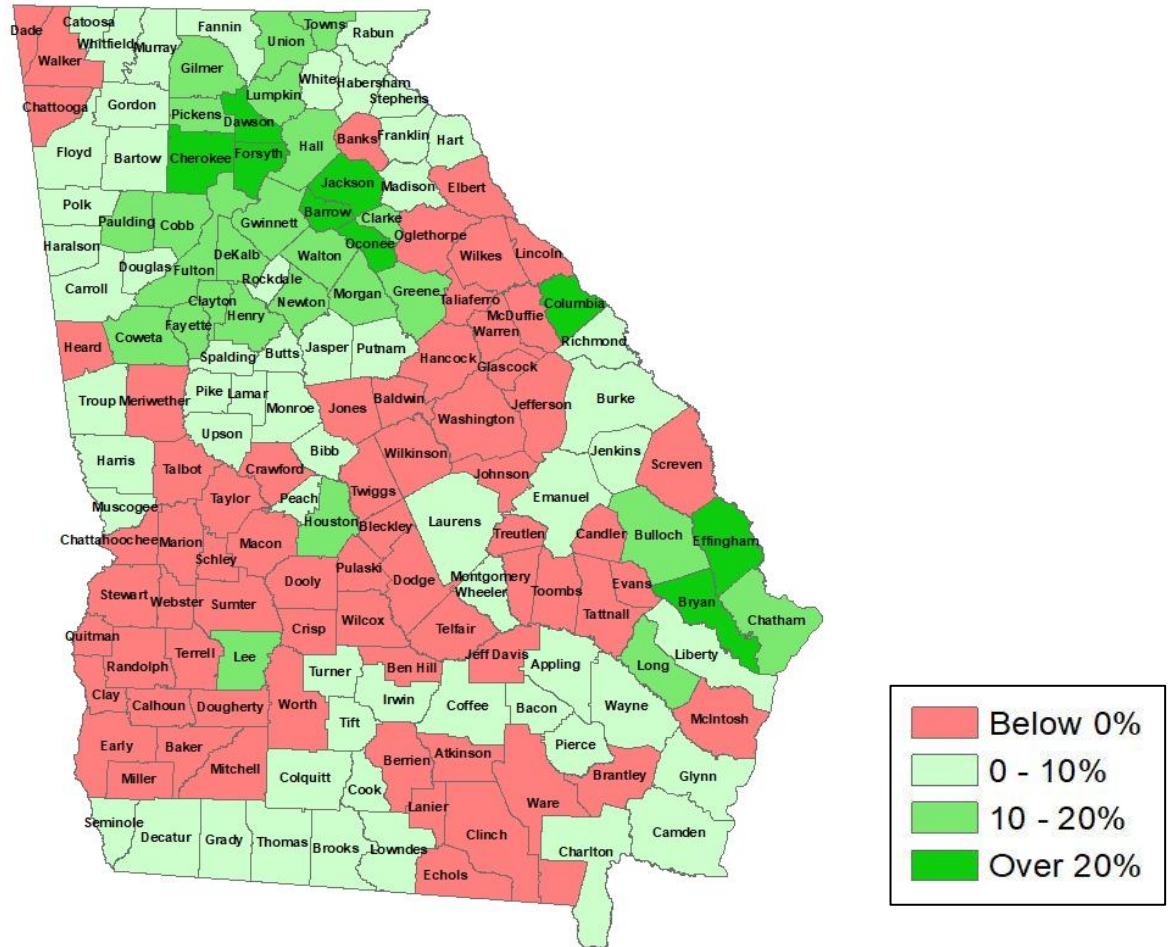

Change in Population in Georgia by County

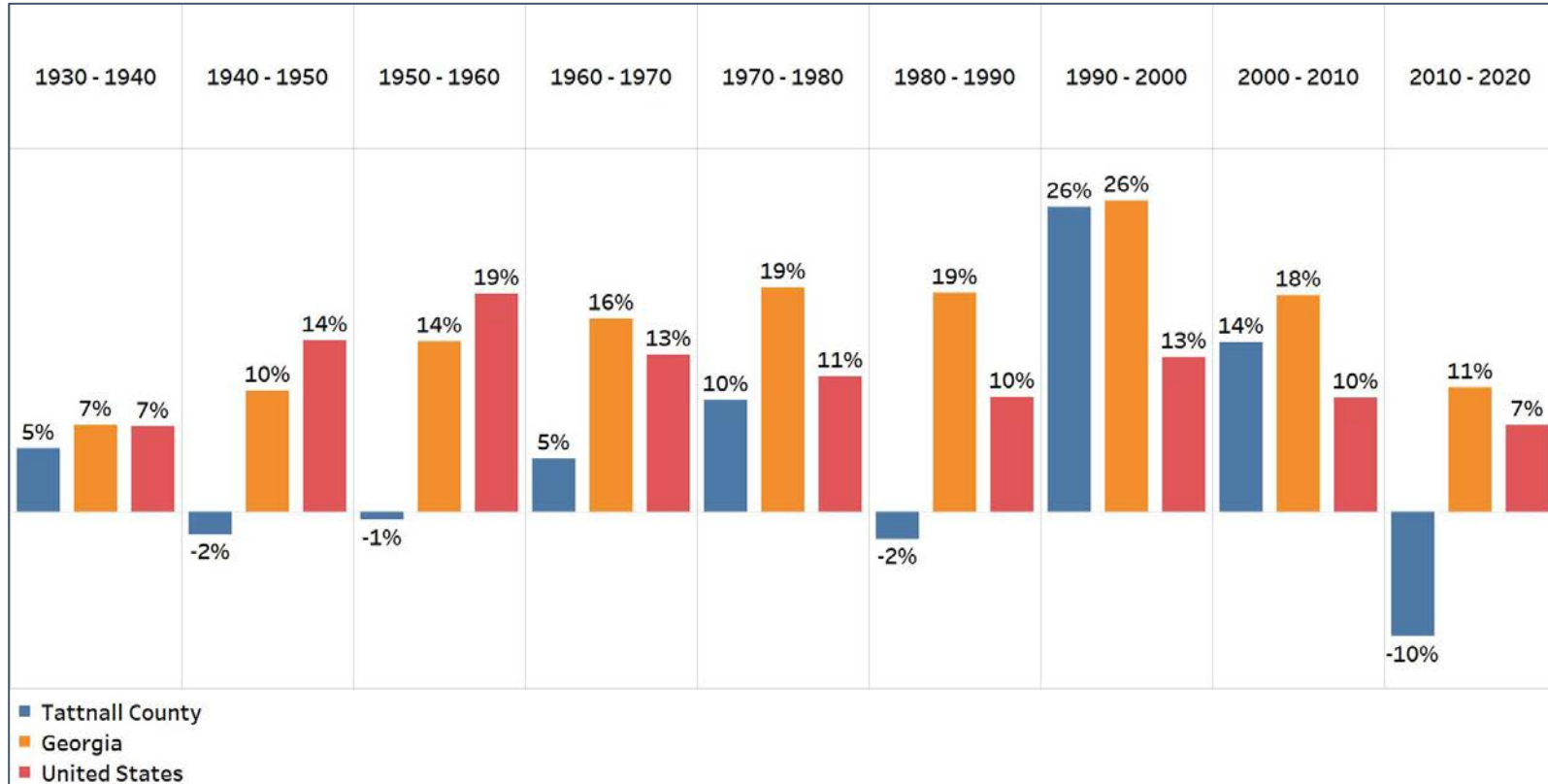


- Georgia is experiencing rapid population growth in the Atlanta, Augusta, and Savannah regions of the state

Change in Population by Decade

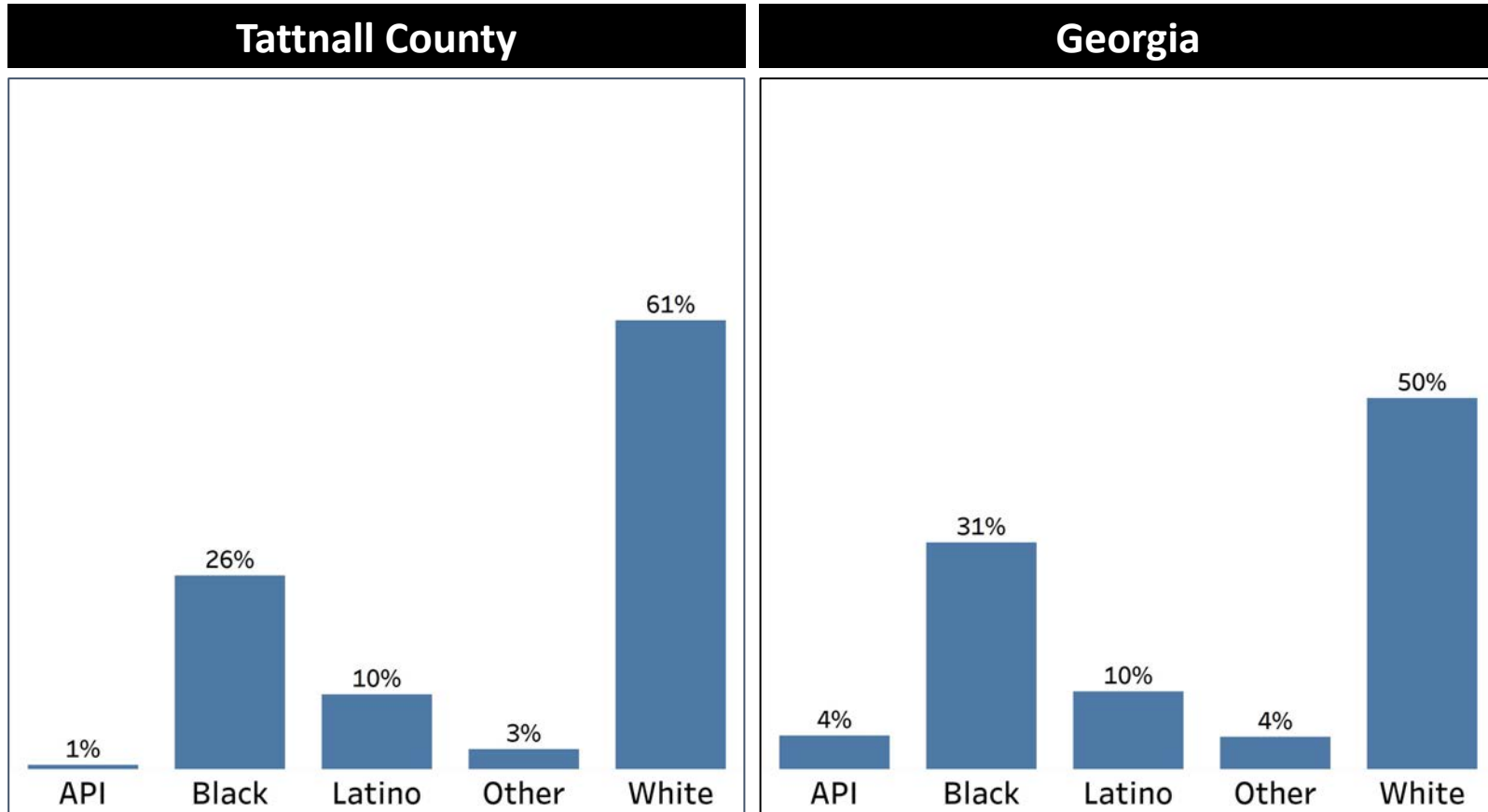


- Despite having a growth in their population from 1990 to 2010, Tattnall County experienced the highest population decline rate

- Tattnall county White population is above the statewide average and is the largest demographic group in the county

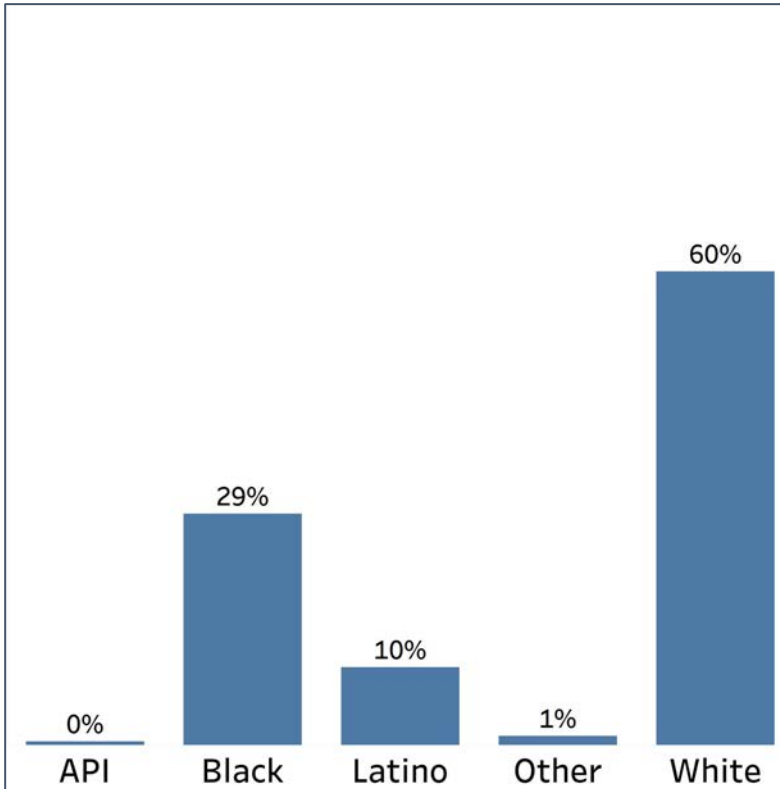

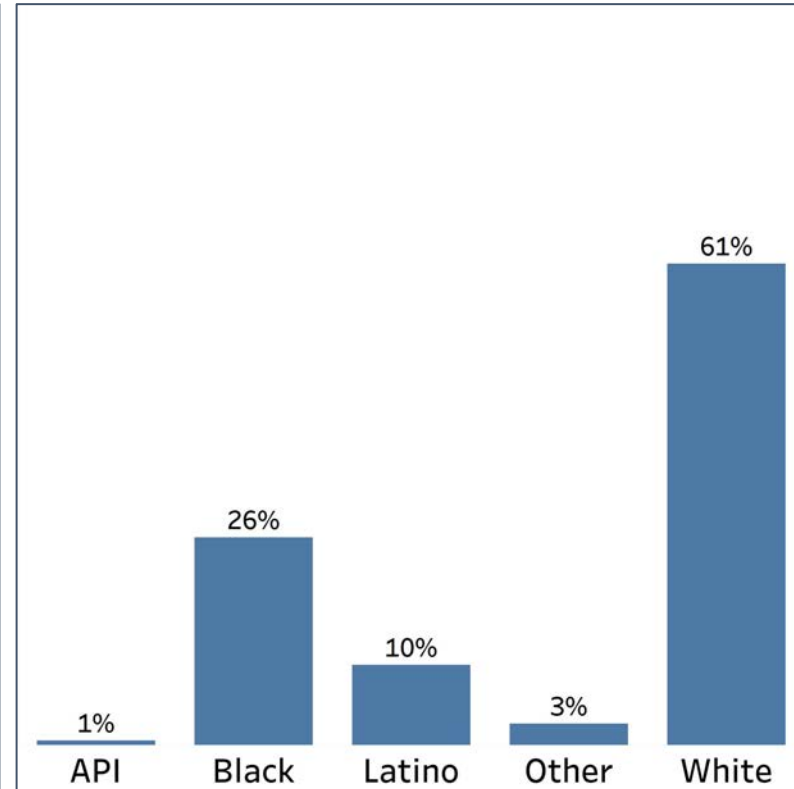
2010 vs 2020 Demographics in Tattnall County

- Tattnall County “Other,” API, and White population increased since 2010

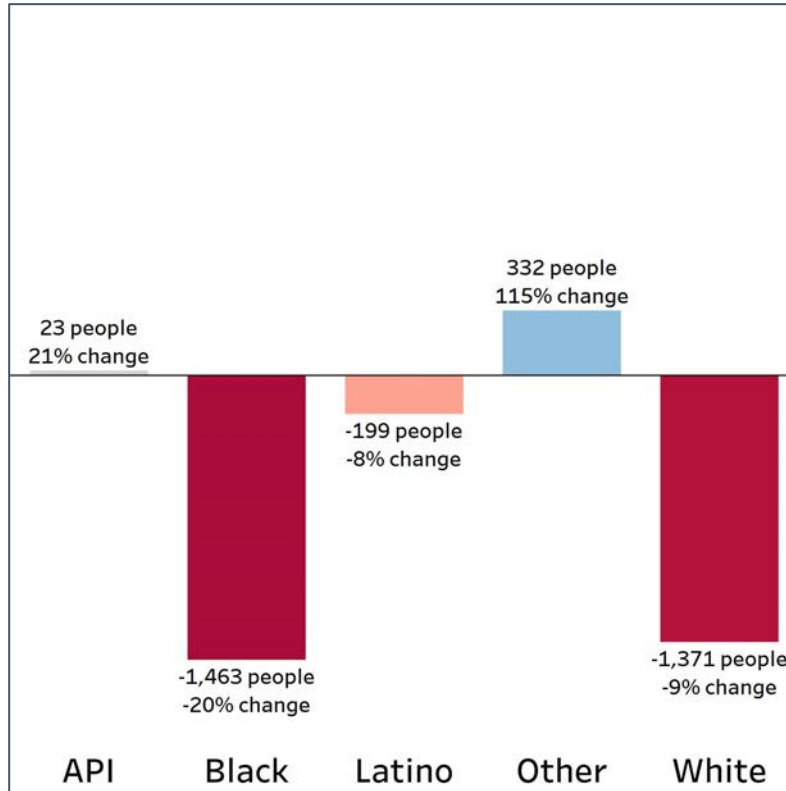

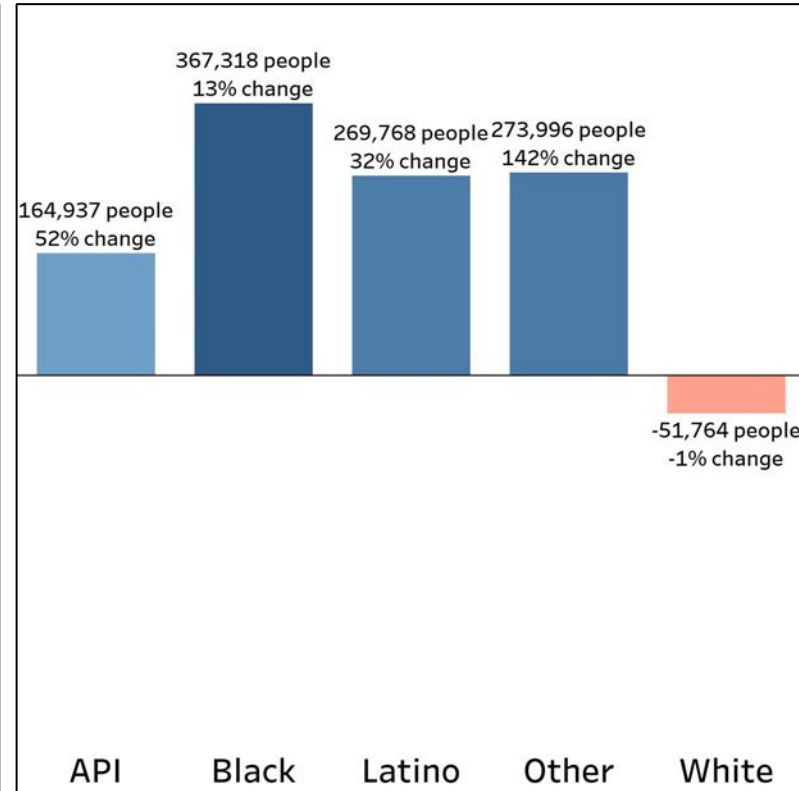
Population Change by Race (2020 - 2010)

- Tattnall County API and “Other” population experienced a population growth

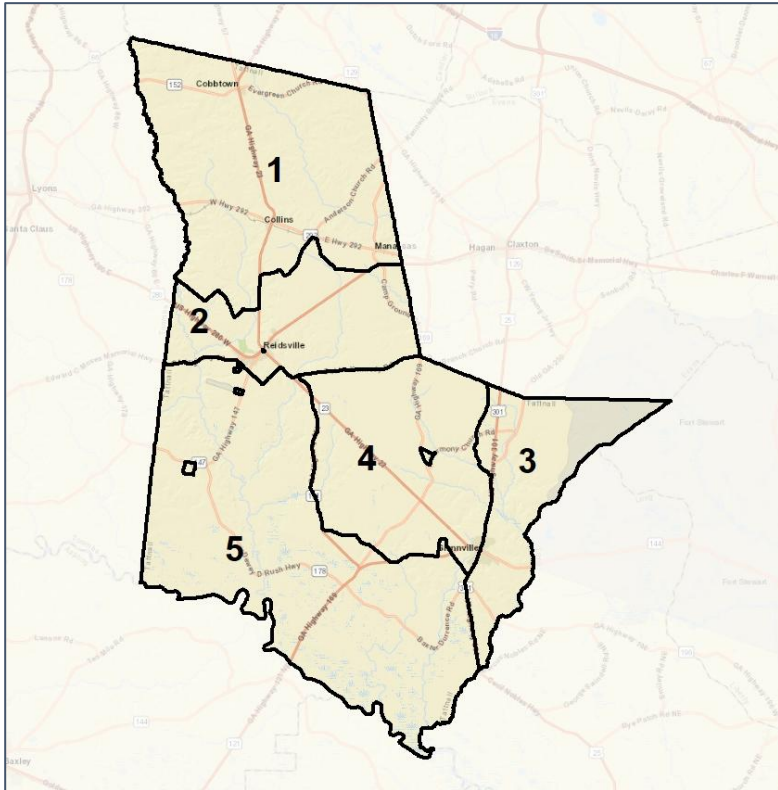

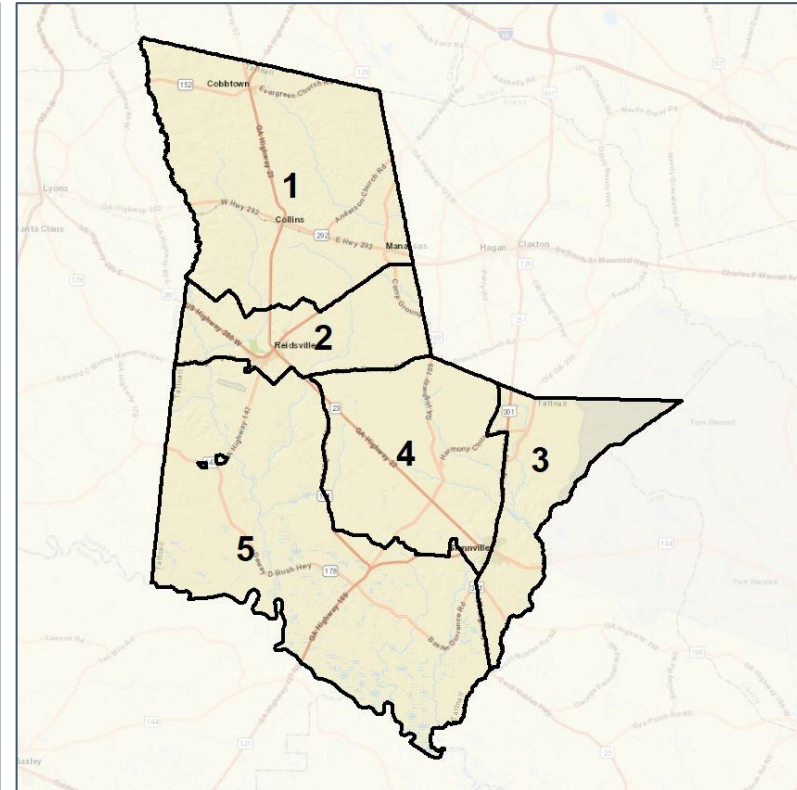

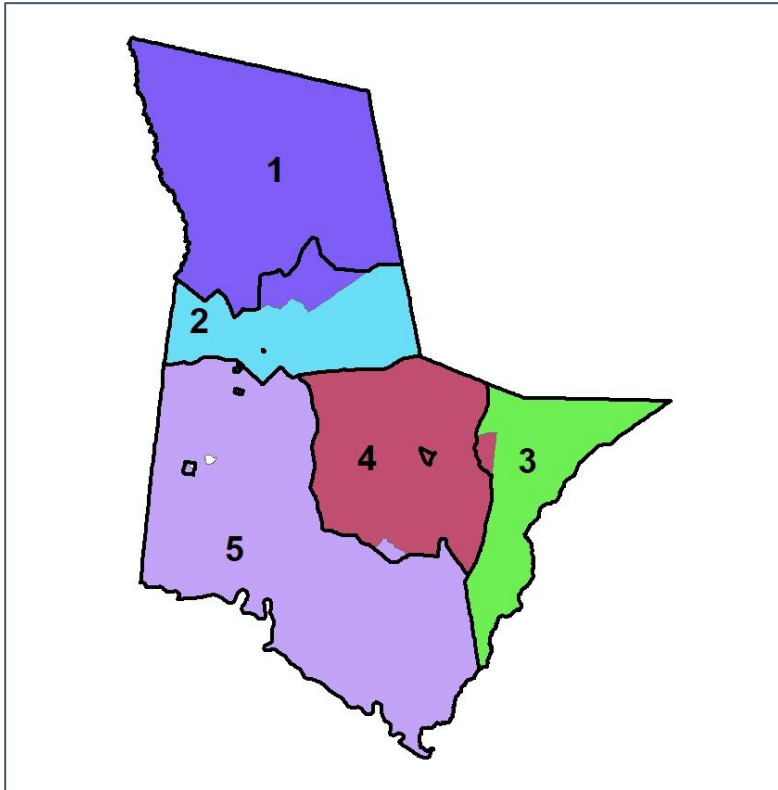

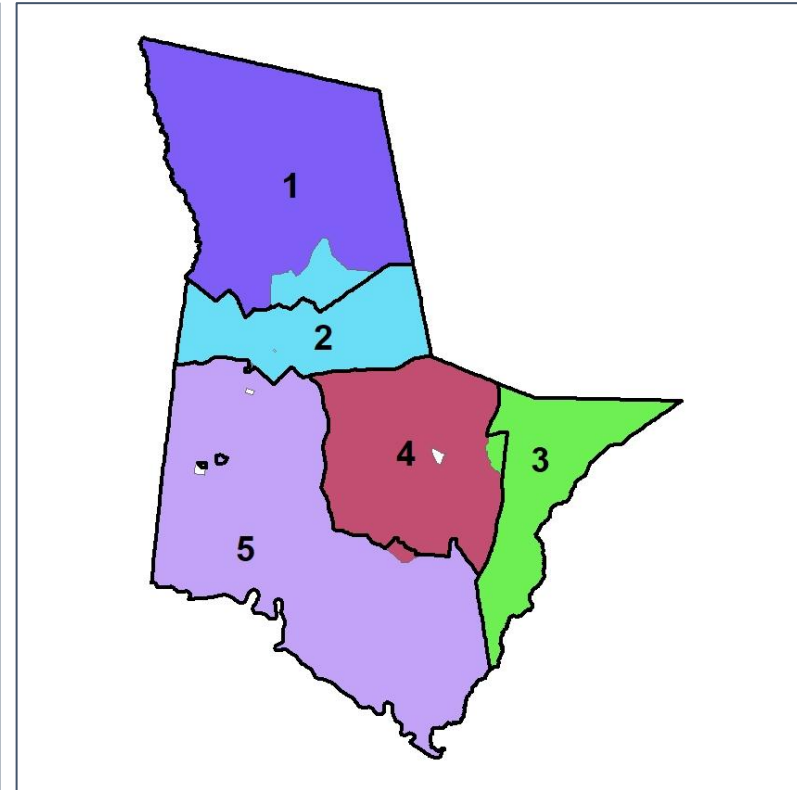
Changes in Redistricting

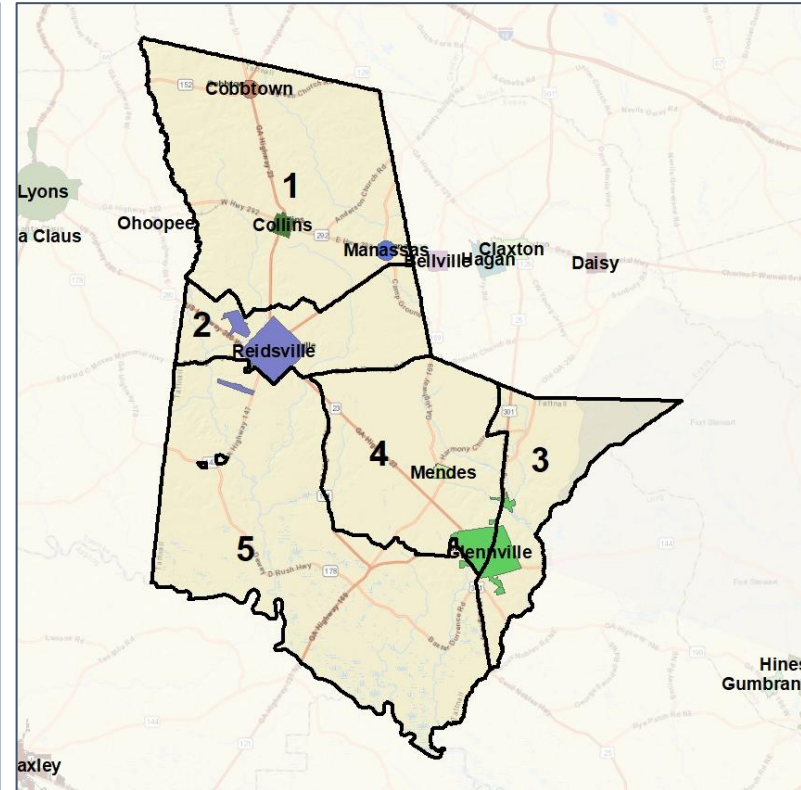

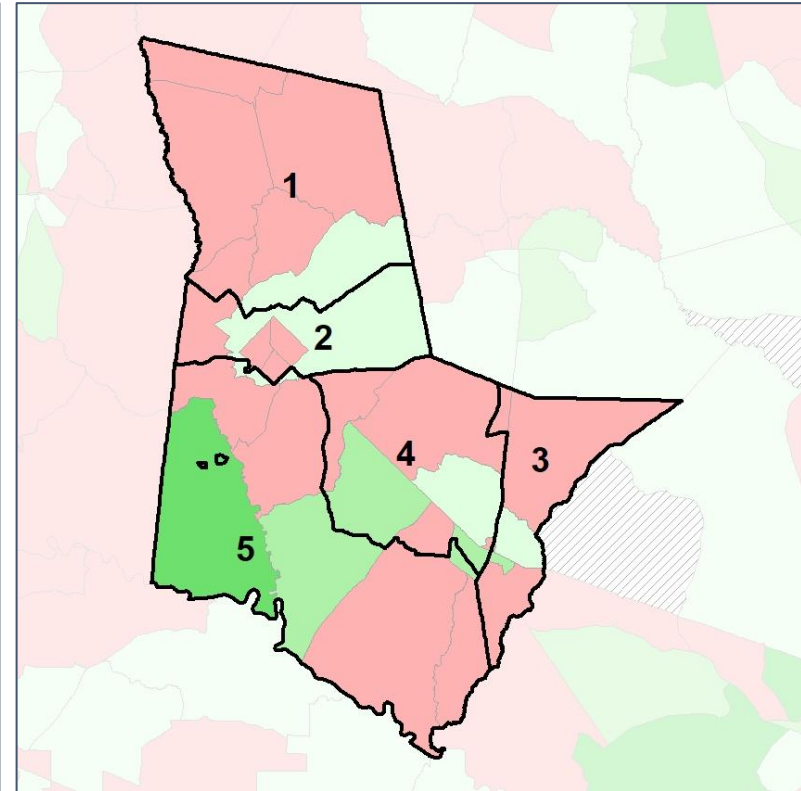
Net Gain in Population (2010 - 2020)

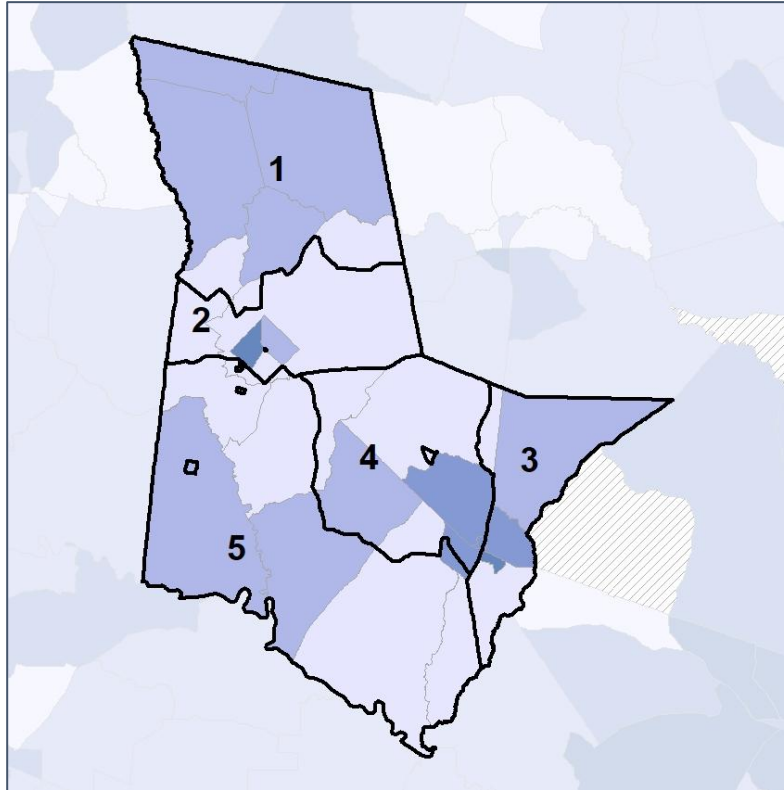

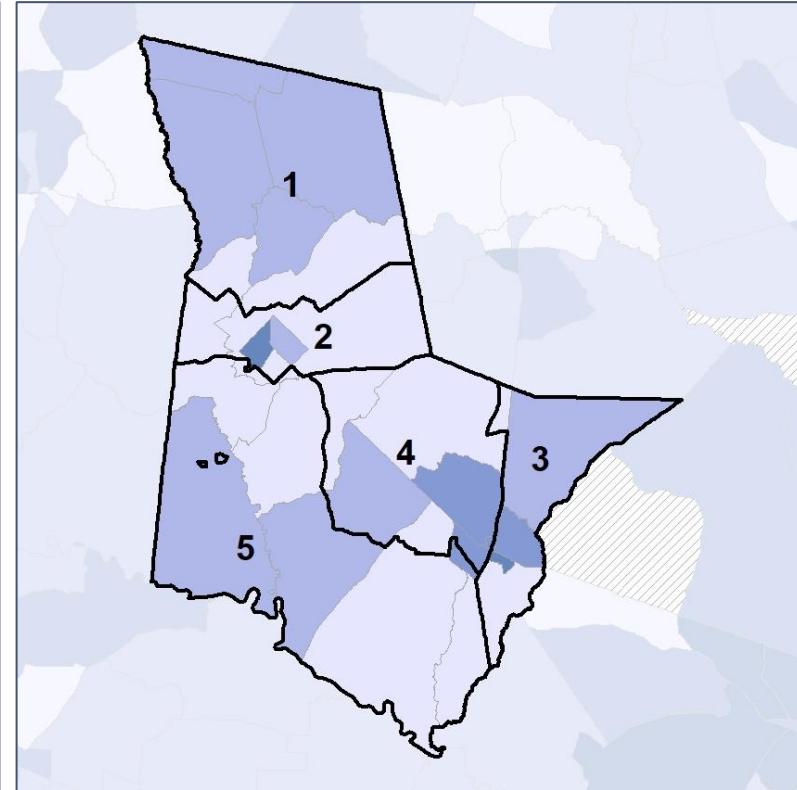
Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group

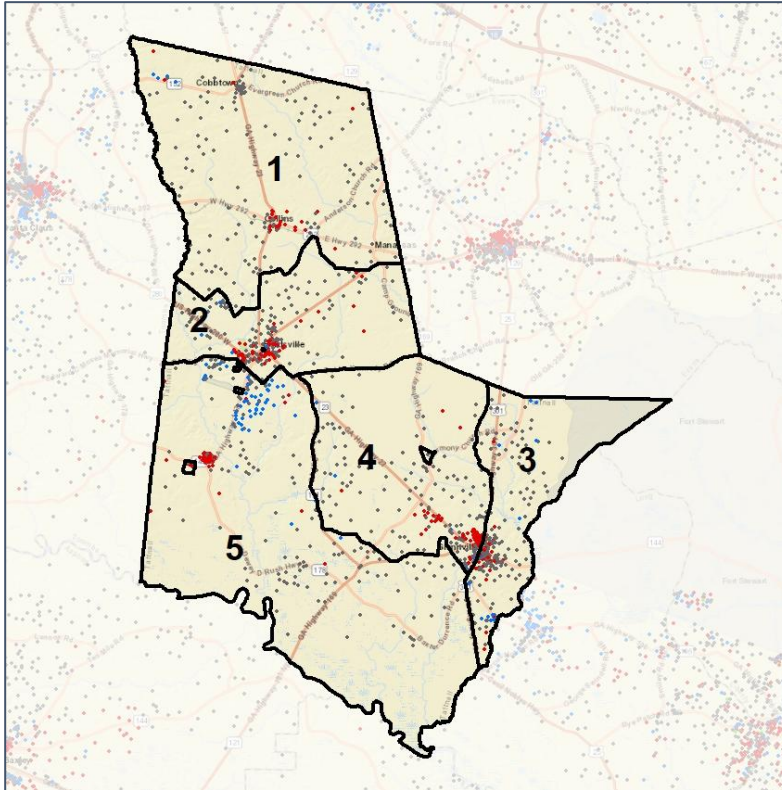

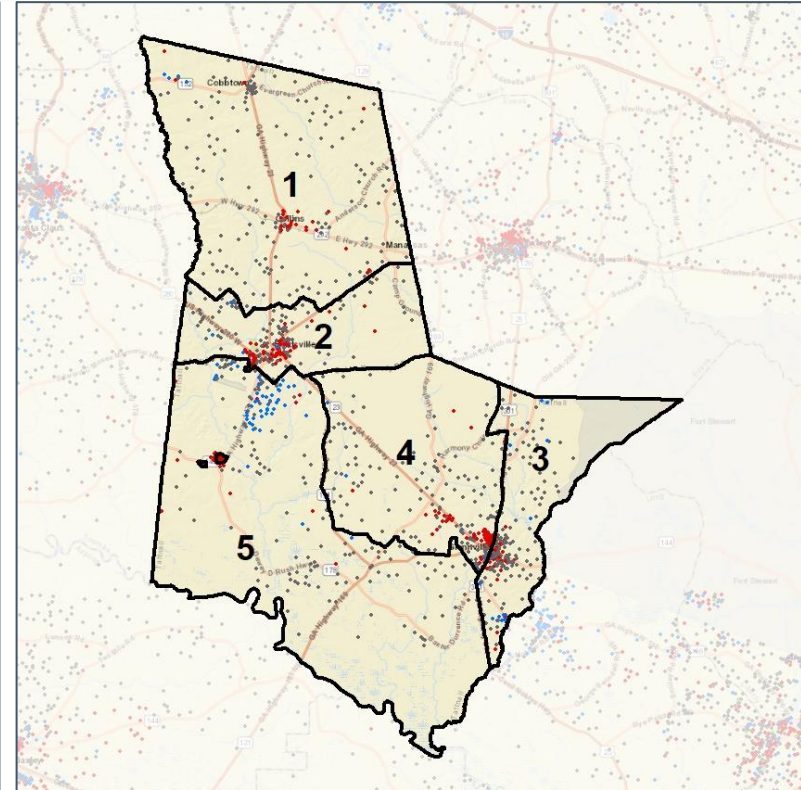
Population Density by Race



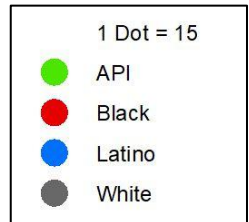

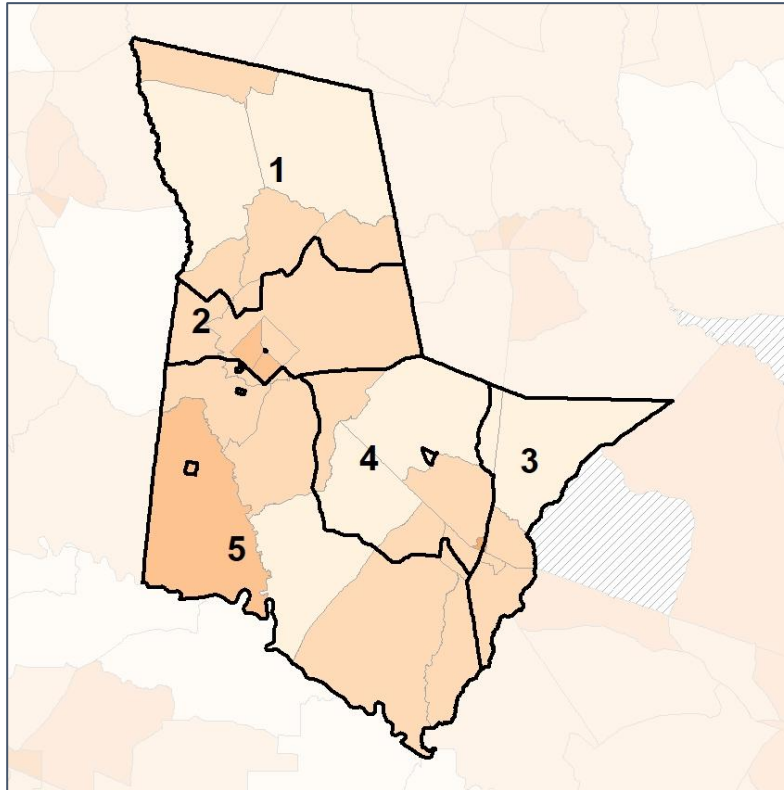

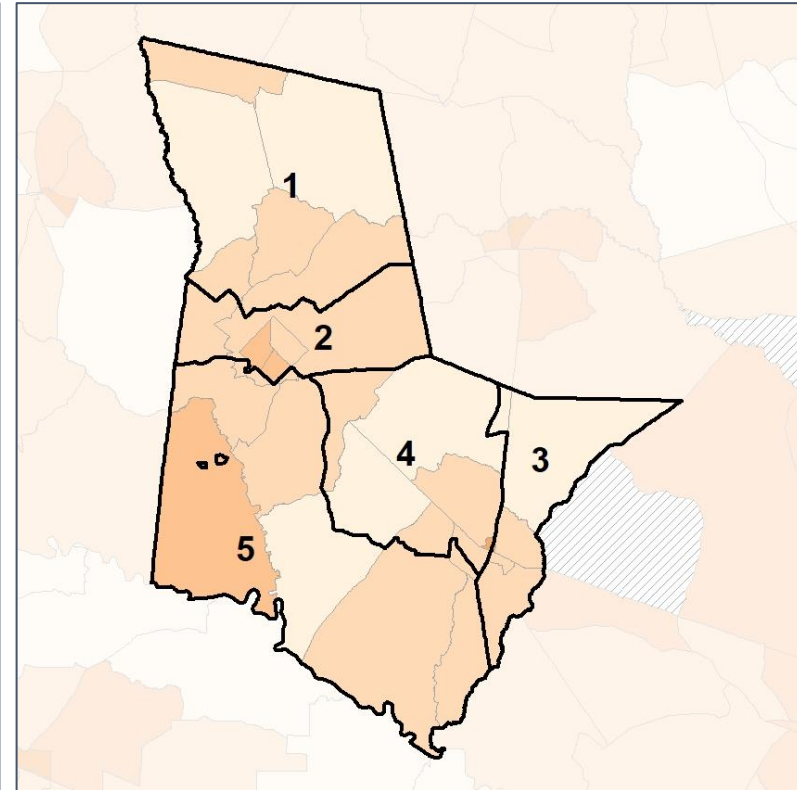
% People of Color by Census Block Group



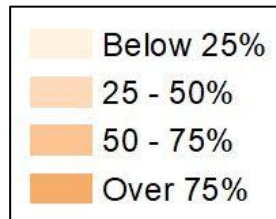

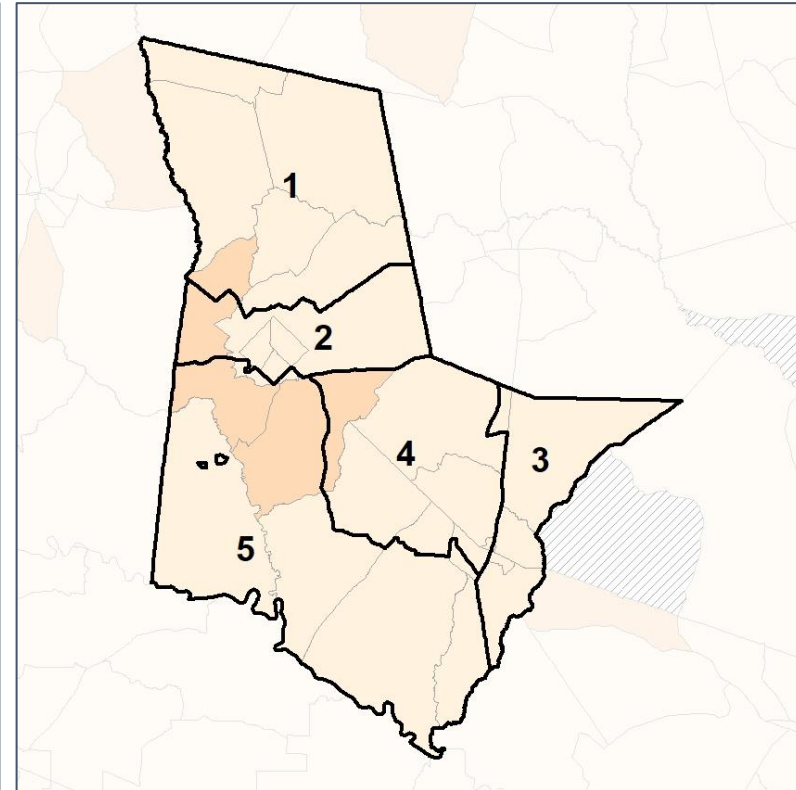
% Latino by Census Block Group

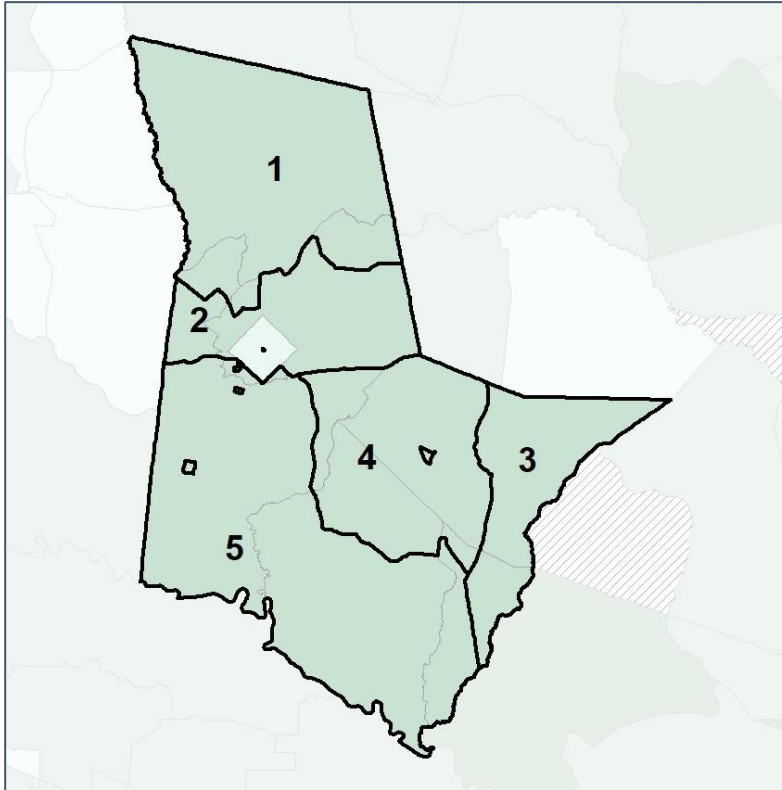

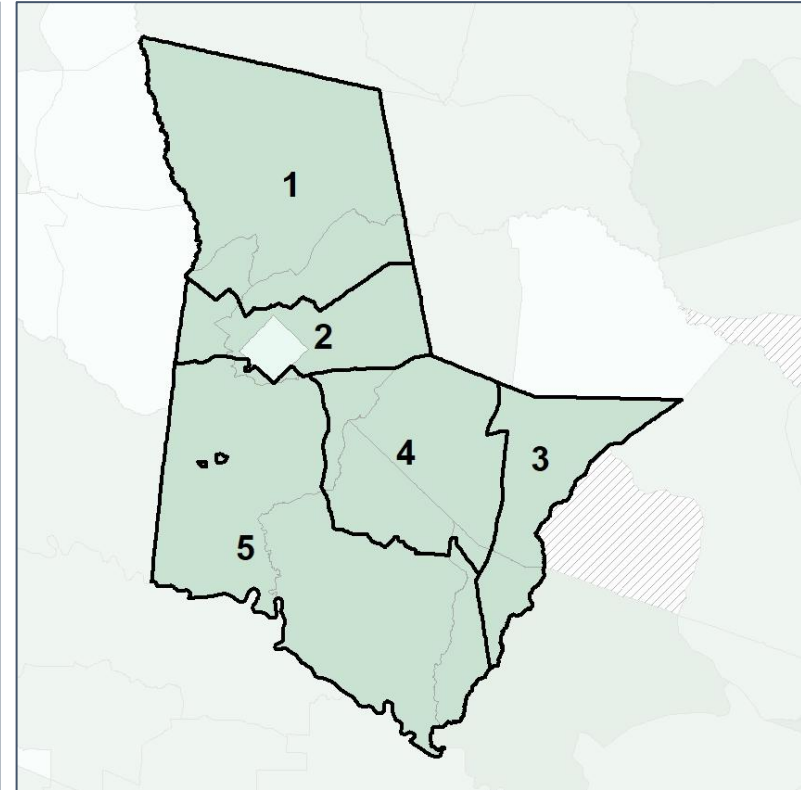
Median Household Income by Census Tract



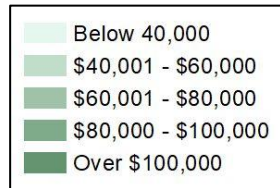

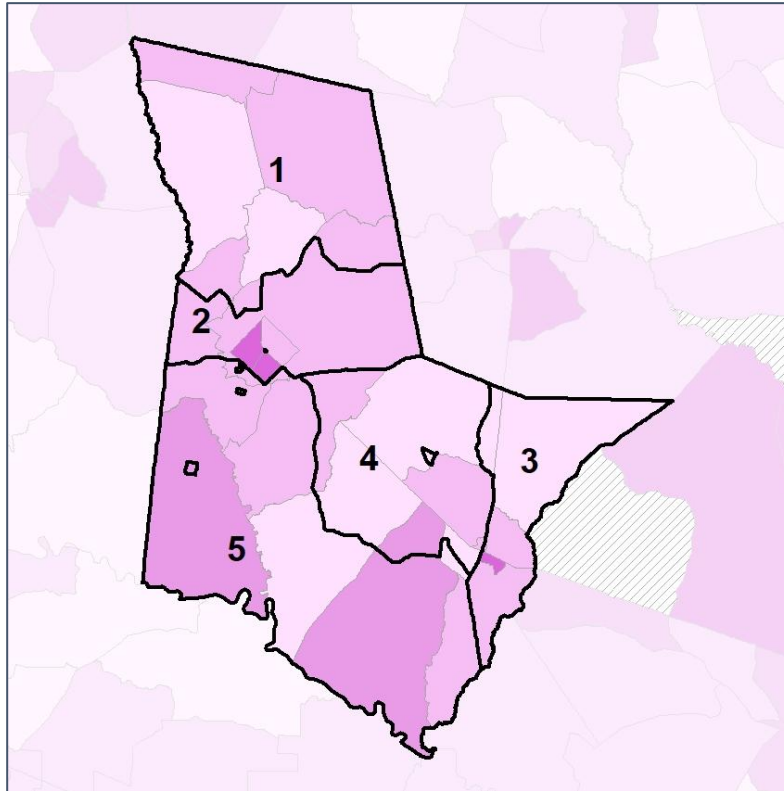

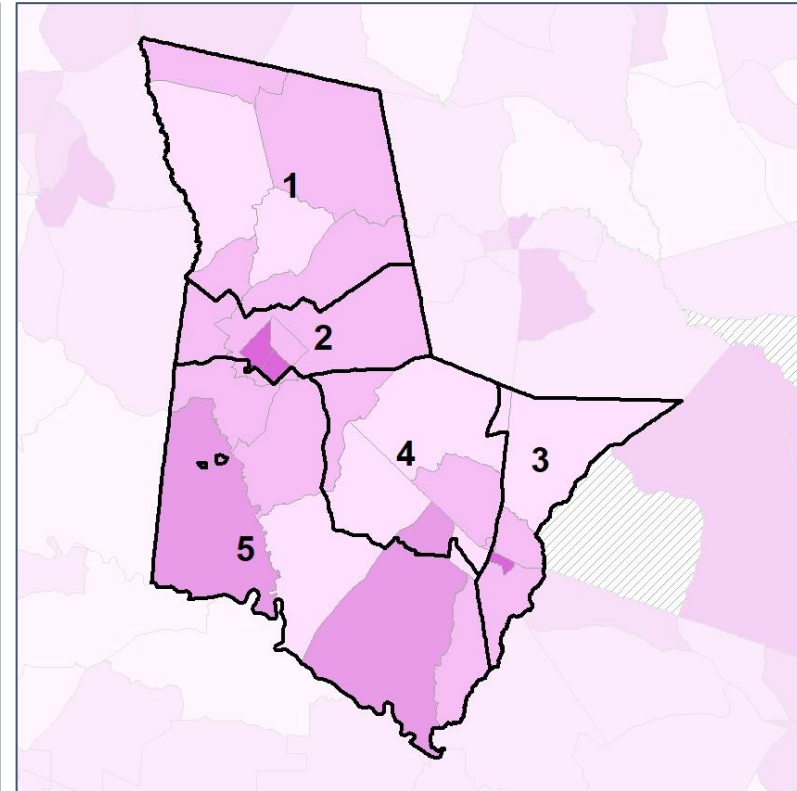
% Renter by Census Block Group

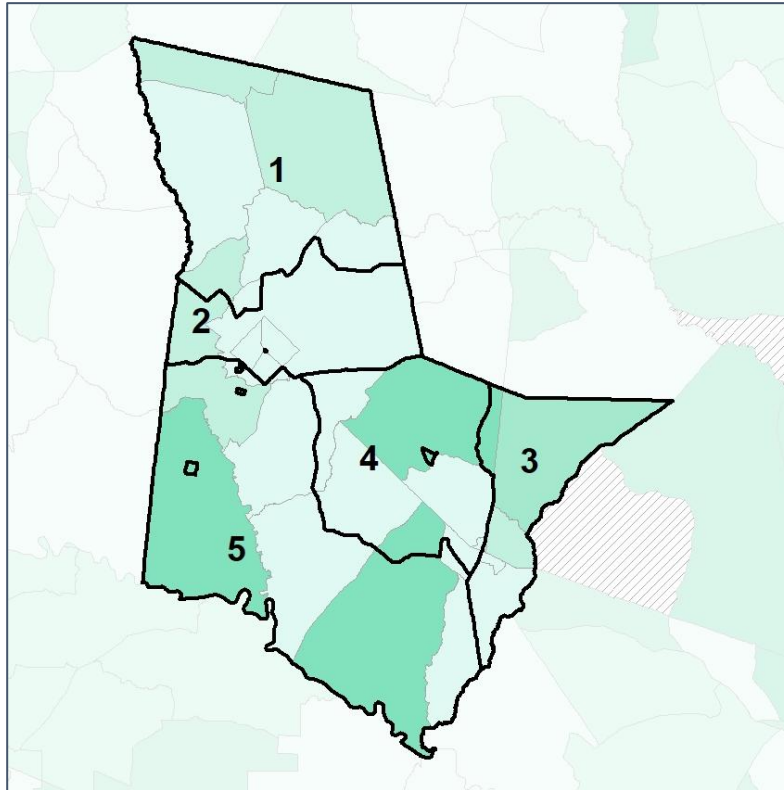

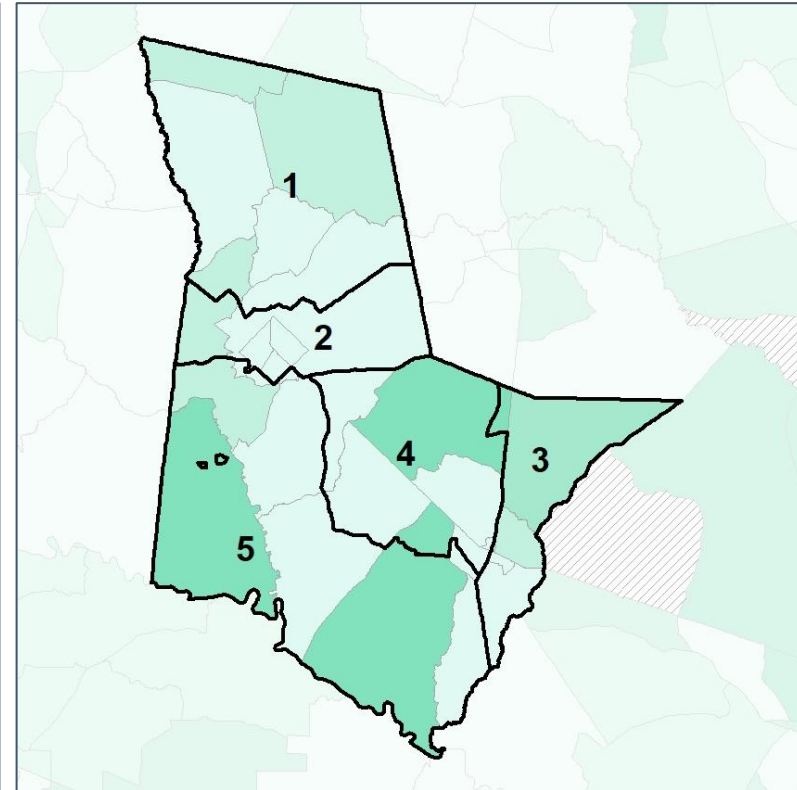
% Youth (18-34) by Census Block Group
