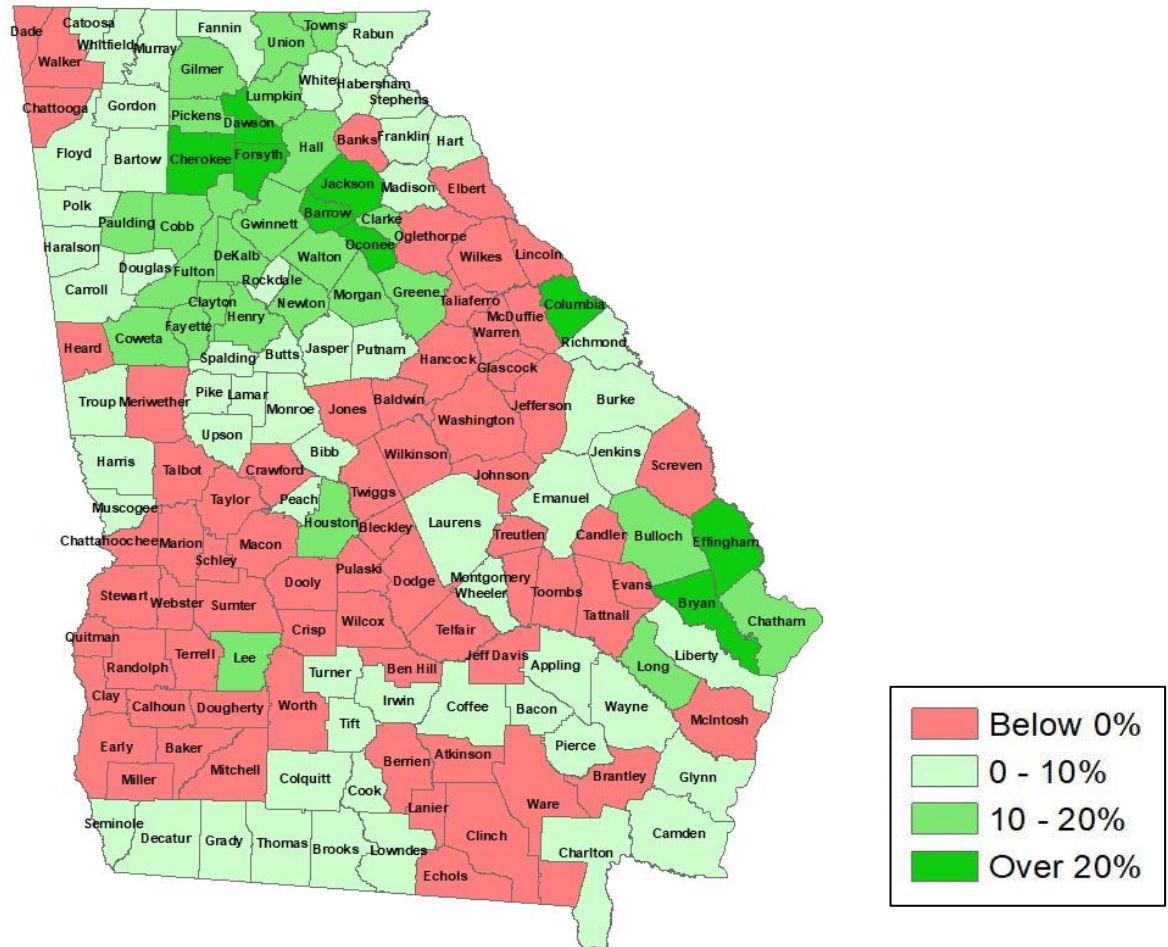

## Change in Population in Georgia by County

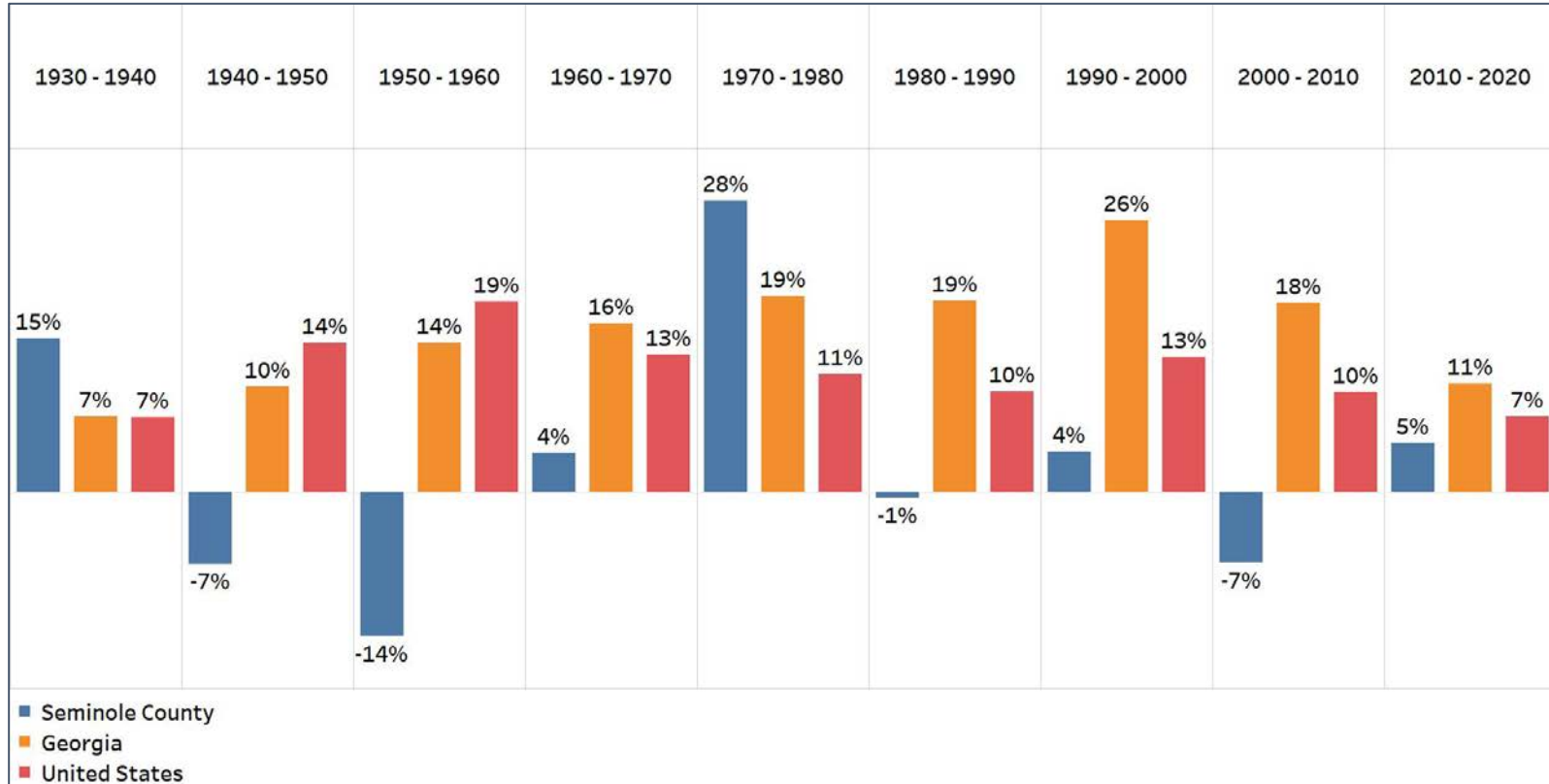


- Georgia is experiencing rapid population growth in the Atlanta, Augusta, and Savannah regions of the state

## Change in Population by Decade

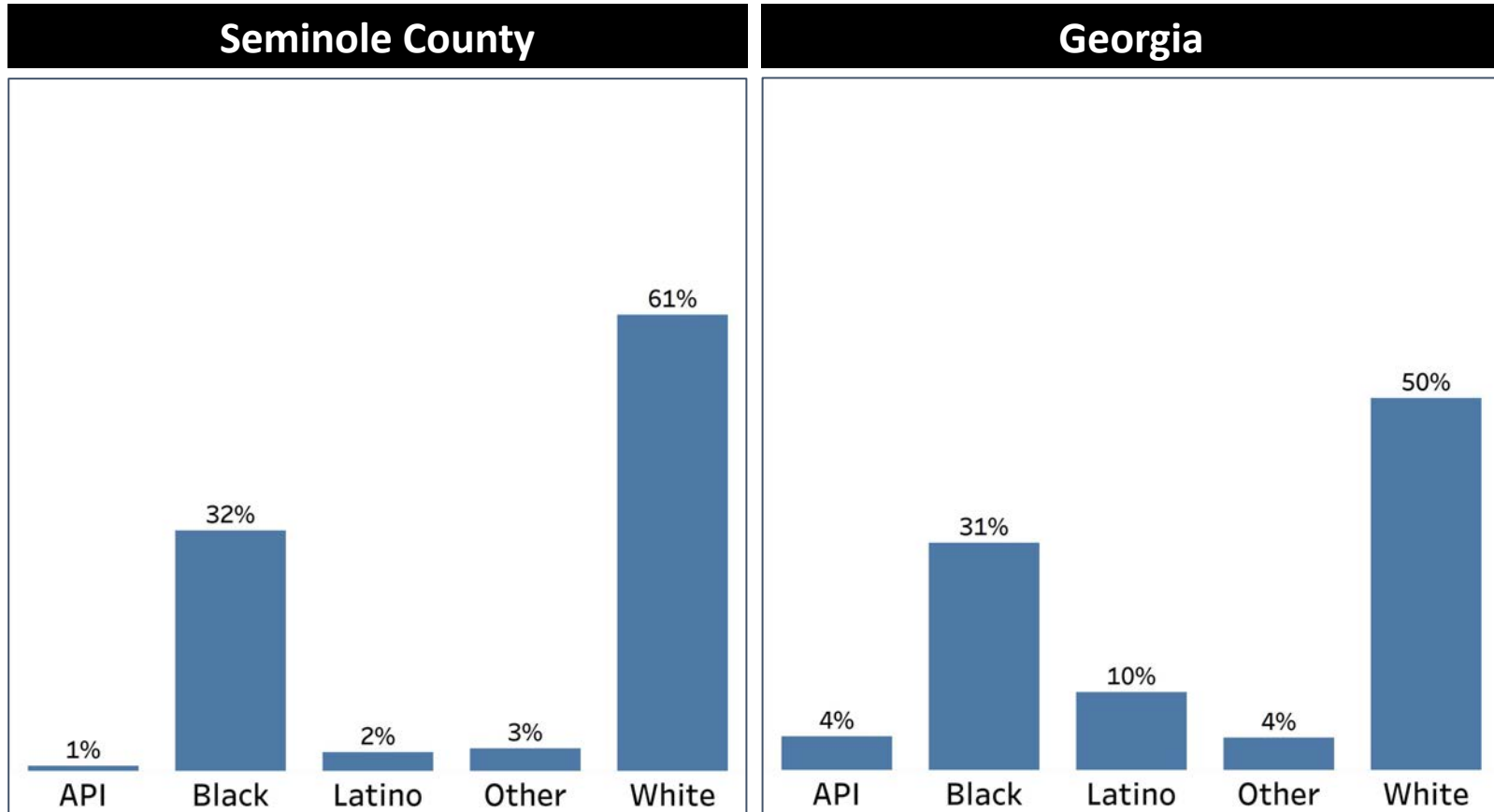


- Seminole County has varied between decline and growth, but overall has seen more growth since 1960

## Comparison between Seminole County and Georgia



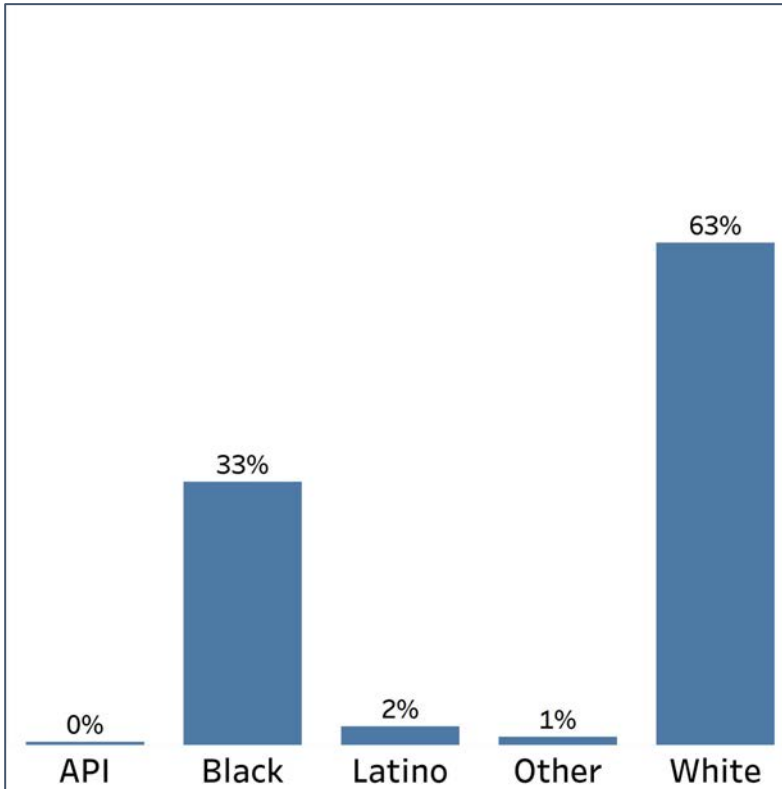
- Seminole County has a higher share of both Black and White populations compared to Georgia overall

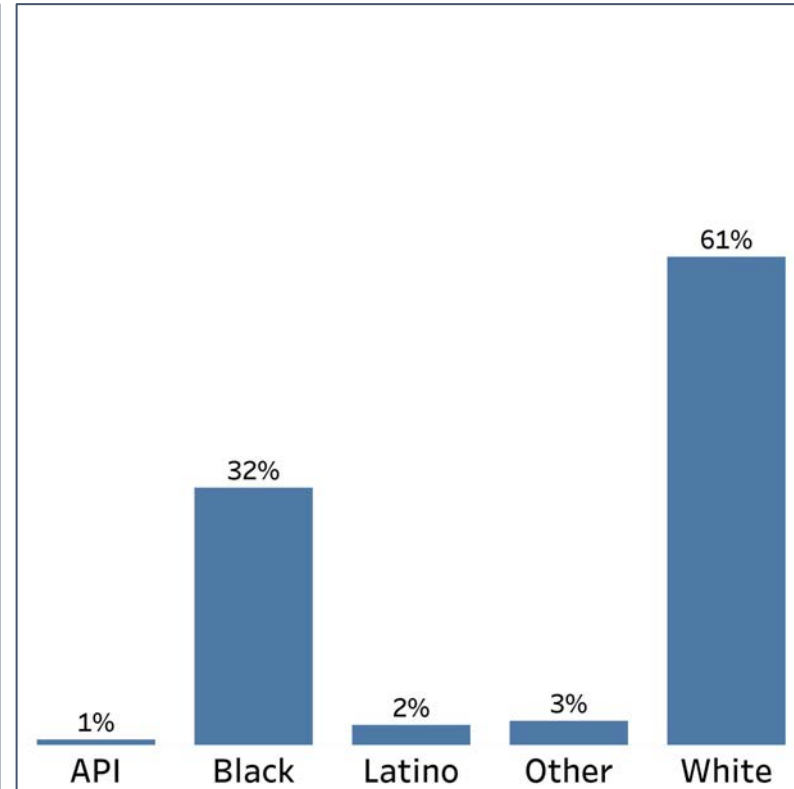
## 2010 vs 2020 Demographics in Seminole County

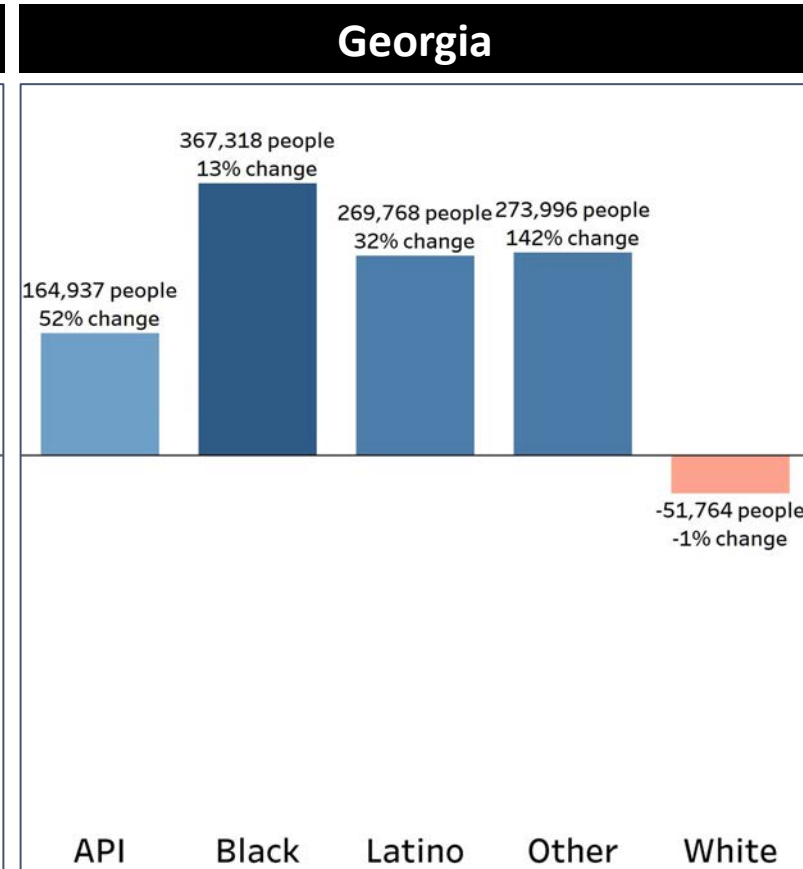
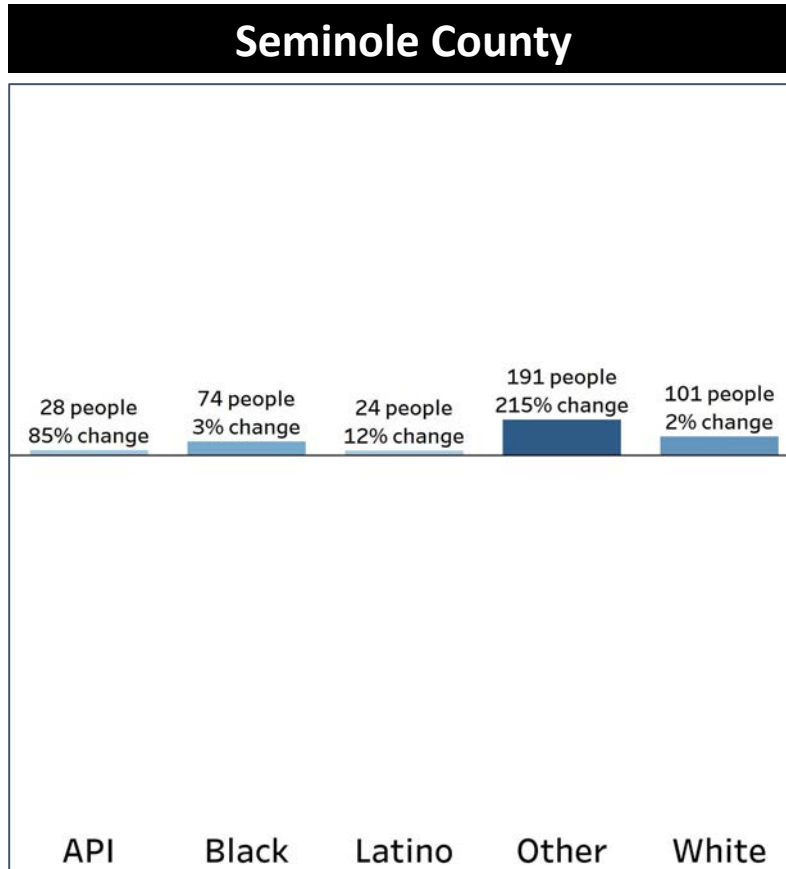


- Seminole County had a decrease in its share of both the White and Black populations

## Population Change by Race (2020 - 2010)



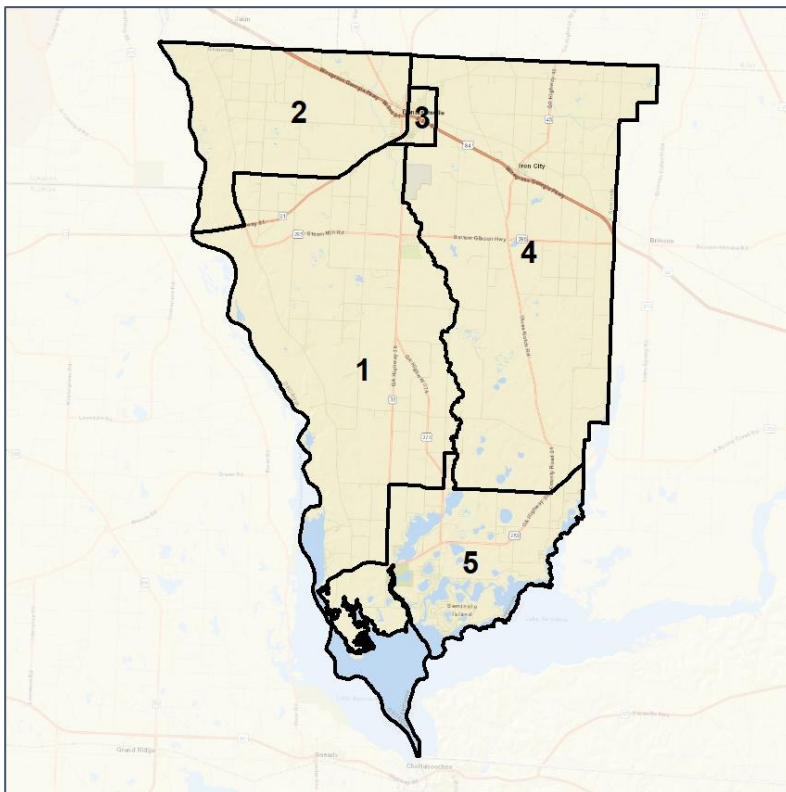
- All demographic groups had an increase in population, although most of it was very small

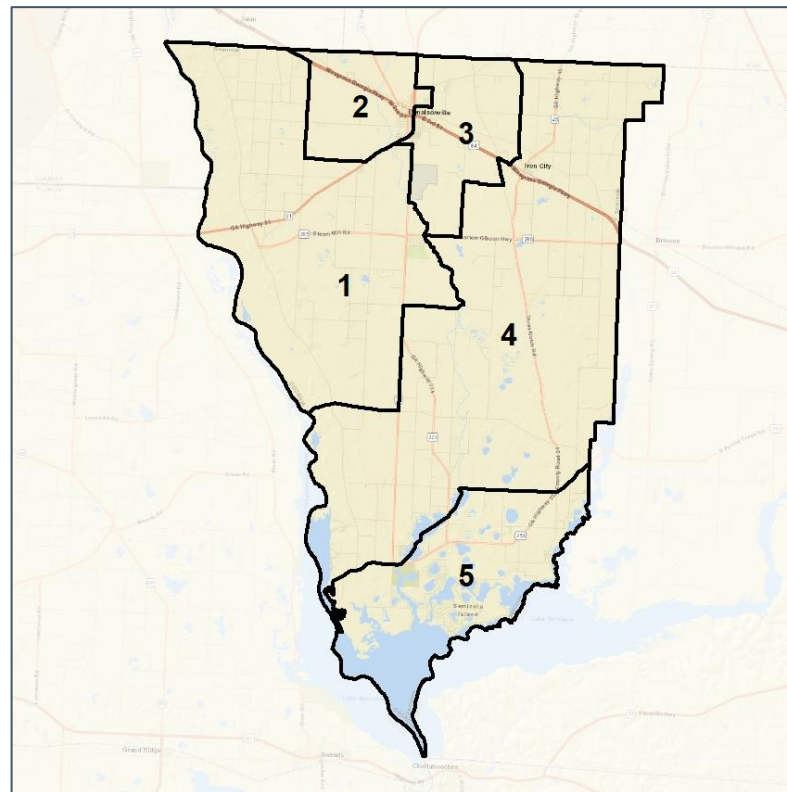

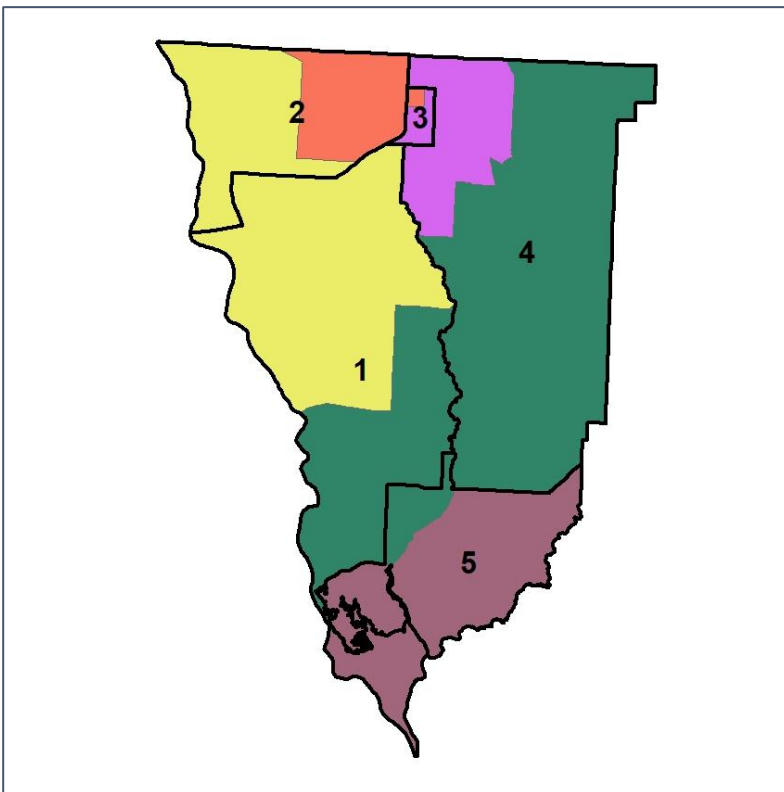

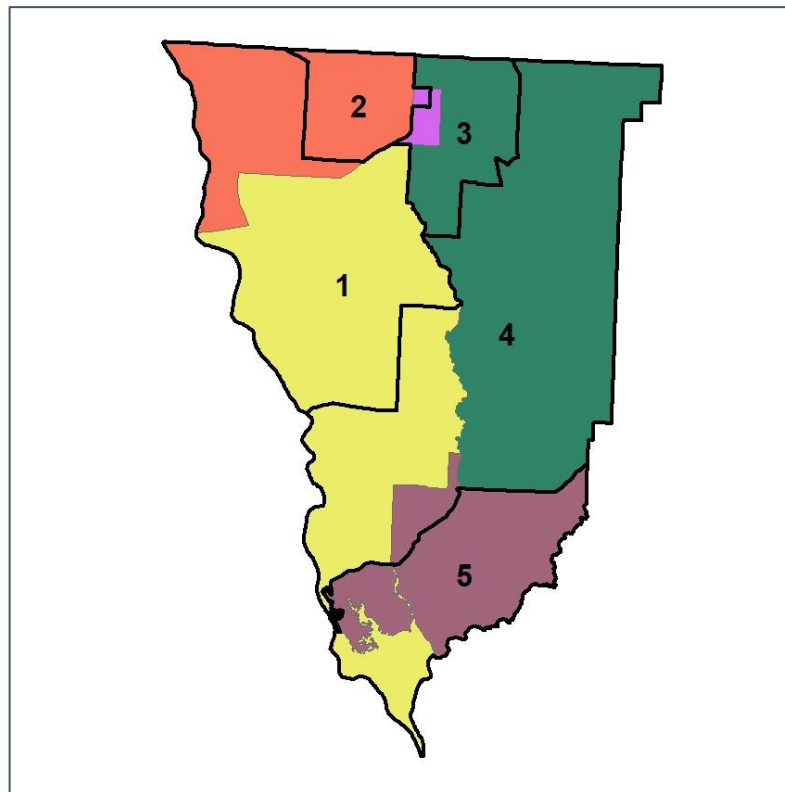
## Changes in Redistricting

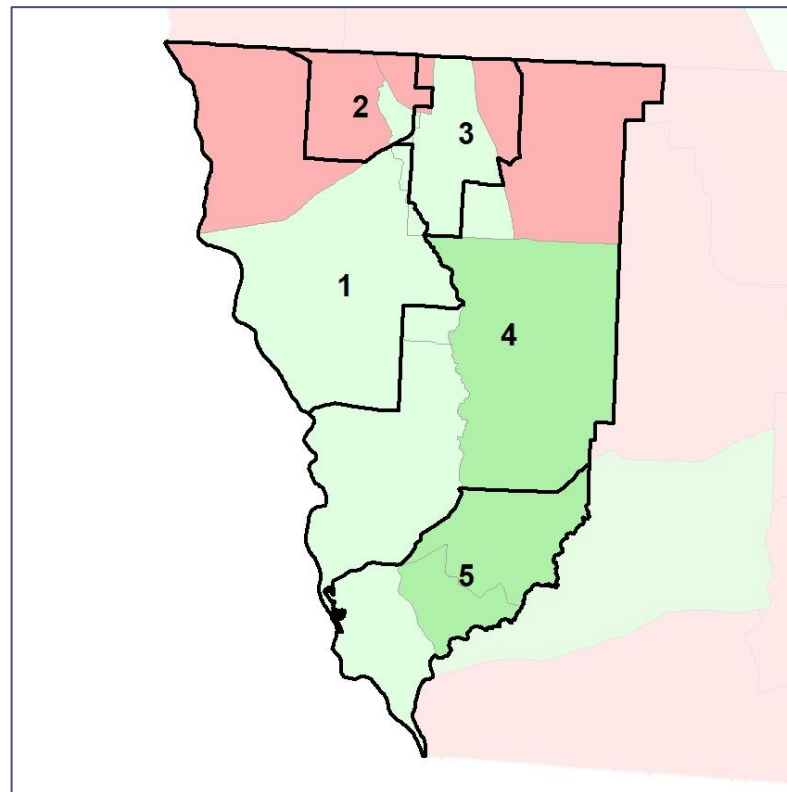
## Net Gain in Population (2010 - 2020) by Census Block Group

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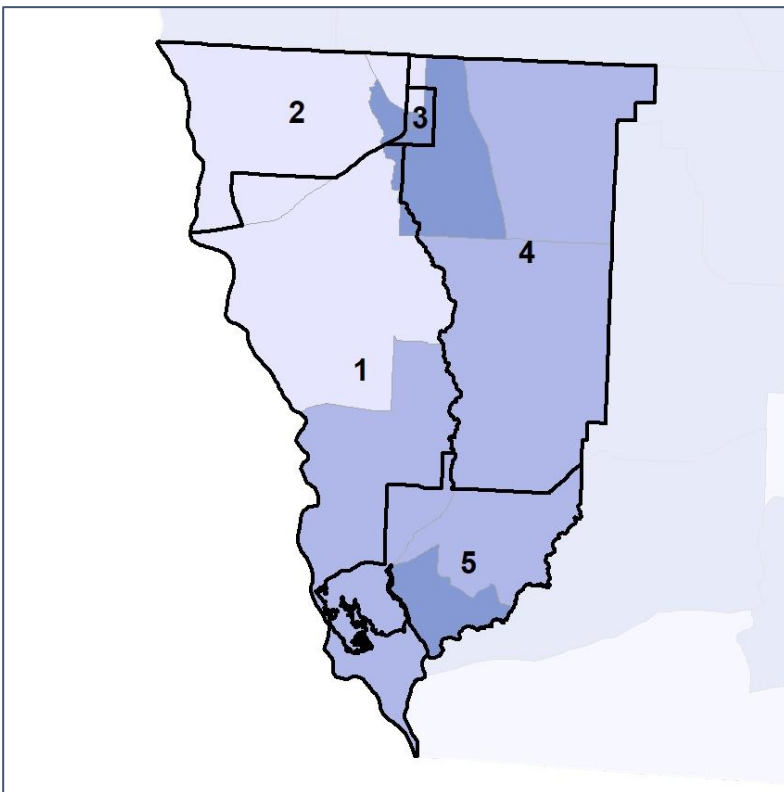

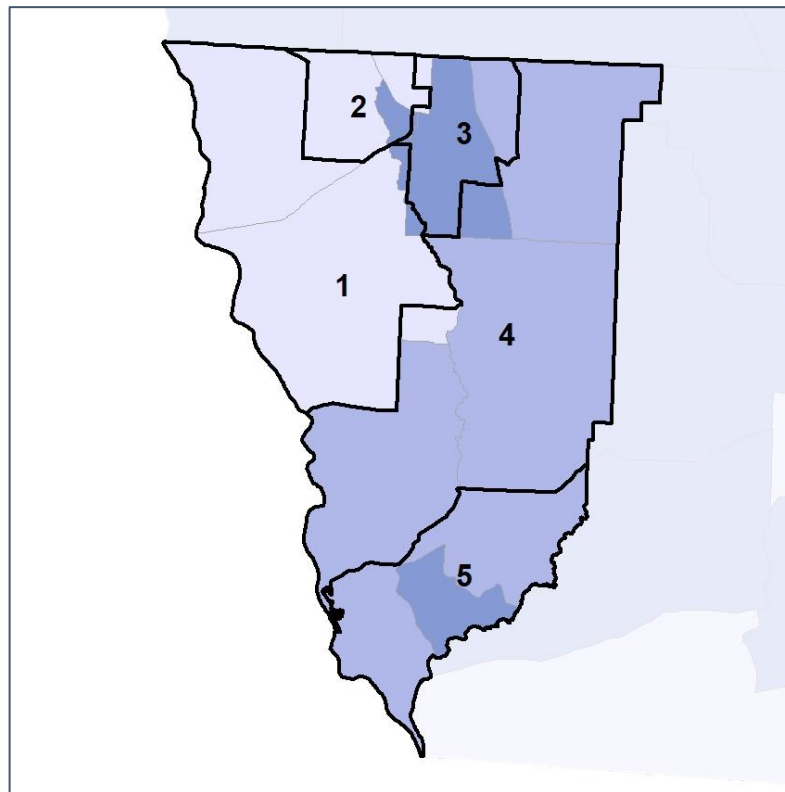
## Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group

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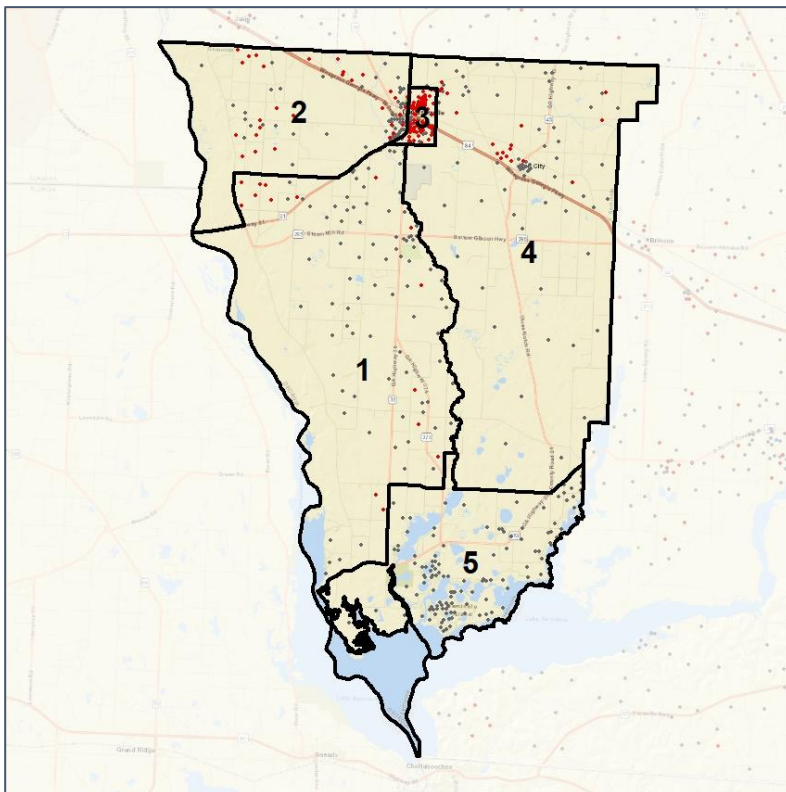

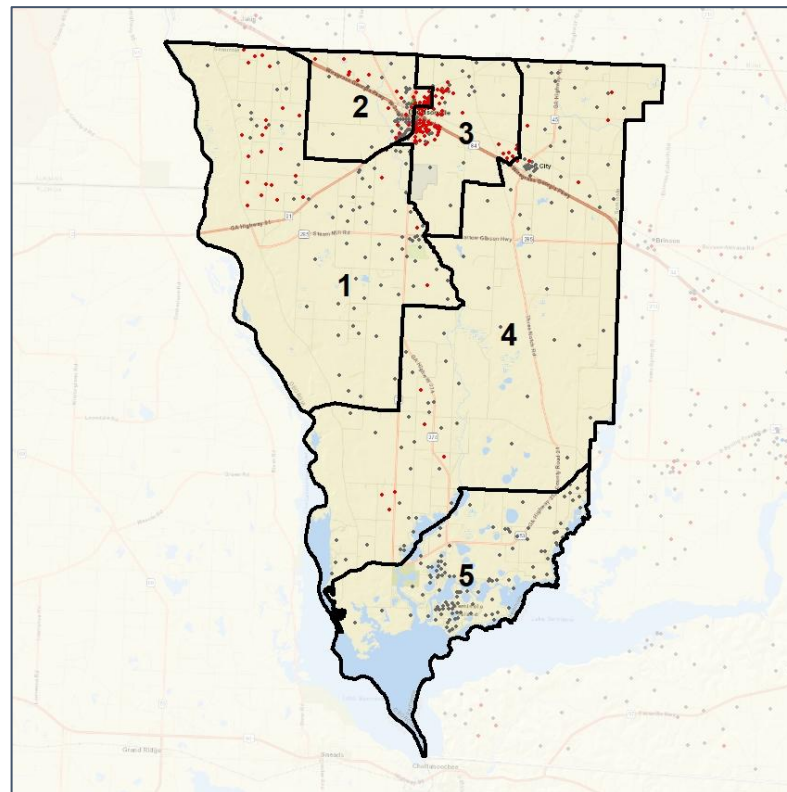
## Population Density by Race



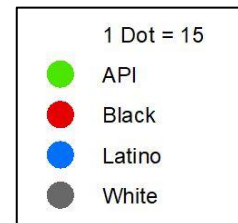

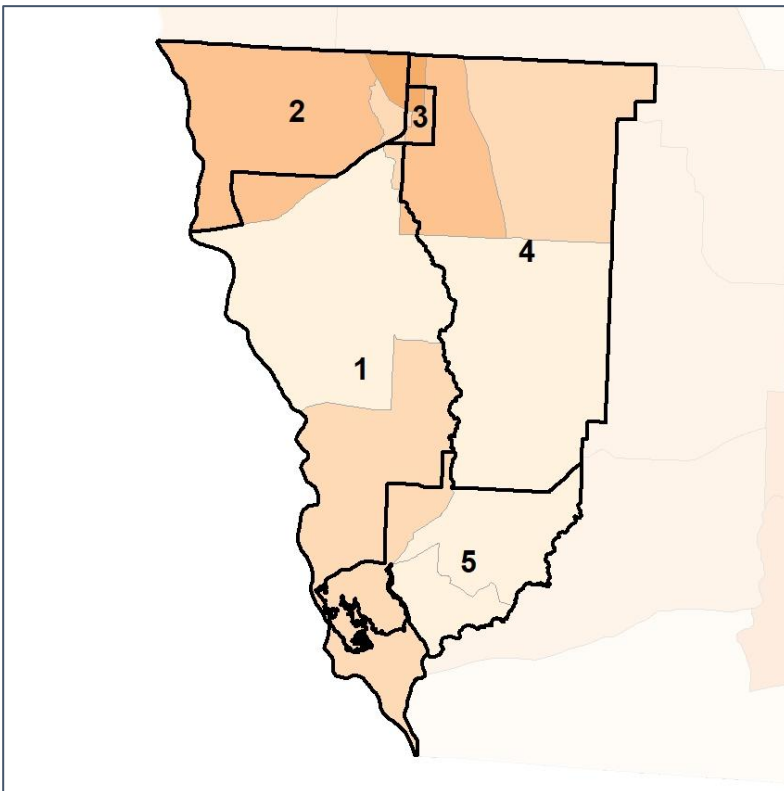

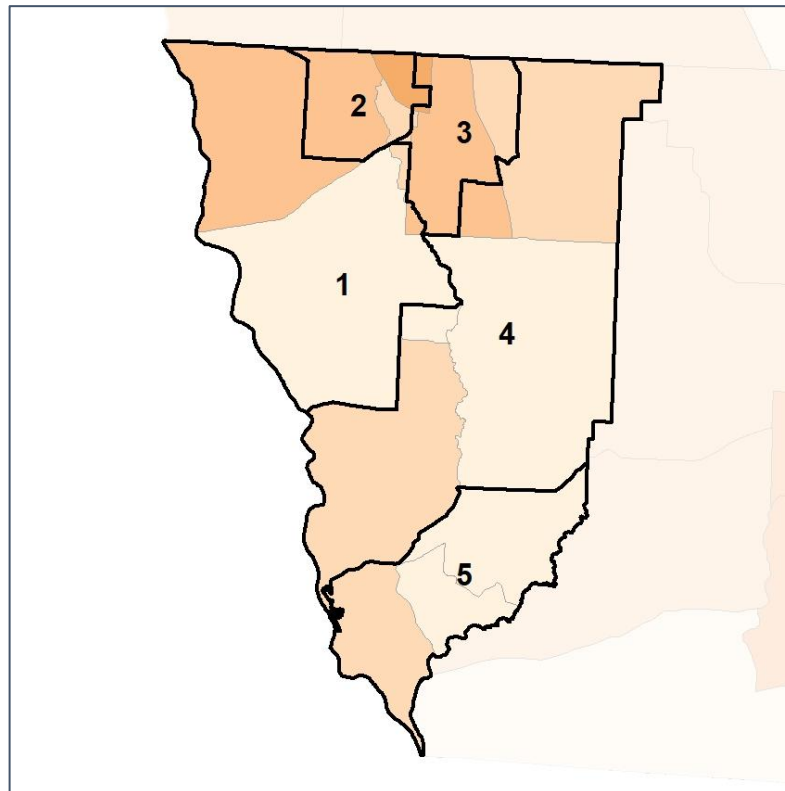
## % People of Color by Census Block Group

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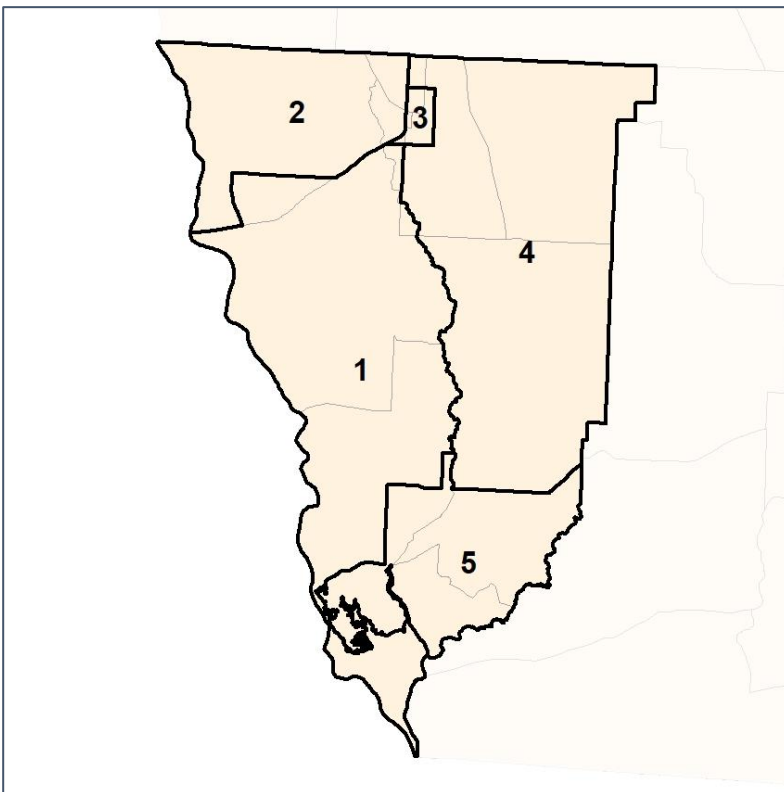

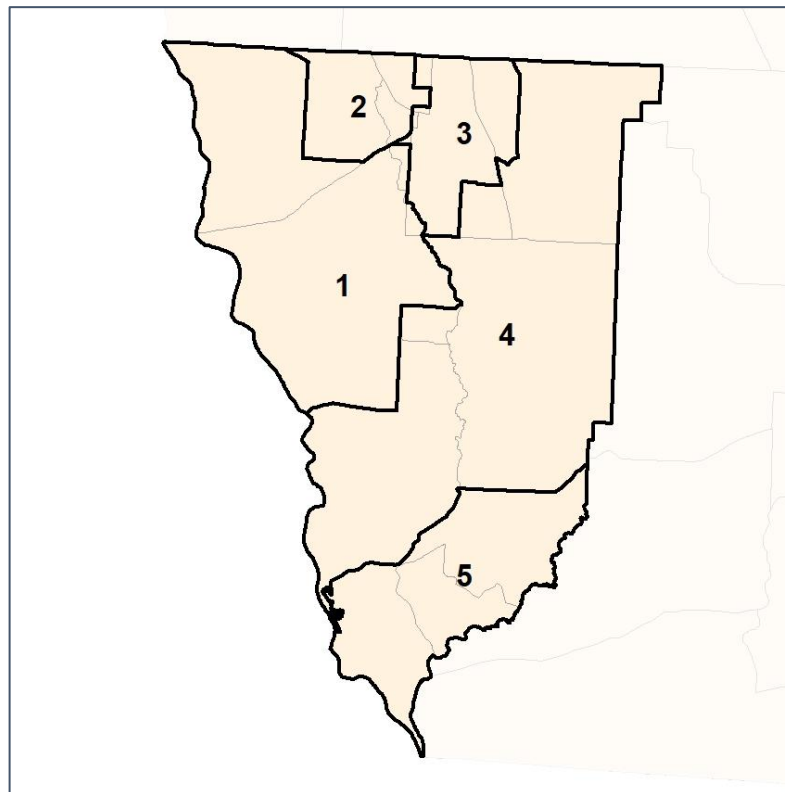
## % API by Census Block Group



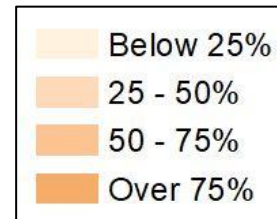

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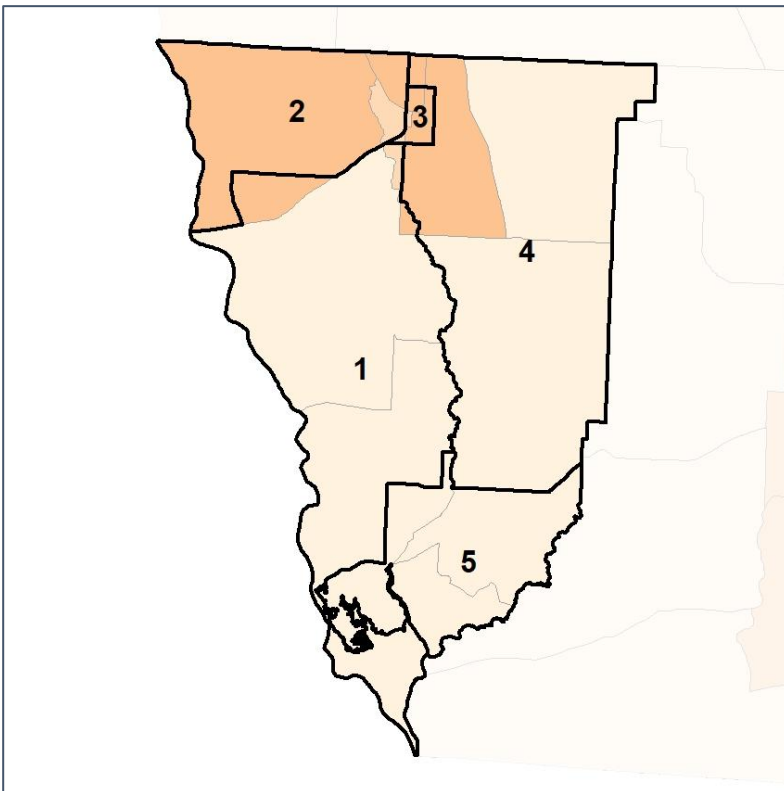

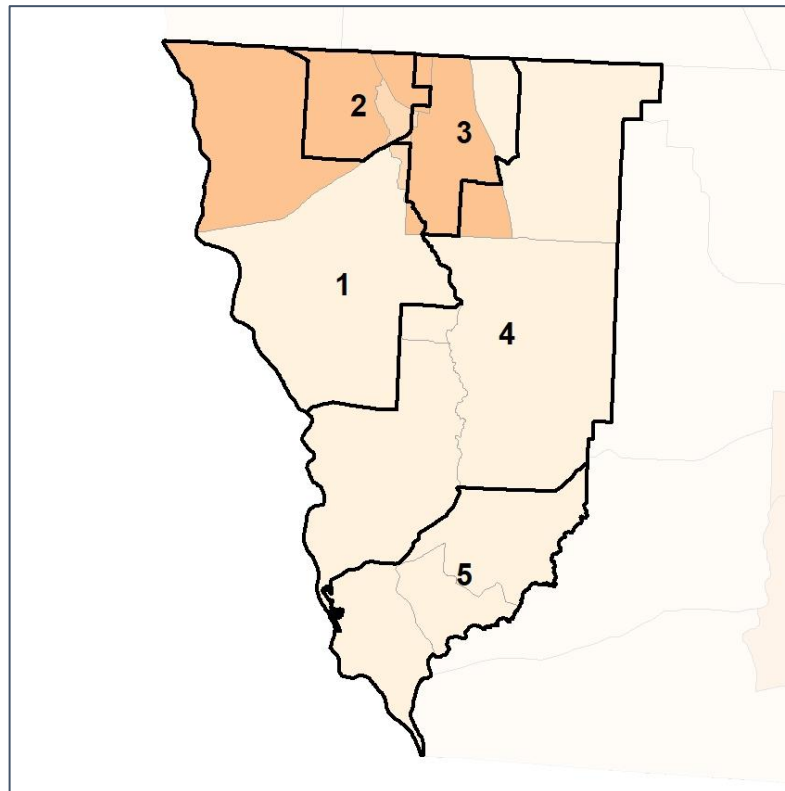
## % Black by Census Block Group



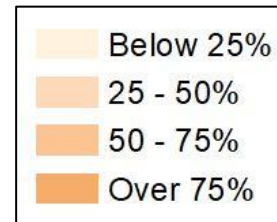

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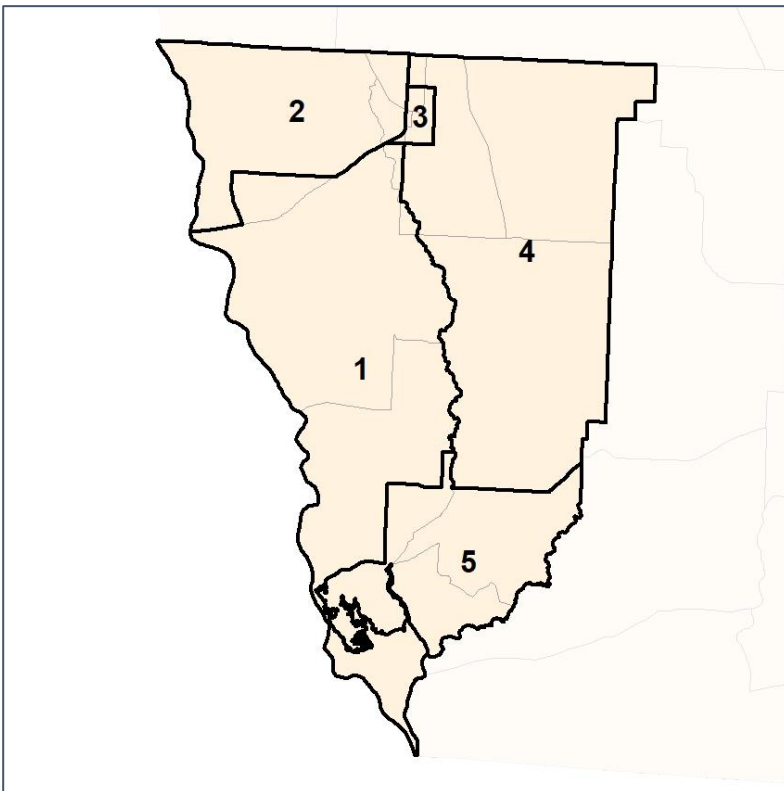

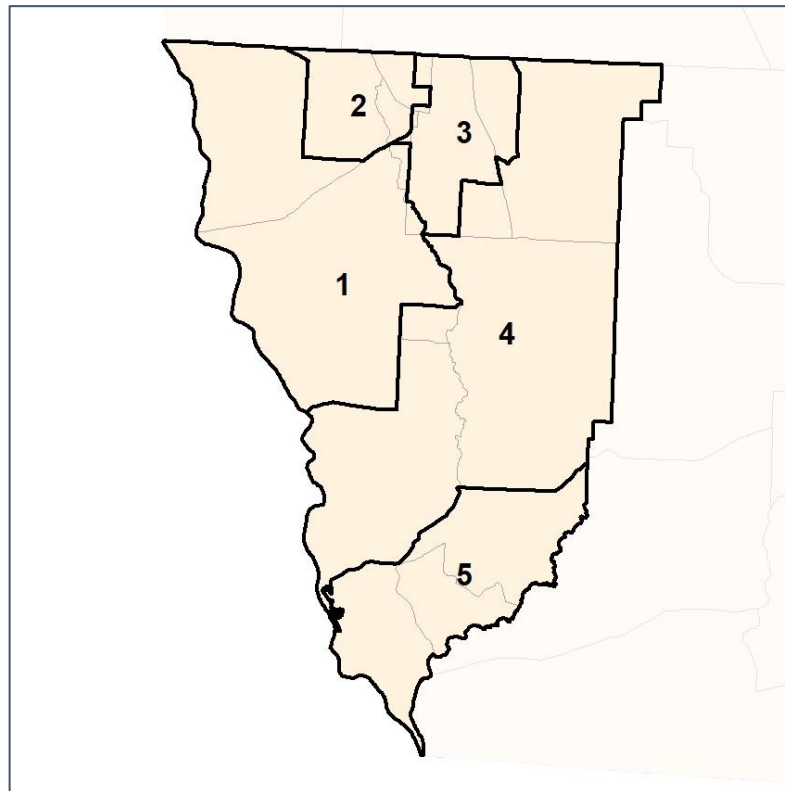
## % Latino by Census Block Group

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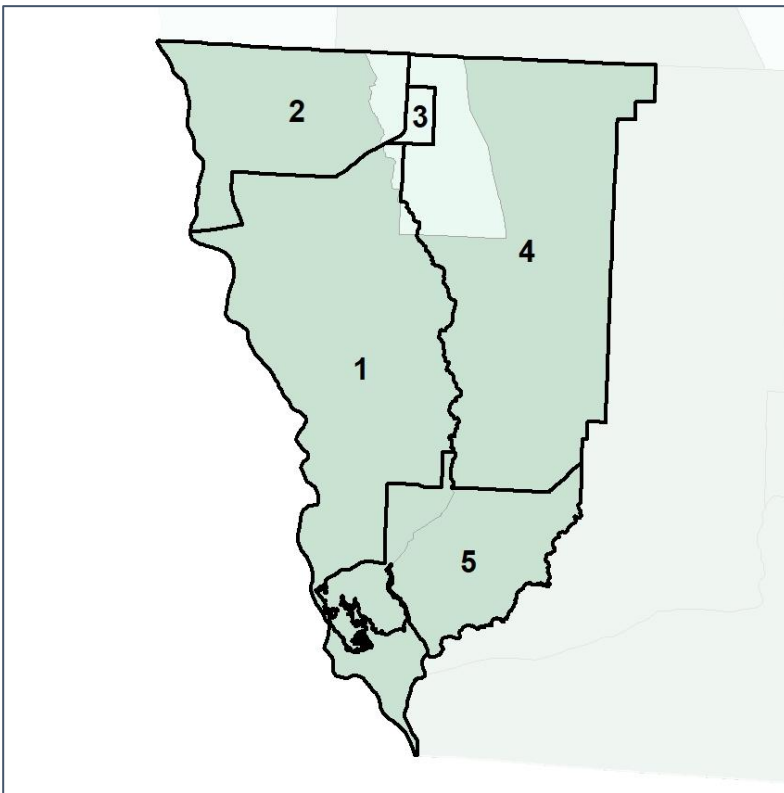

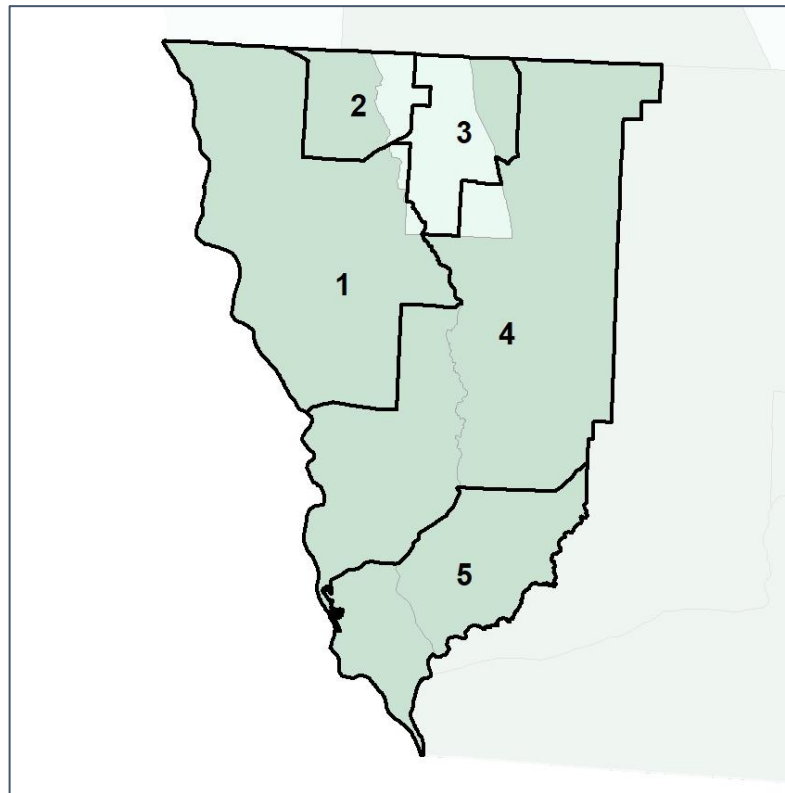
## Median Household Income by Census Tract

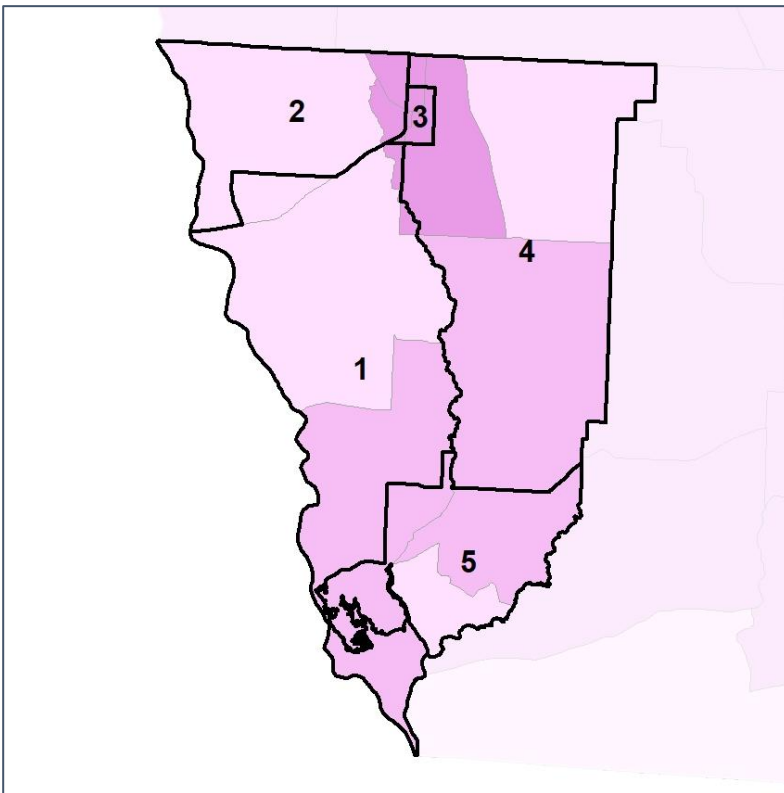

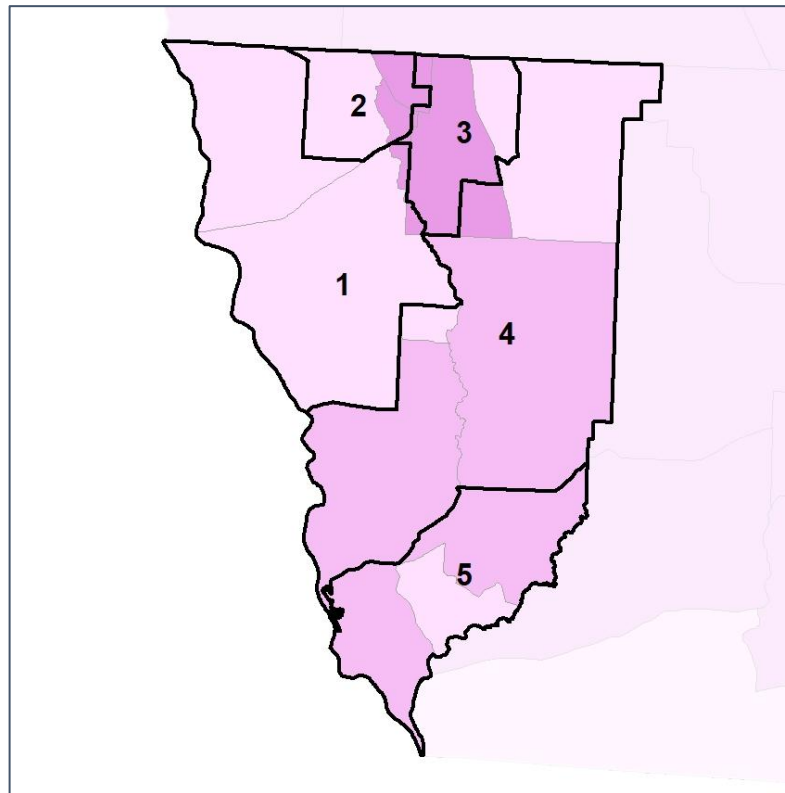
## % Renter by Census Block Group



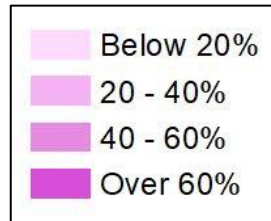

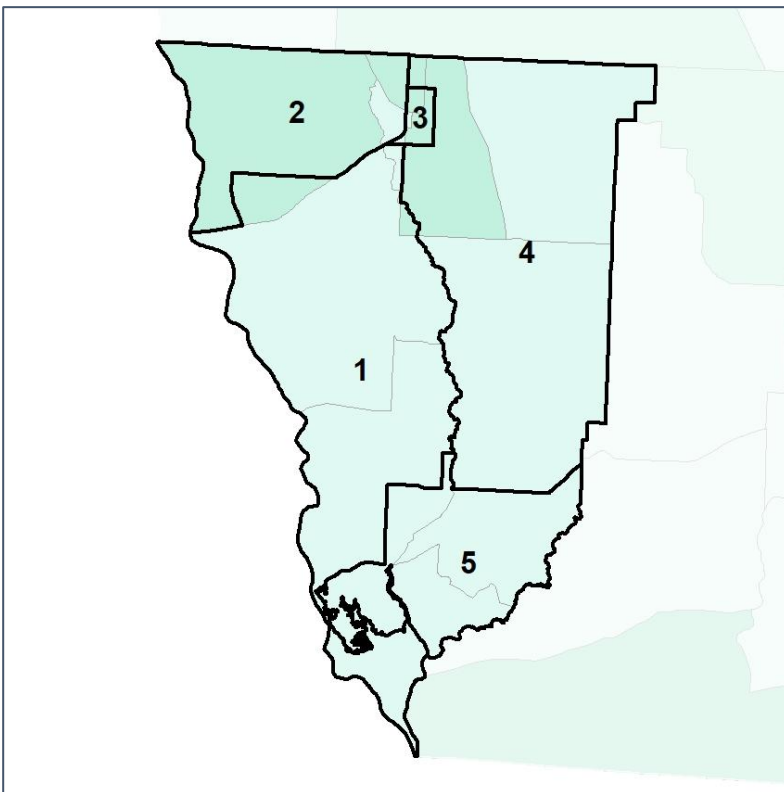

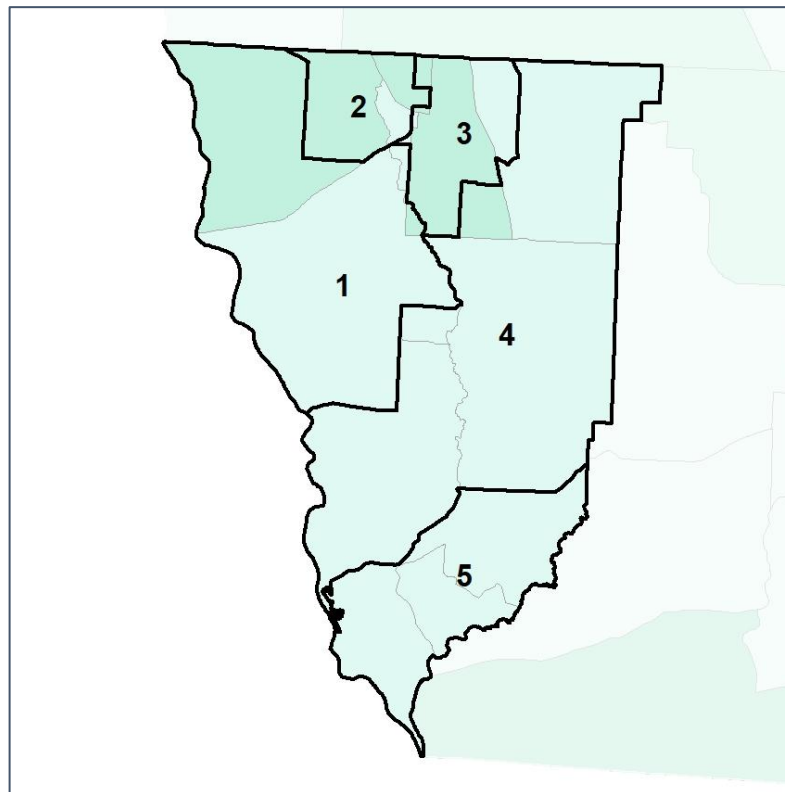
## % Youth (18-34) by Census Block Group
