



### **Population Gain Change in Population by Decade**






While having a steady population since 1930, Tift County's population growth fell below the statewide average in the last four decades






Tift County demographic makeup is very similar to the State of Georgia



# **Demographics**2010 vs 2020 Demographics in Tift County






- Since 2010, the white population fell by 5%, but still remains the largest population demographic








- Since 2010 Tift County White population has decreased 6 times more than the statewide average

# Tift Co. Commission & School Board Net Gain in Population (2010 - 2020)












### Tift Co. Commission & School Board Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group












