

Change in Population in Georgia by County






 Georgia is experience rapid population growth in the Atlanta, Augusta, and Savannah regions of the state

Change in Population by Decade






- The Spalding County has consistently had a growth in their population since 1930

Comparison between Spalding County and Georgia






- The Black and White population in Spalding County is slightly higher than their statewide average


2010 vs 2020 Demographics in Spalding County

- Spalding county communities of color experienced a growth in their population except the API community






- Spalding County communities of color increased in population with the Latino community having a higher growth rate than their statewide average




Spalding Co. Commission & School Board Changes in Redistricting







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







Spalding Co. Commission & School Board % API by Census Block Group









Median Household Income by Census Tract




