

Change in Population in Georgia by County






 Georgia is experience rapid population growth in the Atlanta, Augusta, and Savannah regions of the state

Change in Population by Decade






- Despite having a growth in their population from 1990 to 2010, Tattnall County experienced the highest population decline rate

Comparison between Tattnall County and Georgia







- Tattnall County Black population makes up more than a quarter of the county's population

The Black population of Tattnall County decline by 3%








- Since 2010 Tattnall County Black, Latino, and White population experienced a population decline








