

Population Gain Change in Population by Decade






- Washington County had a period of decline from 1930-1970, followed by a period of growth from 1970-2000

Comparison between Washington County and Georgia






- Washington County Is majority Black, and the next biggest groups is the White population with 42%

Demographics2010 vs 2020 Demographics in Washington County






- Washington County had an increase in its share of the Black and Other populations
- Meanwhile, the share of the White population slightly decreased




DemographicsPopulation Change by Race (2020 - 2010)






- Washington County had a decrease in all demographic groups except for the Other population
- The White population decreased the most, having a higher decline rate than in Georgia overall



















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Washington Co. Commission & School Board Net Gain in Population (2010 - 2020)










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



Washington Co. Commission & School Board Net Gain in % POC (2020 - 2010) by Census Block Group











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
Washington Co. Commission & School Board Population Density by Race


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



Washington Co. Commission & School Board % Youth (18-34) by Census Block Group
